

## DANIEL

3320. Daniel 1:1 King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon besieges King Jehoiakim of Judah in Jerusalem.
3321. Daniel 1:2 King Jehoiakim is taken, with the temple vessels, to the Land of Shinar, to the house of his god.
3322. Daniel 1:3 King Nebuchadnezzar's head eunuch, Ashpenaz, is told to take the smart young royals of Judah (they were all probably made eunuchs).
3323. Daniel 1:4 The young Judean royals must be without blemish, wise in science, and able to learn the Chaldean language.
3324. Daniel 1:5 The king prescribes the kind of food and wines the young royal Judean prisoners will consume for their next three years.
3325. Daniel 1:6 The most outstanding young royal captives are Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah.
3326. Daniel 1:7 The head eunuch, Ashpenaz, gives each of the four new names; Daniel's name is changed to Beltshazzar, Hananiah's name is changed to Shadrach, Mishael's name is changed to Meshach, and Azariah's name is changed to Abednego.
3327. Daniel 1:8-16 Daniel asks his eunuch boss, Ashpenaz, to change their food to pulse (mush) for a ten-day trial; he agrees and they stay healthier than with the Babylonian food prescribed.
3328. Daniel 1:17-20 The four young royals are the wisest in the land; Daniel is wise in visions and dreams; King Nebuchadnezzar has them before him.
3329. Daniel 1:21 Daniel continues to be the wisest of the kingdom into the reign of King Cyrus.

3330. Daniel 2:1-3 King Nebuchadnezzar has a troublesome dream and demands the dream be interpreted and told.
3331. Daniel 2:4-12 The Chaldean wise men tell King Nebuchadnezzar that the dream can't be interpreted; the king decrees death to all wise men, even the four young Judean royals.
3332. Daniel 2:13-23 The decree is sent out; Daniel asks for time from Captain Arioch of Babylon, and prays with the other young three, and the secret of the dream is revealed to him.
3333. Daniel 2:24-27 Daniel is taken to the King; he tells Nebuchadnezzar that the Chaldean wise men cannot interpret the dream; only God can.
3334. Daniel 2:28-45 Daniel gives the dream, then interprets it, tells about kings and God's kingdom.
3335. Daniel 2:46-48 King Nebuchadnezzar worships Daniel, makes him ruler of Babylon and governor of wise men.
3336. Daniel 2:49 Daniel puts Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in charge of Babylon's affairs.
3337. Daniel 3:1-3 King Nebuchadnezzar sets up a golden image in Dura, Babylon, a symbol of him.
3338. Daniel 3:4-7 A proclamation is made in Babylon that at the sound of music, all must bow down and worship the image.
3339. Daniel 3:8-12 The Chaldeans accuse the three young Judean royals of not falling down and worshipping the idol.
3340. Daniel 3:13-15 King Nebuchadnezzar brings Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednago before him and threatens the fiery furnace if they do not bow down to the image and worship it.

3341. Daniel 3:16-19 The three royal young wise answer “No!” The king tells his servants to heat the furnace seven times hotter.
3342. Daniel 3:20-23 The three are bound and the strongest servants are beckoned to cast them into the fire; the fire is so hot that it burns to death those casting the three into the furnace.
3343. Daniel 3:24-25 King Nebuchadnezzar looks into the furnace and sees four men walking in the fire and says, “THE FORM OF THE FOURTH MAN IS LIKE THE SON OF GOD!”
3344. Daniel 3:26-27 The men are called from the furnace; not a hair on them is singed, there is no smell of fire on them, and they have not been harmed.
3345. Daniel 3:28-30 King Nebuchadnezzar makes a decree concerning the three; none are allowed to speak against their God.
3346. Daniel 4:1-23 The King tells of Daniel’s dream interpretation about a tree depicting his kingdom.
3347. Daniel 4:24-29 Daniel tells King Nebuchadnezzar that he will live like an animal, grazing on grass.
3348. Daniel 4:30-33 The King is driven out to pasture; his hair grows like an eagle’s feathers and his nails like claws.
3349. Daniel 4:34-37 King Nebuchadnezzar acknowledges God; he is returned to power and blesses and praises Jehovah God.
3350. Daniel 5:1-4 Belshazzar, son of King Nebuchadnezzar, becomes king; he calls for a party and the golden vessels from the Jerusalem Temple be brought to use for wine; all at the party drink from them.

3351. Daniel 5:5-6 Handwriting with a man's hand appears on the wall of the party chamber; King Belshazzar's joints become loose and his knees knock.
3352. Daniel 5:7-12 King Belshazzar calls for the astrologers and wise to interpret the writing; none can and the queen tells him of Daniel.
3353. Daniel 5:13-29 Daniel interprets the handwriting and tells the King that the use of the sacred vessels will cost him his kingdom.
3354. Daniel 5:30-31 That same night King Belshazzar is slain and Darius the Median, age sixty-two takes the kingdom.
3355. Daniel 6:1-3 King Darius sets up one hundred twenty princes over his kingdom with three presidents; Daniel is made the top president.
3356. Daniel 6:4-9 The jealous sub-presidents and princes get King Darius to make a decree that none may worship other than the king for thirty days; the penalty for disobedience is being cast into the den of lions.
3357. Daniel 6:10-15 Spies find Daniel praying; they tell the King and demand the penalty for his disobedience.
3358. Daniel 6:16-18 King Darius loves Daniel but must execute the sentence; he seals the lions' den with his signet and lies awake all night.
3359. Daniel 6:19-23 King Darius returns to the den early the next morning and finds Daniel safe, and extracts him.
3360. Daniel 6:24-27 King Darius casts all of the accusers into the lions' den with their families; all are killed by the lions and eaten.
3361. Daniel 6:28 Daniel prospers in the reign of Darius and Cyrus, the Persian.

3362. Daniel 7:1 Daniel also has a dream during the reign of King Belshazzar and tells it.
3363. Daniel 7:2-3 Daniel's dream: four great winds over the sea and four great beasts come up from the sea.
3364. Daniel 7:4 The first beast is a lion with eagle wings (plucked), which stood on feet; the heart of a man is given to it.
3365. Daniel 7:5 The second beast is a bear with one side raised and three ribs between its teeth; the ribs say, "Devour much flesh!"
3366. Daniel 7:6 The third beast is a leopard with four wings on its back and four heads; it is given dominion.
3367. Daniel 7:7 The fourth beast is dreadful with great iron teeth and ten horns; it destroys and stomps everything.
3368. Daniel 7:8 The fourth beast grows another small horn that plucked up three other horns; it has the eyes of a man and a mouth speaking great things.
3369. Daniel 7:9 Thrones are cast down to earth; the "Ancient of Days" sits with a garment as white as snow, hair like pure wool, a throne like a fiery flame, and wheels like burning fire.
3370. Daniel 7:10 A fiery stream comes from Him; thousands minister unto Him; ten million stand before Him; judgment is set; the books are opened.
3371. Daniel 7:11 Daniel beholds great words as the small horn of the fourth beast speaks; the beast is slain, destroyed, and burned.
3372. Daniel 7:12 The other three beasts have their dominion taken away and their lives prolonged for a season of time.

3373. Daniel 7:13 DANIEL SEES IN THE DARKNESS, JESUS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN, BROUGHT BEFORE GOD.
3374. Daniel 7:14 JESUS IS GIVEN DOMINION, GLORY, AND THE KINGDOM OF THE WHOLE WORLD FOREVER; IT WILL NEVER PASS AWAY OR BE DESTROYED.
3375. Daniel 7:15-16 Daniel is troubled with the vision and goes to minister before God; he asks for the interpretation.
3376. Daniel 7:17-18 The interpretation: the four beasts are earth kings (big four countries); but the saints will take the kingdoms away.
3377. Daniel 7:19-22 The fourth beast's small horn makes war with the saints and wins; then God comes and gives judgment and the saints win.
3378. Daniel 7:23 The fourth beast is diverse from the other three and shall devour the whole earth, tread it down, and break it in pieces.
3379. Daniel 7:24 The fourth beast's ten horns are the ten kings of earth; another is diverse and will subdue three kingdoms.
3380. Daniel 7:25 The diverse one will speak against God, wear out the saints, and will change the laws for a time.
3381. Daniel 7:26 At the end God's judgment will stand and the diverse one's dominion will be destroyed.
3382. Daniel 7:27 The whole earth's kingdom will be given to the people of God's saints; they will serve Him everlasting.
3383. Daniel 7:28 The end of Daniel's visions; knowing these visions trouble him and change his countenance; all of them are kept secret in his heart.

3384. Daniel 8:1-2 In the third year of King Belshazzar Daniel has a second vision at Shushan by the River of Uilai.
3385. Daniel 8:3-4 Daniel sees a ram with two horns come out of the river; it pushes North, West, and South, overpowering all.
3386. Daniel 8:5-6 A he goat comes from the West and covers the earth; it floats in the air and has only one horn (unicorn); it runs into the ram.
3387. Daniel 8:7 The he goat smites the ram, breaks his horns, casts him down, and stomps him into the ground.
3388. Daniel 8:8 The he goat's great horn is broken but four more horns replace it, each points toward the four winds of heaven.
3389. Daniel 8:9 A little horn comes out of one of them and becomes powerful; it points South, East, and toward the pleasant land.
3390. Daniel 8:10 The little horn waxes great, reaches to heaven, casts down the stars to the ground, and stomps them.
3391. Daniel 8:11 The little horn magnifies against Jesus, takes the daily sacrifice away, and casts down the sanctuary.
3392. Daniel 8:12 The little horn's deputies transgress against truth; evil is practiced and prospers.
3393. Daniel 8:13 Daniel hears a saint speaking, asking another how long the desolation will last.
3394. Daniel 8:14 An angel (saint) says the desolation will last two thousand three hundred days (six years), then the sanctuary will be cleansed.
3395. Daniel 8:15 Daniel asks to know the meaning of the vision; a man appears before him.

3396. Daniel 8:16 The man stands in the middle of the Ulai River and tells Gabriel to explain the vision to Daniel.
3397. Daniel 8:17 Gabriel (angel) comes to Daniel, Daniel falls on his face, and he is told that the vision is the end of time.
3398. Daniel 8:18-19 Angel Gabriel sets Daniel up and tells him this is the end of indignation, the appointed time has arrived, and the end shall come.
3399. Daniel 8:20 Gabriel says that the ram with two horns is a symbol of Media and Persia.
3400. Daniel 8:21 Gabriel says that the rough (he) goat symbolizes Grecia (Greece) and his great horn is the first king of Greece.
3401. Daniel 8:22 The goat's great horn is broken but the other four horns stand up for it; they represent the next four kingdoms not in his power.
3402. Daniel 8:23 At the end of these four kingdoms, transgressors will come and a fierce king will come with understanding.
3403. Daniel 8:24 That king and others will destroy and prosper; they will destroy a mighty and holy people.
3404. Daniel 8:25 That king will magnify himself and with peace will destroy many; he will stand against THE PRINCE OF PRINCES, but shall be broken.
3405. Daniel 8:26 Daniel is told that the whole vision is true and to protect it; the vision will occur after a long time.
3406. Daniel 8:27 Daniel faints and is sick several days; he rises up and does the king's business; he is astonished at the vision none understood.
3407. Daniel 9:1 The time is the first year of King Darius (son of King Ahasuerus – the time of Esther), a Mede and King of the Chaldeans.

3408. Daniel 9:2 Daniel reads the prophesy of Jeremiah of seventy years in the desolation of Jerusalem.
3409. Daniel 9:3-19 Daniel humbles, expresses the sins of Israel in detail, and asks forgiveness.
3410. Daniel 9:20-21 While Daniel prays in the evening, the Angel “man” Gabriel from the vision comes to him.
3411. Daniel 9:22-23 Gabriel speaks, “I bring skill to you, God says you will understand the vision.
3412. Daniel 9:24 God says, “There are seventy weeks to finish transgressions, end sins, be righteous, seal the vision, and anoint the Most Holy.”
3413. Daniel 9:25 God: “Know that in sixty-nine weeks from the rebuilding of Jerusalem, in troublesome times, MESSIAH, THE PRINCE WILL COME.”
3414. Daniel 9:26 God: “After sixty-two weeks Messiah will be cut off; His people will destroy the city and the Temple with a flood and desolations.”
3415. Daniel 9:27 God: “Messiah will confirm the covenant for one week; at midweek the desolations will come.”
3416. Daniel 10:1 In the third year of King Cyrus, King of Persia, a vision is revealed to Daniel and lasts a long time.
3417. Daniel 10:2-4 Daniel fasts for three weeks; on the twenty-fourth day of the month Daniel stands beside the Hiddekel River.
3418. Daniel 10:5-7 DANIEL SEES JESUS IN A VISION, THE EARTH QUAKES AND HIS MEN RUN AND HIDE.
3419. Daniel 10:8-9 UPON SEEING THE VISION OF JESUS, DANIEL GROWS WEAK AND FALLS ON HIS FACE IN A DEEP SLEEP.

3420. Daniel 10:10-11 JESUS TOUCHES DANIEL; HE STANDS TREMBLING; JESUS SAYS, "I AM SENT TO YOU."
3421. Daniel 10:12-13 JESUS TELLS DANIEL THAT HE IS HEARD; PERSIA RESISTS HIM FOR TWENTY-ONE DAYS; PRINCE MICHAEL (ANGEL?) KEEPS HIM THERE WITH THE KING OF PERSIA.
3422. Daniel 10:14-15 JESUS TELLS DANIEL OF LATTER DAYS AND EVENTS TO COME; DANIEL FALLS ON HIS FACE.
3423. Daniel 10:16-19 DANIEL LOSES HIS STRENGTH; JESUS PRAISES HIM AND GIVES HIM STRENGTH.
3424. Daniel 10:20-21 JESUS: "I WILL FIGHT WITH PERSIA; A GREEK PRINCE WILL COME; HE AND MICHAEL WILL SHOW TRUTH OF SCRIPTURE; 'MICHAEL, YOUR PRINCE'."
3425. Daniel 11:1 JESUS IS TALKING TO DANIEL: "I HELPED STRENGTHEN MEDE KING DARIUS IN HIS FIRST YEAR."
3426. Daniel 11:2 JESUS SAYS: "THREE PERSIAN KINGS PLUS ONE RICH ONE WILL BE STIRRED UP AGAINST GREECE."
3427. Daniel 11:3-4 JESUS: "A MIGHTY KING WITH DOMINION WILL LOSE IT, IT WILL BE SCATTERED, AND THE KINGDOM WILL BE PLUCKED UP."
3428. Daniel 11:5-6 JESUS: "THERE ARE STRONG NORTH AND SOUTH KINGS; THE DAUGHTER OF THE SOUTH KING WILL BETROTH THE NORTH KING."
3429. Daniel 11:7 JESUS: "A BRANCH OF THE DAUGHTER'S ROOTS WILL COME AS AN ARMY AND CONQUER THE NORTHERN KINGDOM."

3430. Daniel 11:8-9 JESUS: "CAPTIVES AND TREASURES FROM THE NORTH WILL BE CARRIED INTO EGYPT; THE SOUTH KING IS RETURNED HOME."
3431. Daniel 11:10-12 JESUS: "THE SOUTH KING'S SONS WILL RISE UP; THERE WILL BE ANOTHER FIGHT, NORTH AGAINST SOUTH, AND THE NORTH WINS."
3432. Daniel 11:13-15 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL COME AND CAPTURE THE FENCED CITIES OF THE SOUTH."
3433. Daniel 11:16-19 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL REIGN OVER THE SOUTH AND TAKE SOME ISLANDS; HE WILL FALL AND RETURN HOME."
3434. Daniel 11:20-21 JESUS: "A TAX COLLECTOR WILL REIGN IN THE NORTH KINGDOM AND FALL; A LEADER WILL COME AND TAKE THE KINGDOM BY FLATTERY."
3435. Daniel 11:22-24 JESUS: "THE VILE LEADER WILL FLOOD OVER THE WHOLE AREA, EVEN OVER THE 'PRINCE OF THE COVENANT.'"
3436. Daniel 11:25-26 JESUS: "THIS VILE LEADER WILL FIGHT THE KING OF THE SOUTH BUT INTERNAL CONFLICTS WILL DESTROY HIM."
3437. Daniel 11:27-28 JESUS: "THE NORTH AND SOUTH KINGS' HEARTS ARE WICKED, THEY ARE AGAINST THE COVENANT AND ARE EXPLOITING; THE NORTH KING WILL RETURN HOME."

3438. Daniel 11:29-30 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL COME AGAIN, THE CHITTIM NAVY WILL DEFEAT HIM, HE WILL HAVE INDIGNATION AGAINST THE HOLY COVENANT, AND WILL FORSAKE THE COVENANT."
3439. Daniel 11:31 JESUS: "THE KING OF THE NORTH WILL COME AGAIN, POLLUTE THE SANCTUARY, TAKE AWAY THE DAILY SACRIFICE, AND PLACE THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION THERE."
3440. Daniel 11:32-35 JESUS: "THE WICKED ARE AGAINST THE COVENANT BUT THE ONES WHO KNOW GOD WILL HOLD ON AND BE SLAIN, BUT THE END IS NOT YET COME."
3441. Daniel 11:36 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL DO HIS OWN WILL, EXHALT HIMSELF ABOVE GOD, SPEAK MARVELOUSLY AGAINST GOD, AND WILL PROSPER UNTIL THE INDIGNATION IS ACCOMPLISHED; THE END IS COMING."
3442. Daniel 11:37-39 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL NOT HONOR THE GOD OF HIS FATHERS NOR WOMEN; HE WILL MAKE A GOD AND DIVIDE THE LAND."
3443. Daniel 11:40-41 JESUS: "AT THE TIME OF THE END THE NORTH KING WILL BE ATTACKED BY THE SOUTH KING WHO WILL DEFEAT HIM WITH HORSEMEN, CHARIOTS, AND SHIPS, AND TAKE ALL OF HIS LAND, BUT EDOM, MOAB, AND AMMON WILL ESCAPE."
3444. Daniel 11:42-43 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL TAKE EGYPT, LIBYA, AND ETHIOPIA WHO ARE ALL VULNERABLE TO HIS ATTACK."

3445. Daniel 11:44 JESUS: "THREATS AGAINST THE NORTH KING WILL COME FROM THE EAST AND NORTH; HE WILL ATTACK WITH GREAT FURY."
3446. Daniel 11:45 JESUS: "THE NORTH KING WILL BUILD HIS PALACE BETWEEN THE SEAS ON THE HOLY MOUNTAIN; HE WILL COME TO HIS END; NONE WILL COME TO HIS RESCUE."
3447. Daniel 12:1 JESUS STILL SPEAKING: "AT THE TIME OF THE FALL OF THE NORTH KING, PRINCE (ANGEL) MICHAEL WILL COME; THEN WILL COME THE WORLD'S WORST TROUBLES; GOD'S PEOPLE IN THE BOOK WILL BE DELIVERED."
3448. Daniel 12:2 JESUS: "THE BURIED WILL AWAKE, SOME TO EVERLASTING LIFE (HEAVEN) AND THE REST TO HELL."
3449. Daniel 12:3-4 Jesus praises the wise (saved), especially evangelists; He tells Daniel to seal the book until the end of time and says that many false philosophies will be spread.
3450. Daniel 12:5-6 Daniel sees one angel on each bank of the river; Jesus is standing on the water in the middle of the river; one angel asks Jesus how long it will be until the end of time.
3451. Daniel 12:7 Jesus holds up his hands and swears by God that the end will come in two and a half times when his holy people are scattered all over the earth.
3452. Daniel 12:8-9 Daniel doesn't understand and asks about the end time; Jesus says that words of the end are sealed.
3453. Daniel 12:10 JESUS: "MANY WILL BE PURIFIED WHITE AND TRIED; THE WICKED WILL NOT UNDERSTAND BUT THE WISE WILL."

3454. Daniel 12:11                    JESUS: "THE DAILY SACRIFICE WILL CEASE; THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION WILL BE SET UP; THERE WILL BE THREE YEARS AND SEVEN MONTHS BETWEEN THE TWO EVENTS."
3455. Daniel 12:12                    JESUS: "THE BLESSED WILL WAIT AND COME TO A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS, EIGHT AND ONE HALF MONTHS."
3456. Daniel 12:13                    JESUS TELLS DANIEL: "GO BACK TO WORK, YOU WILL DIE AND BE BURIED, BUT WILL ARISE FROM THE GRAVE AND STAND IN HONOR AT THE SECOND COMING."
