

ECCLESIASTES

2868. Ecclesiastes 1:1-17 The “Preacher,” son of King David’s pessimism over life, “all is vanity.”
2869. Ecclesiastes 1:18 Much wisdom equals much grief; increasing knowledge increases sorrow.
2870. Ecclesiastes 2:1-11 Story of the spoiled rich king or man who tries everything but receives no blessings.
2871. Ecclesiastes 2:12-17 The rich, putting down wisdom, hate life because they are rich and spoiled.
2872. Ecclesiastes 2:18-26 The rich hates his labor and leaves his wealth to one who has not labored for it.
2873. Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 Everything has a season; there is a time for everything, listed in these verses.
2874. Ecclesiastes 3:9-15 Acknowledging God’s gifts to man and how they should be enjoyed.
2875. Ecclesiastes 3:16-22 God’s judgment of evil; man and beast are much the same in death except that man has a spirit (soul).
2876. Ecclesiastes 4:1-8 Oppression without comfort and labor without reward, all is vanity.
2877. Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 TWO ARE BETTER THAN ONE; IF ONE FALLS, THE OTHER PICKS HIM (OR HER) UP.
2878. Ecclesiastes 4:11 Two lying together have heat; one alone will be cold (as in marriage).
2879. Ecclesiastes 4:12 The benefit of two protecting each other; three are even better and stronger like a braided cord.
2880. Ecclesiastes 4:13 It is better to be a poor and wise child than a king who will not be admonished.

2881. Ecclesiastes 4:14 A foolish old king is like one ruling from prison; people will hate him.
2882. Ecclesiastes 5:1-7 Carefully go before God; don't speak much; never break a vow.
2883. Ecclesiastes 5:8-20 Riches defeat; the rich can't sleep; evil riches will perish; no riches will go with one to heaven.
2884. Ecclesiastes 6:1-12 Evil of riches; vanity brings darkness; good comes only if the soul is good.
2885. Ecclesiastes 7:1 A good name is better than precious ointment, so one's day of death is better than one's day of birth.
2886. Ecclesiastes 7:2-4 Mourning is better than feasting; sorrow is better than laughter; sadness makes one better.
2887. Ecclesiastes 7:5-22 Rebuke of the wise is better than the song of fools; anger slowly; the wicked sometimes prevail.
2888. Ecclesiastes 7:23-29 Wisdom; folly; foolishness; madness; bad women; God makes man upright; man invents failures.
2889. Ecclesiastes 8:1-10 Wise men and kings; purpose has judgment; power over the spirit; the wicked are forgotten.
2890. Ecclesiastes 8:11 A sentence for evil not speedily executed causes others to do evil (i.e. the death penalty).
2891. Ecclesiastes 8:12-17 Sinners who fear God are forgiven; other sinners are condemned.
2892. Ecclesiastes 9:1-6 God holds his wise ones; evil and good come to everyone equally; evil ones ignore death.
2893. Ecclesiastes 9:7-9 God's people must strive to be pure; live joyfully with and love your wife (husband) always.

2894. Ecclesiastes 9:10-12 Work hard; winning depends on chance and time; even the good are sometimes snared.
2895. Ecclesiastes 9:13-18 The wise poor are never rewarded for saving the city, but wisdom is better than weapons of war.
2896. Ecclesiastes 10:1-15 Flies, like fools, spoil things; fools are full of words which weary and displace.
2897. Ecclesiastes 10:16-20 Kings must be mature and work hard; money answers all things; whispers of the king are heard.
2898. Ecclesiastes 11:1-6 Cast your bread upon the waters; give to the poor; sow and reap at the proper times and conditions.
2899. Ecclesiastes 11:7-10 Always remember the dark as well as the good times; in your youth, work hard for wisdom.
2900. Ecclesiastes 12:1-5 Coming to the end times; evil days; all music stops; fear abounds; man is going home.
2901. Ecclesiastes 12:6-7 Chaos will reign; man's body will return to dust; the spirit shall return to God.
2902. Ecclesiastes 12:8-12 The preacher, through preaching knowledge, believes that all is vanity.
2903. Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 Conclusion; fear God; keep His Commandments; all works shall be judged; all secrets shall be known, both good and evil.
