

## EZEKIEL

3215. Ezekiel 1:1-3 Ezekiel is in captivity in the Land of the Chaldeans; he is a priest-prophet who sees visions.
3216. Ezekiel 1:4-5 Ezekiel sees a whirlwind coming from the north and inside it four creatures like men.
3217. Ezekiel 1:6-7 Each of the four men-creatures have four faces and four wings and have straight feet with hoof like soles.
3218. Ezekiel 1:8-9 Each has hands under their wings; their wings are connected together with all moving forward.
3219. Ezekiel 1:10 Each man-creature has the face of a man with the face of a lion on the right side, the face of an ox on the left side, and the face of an eagle.
3220. Ezekiel 1:11-14 Two extra wings cover their bodies; like burning coals, with lightning they run to and fro.
3221. Ezekiel 1:15-16 There are wheels on these creatures and in the works of the wheels each has another wheel inside it.
3222. Ezekiel 1:17-18 The creatures go on four sides; they have rings and are high; they each have four eyes and are dreadful.
3223. Ezekiel 1:19-21 The wheels lift up and go with the creatures; the spirit of the creatures is in the wheels.
3224. Ezekiel 1:22-25 Crystal firmament is on their heads; the noise of their wings is like the Almighty speaking.
3225. Ezekiel 1:26-28 Above this firmament is the likeness of a throne with a Man on it and a rainbow around it.

3226. Ezekiel 2:1-5 The creature is God; He speaks to me and says: “Stand; I send you to rebellious Israel as a Prophet.”
3227. Ezekiel 2:6-10 God tells Ezekiel not to fear and gives him a book to deliver with lamentations, mourning, and woe.
3228. Ezekiel 3:1-3 God feeds Ezekiel a roll; it is like sweet honey and fills him.
3229. Ezekiel 3:4-11 Ezekiel is sent to Israel; God tells him that they will not listen in captivity because their heads are hard, “But your head will be harder.”
3230. Ezekiel 3:12-15 Ezekiel is taken in the spirit to Chaldea where he hears the noise of wings, wheels, and a voice of praise.
3231. Ezekiel 3:16-21 God tells Ezekiel to speak the truth to the wicked of Israel or their blood will be on his hands.
3232. Ezekiel 3:22-27 God’s Hand is upon Ezekiel; He tells Ezekiel, “Israel will bind you and keep you quiet, but I will open your mouth.
3233. Ezekiel 4:1-8 God has Ezekiel build a model of Jerusalem’s siege and lay it on its side as a symbol of Israel and Judah.
3234. Ezekiel 4:9-17 God has Ezekiel bake bread to eat, then bake bread made with man’s dung and cow dung to make the children of Israel eat.
3235. Ezekiel 5:1-7 God has Ezekiel shave his head and beard and divide it in thirds; burn one third, scatter one third, and bind one third; God is angry.
3236. Ezekiel 5:8-11 GOD: “BECAUSE OF ISRAEL’S ABOMINATIONS, FATHERS AND SONS SHALL KILL AND EAT EACH OTHER AND I WON’T PITY!”

3237. Ezekiel 5:12-17 God says that one third of Israel will die, one third be scattered, and one third will be in famine, devoured by evil beasts, or exposed to pestilences.
3238. Ezekiel 6:1-7 God tells Ezekiel to look toward Israel and prophesy against them; God will scatter their bones.
3239. Ezekiel 6:8-14 God says He will leave a remnant of Israel but will slay the rest with their whorish hearts.
3240. Ezekiel 7:1-27 God's wrath upon Israel, pestilence and famine, death in the cities, and sword to the scattered.
3241. Ezekiel 8:1-18 Ezekiel is taken in a vision to Jerusalem to see the abominations of the House of Israel.
3242. Ezekiel 9:1-4 Ezekiel sees men with destroying weapons and one with an inkhorn to mark the foreheads of the repentant.
3243. Ezekiel 9:5-11 All of the evil ones without the mark, even women and children are killed by the men with destroying weapons.
3244. Ezekiel 10:1-2 Ezekiel observes the throne above the cherubims; God sends the inkhorn man to take fire coals from under the cherubims and scatter them on the city of Jerusalem.
3245. Ezekiel 10:3-11 Ezekiel observes cherubims with wheels and hands under their wings picking up coals of fire.
3246. Ezekiel 10: 12-22 Ezekiel sees wheels full of eyes and the Glory of the Lord at the River of Chebar in Chaldea.
3247. Ezekiel 11:1-25 God shows Ezekiel the slaughter of Israel in Zion and Israel's borders and the repentant ones.
3248. Ezekiel 12:1-28 God tells of the doom of the "Prince of Jerusalem" in Babylon and of more destruction of the Jews.

3249. Ezekiel 13:1-16 God speaks of false prophets of Israel building walls daubed with untempered mortar.
3250. Ezekiel 13:17-23 God tells Ezekiel to distrust the Daughters of Israel who make pillows with armholes.
3251. Ezekiel 14:1-13 Israel's elders gather; Ezekiel condemns them for idols and foretells of Israel's doom.
3252. Ezekiel 14:14 God says that Noah, Daniel, and Job can only deliver their own souls by their righteousness.
3253. Ezekiel 14:15-23 God amplifies personal salvation; some will be saved but most will be destroyed.
3254. Ezekiel 15:1-8 God's curse of fire on the inhabitants of Jerusalem; they will burn like a vine tree; there will be desolation.
3255. Ezekiel 16:1-5 God on the abominations of Jerusalem, "The baby was not salted, swaddled, nor supplied."
3256. Ezekiel 16:6-14 God tells how He loved Jerusalem from birth, cleaned her up, gave her a jewel on her forehead and a crown.
3257. Ezekiel 16:15-34 God speaks of Jerusalem's whoredoms, "Opened your feet instead of spreading your legs, paid your lovers instead of being paid, you have committed adultery with all countries around Israel and Judah!"
3258. Ezekiel 16:35-44 More abominations of Jews; God says the world will use this proverb against Jerusalem: "As is the mother, so is her Daughter."
3259. Ezekiel 16:45-63 God to Jerusalem, "Your sister is Samaria, your younger sister is Sodom and her daughters; you have no good works; you have not fed the poor, yet I will remember my covenant with you!"
3260. Ezekiel 17:1-24 God speaking of eagles bringing two trees and planting Israel and nurturing her.

3261. Ezekiel 18:1-32 God's qualifications for being good or bad as the House of Israel; says the soul that sins, dies.
3262. Ezekiel 19:1-14 A lamentation for Israel; her strong rod is weak and her fire is quenched.
3263. Ezekiel 20:1-9 Israel's elders come before Ezekiel to inquire; God reviews their history.
3264. Ezekiel 20:10-32 Israel's rebellion, pollution, and broken statutes; goes to a hill called "Bamah."
3265. Ezekiel 20:33-49 GOD TELLS THE JEWS THAT HE WILL REGATHER THEM FROM THE WHOLE WORLD AND BRING THEM BACK TO ISRAEL (THEY BEGAN IN THE YEAR 1948).
3266. Ezekiel 21:1-7 God tells Ezekiel to prophesy against Israel again, that He is sending a sword.
3267. Ezekiel 21:8-32 God's word about the destruction of Israel by the Ammonites and Babylonians.
3268. Ezekiel 22:1-12 God's accusations of abominations of Israel with neighbor's wives, daughter-in-law, and sisters.
3269. Ezekiel 22:13-31 Israel has become dross; God will send fire; Israel's priests violate God's holiness.
3270. Ezekiel 23:1-4 God's word to Ezekiel of whoredoms of two women in Egypt, Aholah and Aholibah – symbolic.
3271. Ezekiel 23:5-8 Aholah is Samaria and Aholibah is Jerusalem; Israel and Judah are harlots.
3272. Ezekiel 23:9-49 Samaria is delivered into the hand of the Assyrians, Jerusalem to Babylonians and the reasons.
3273. Ezekiel 24:1-27 Babylon coming against Jerusalem; burning bones and scum; Ezekiel speaking to them.

3274. Ezekiel 25:1-17 God speaking vengeance against the Ammonites, Moab, Edom, Philistines, and Cherethims.
3275. Ezekiel 26:1-21 God's word against Tyrus and isles; Nebuchadrezzar is coming to conquer them.
3276. Ezekiel 27:1-36 Lamentation of God for Tyrus; merchants coming against them with terror.
3277. Ezekiel 28:1-19 God accusing Tyrus of claiming to be god; their corrupted wisdom; they are full of iniquities.
3278. Ezekiel 28:20 God speaking against Zidon and again gathering the House of Israel to know Him.
3279. Ezekiel 29:1-7 God's word against Pharaoh of Egypt (Great Dragon) because he says the Nile River was his.
3280. Ezekiel 29:8-12 Egypt shall be a desolate waste to the border of Ethiopia and the people scattered for forty years.
3281. Ezekiel 29:13-21 Egypt is reunited but Nebuchadrezzar will conquer them and take them for prey.
3282. Ezekiel 30:1-19 Egypt's doom; Ethiopia, Libya, Lydia, and Chub are lands full of those slain by Babylon.
3283. Ezekiel 30:20-26 Pharaoh of Egypt is broken by Babylon, its survivors are scattered throughout the nations.
3284. Ezekiel 31:1-18 Death and hell to Egypt and Assyrians; the great trees of Eden are broken and Lebanon too.
3285. Ezekiel 32:1-32 God's continued condemnation of Egypt and His promise of their destruction.
3286. Ezekiel 33:1-20 God's words on Watchmen (Preachers and Prophets) on their responsibility to warn and save repenters.

3287. Ezekiel 33:21-33 Ezekiel receives word that Jerusalem is smitten; he warns Israel.
3288. Ezekiel 34:1-31 God's word to Israel's shepherds not being effective and being destroyed; God says He will rescue Israel.
3289. Ezekiel 35:1-15 God against Mt. Seir and cities; "The slain will cover the hills and valleys!"
3290. Ezekiel 36:1-38 God's word to Israel, "If you repent I will do great wonders for you."
3291. Ezekiel 37:1-2 Ezekiel is carried in the spirit by God and set down in a valley full of dry bones.
3292. Ezekiel 37:3-6 God tells Ezekiel to prophesy to the dry bones and they will become humans.
3293. Ezekiel 37:7-8 As Ezekiel prophesies, the bones come together with flesh and skin, but no life.
3294. Ezekiel 37:9-10 God has Ezekiel prophesy to the winds, which bring breath; the beings stand to their feet, a great army.
3295. Ezekiel 37:11-14 God says the bones are the whole House of Israel; the graves will open and their spirit will return.
3296. Ezekiel 37:15-28 God has Ezekiel take sticks and write the tribes' names; Israel and Judah are reunited; the House of David shall rule them forever.
3297. Ezekiel 38:1-7 God's word on Gog and Magog, Meshech, Tubal, Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya; God will put hooks in their jaws.
3298. Ezekiel 38:8-15 The enemy, especially from the North, is coming to conquer the land, mighty armies riding on horses.
3299. Ezekiel 38:16-23 Gog against Israel; earthquake; sword of brother against brother; rain of hailstones, fire, and brimstones; all will know God is Lord.

3300. Ezekiel 39:1-7 More prophesy against Gog; destruction with fire; Israel will not be polluted any more.
3301. Ezekiel 39:8-10 Israel will burn all weapons of war for seven years and spoil the enemy.
3302. Ezekiel 39:11-12 The burial of the dead of Gog will take seven months; the stench will close the noses of all passing by at the Valley of Passengers in the Valley of Hamon-gog at the east end of the sea.
3303. Ezekiel 39:13-16 Continual employees will bury the enemy; a flag will be planted everywhere a body is found.
3304. Ezekiel 39:17-29 Fowls (buzzards, etc.) and beasts will be employed by God to eat the dead and drink their blood.
3305. Ezekiel 40:1-49 God brings Ezekiel to a brass angel on a mountain and gives him the total dimensions of a "City of the South."
3306. Ezekiel 41:1-26 An angel shows Ezekiel the fashion and dimensions of the New Temple.
3307. Ezekiel 42:1-20 Angel shows more of Temple size and the places of duty of the Temple Priests.
3308. Ezekiel 43:1-27 God plants Himself in the midst of the Temple and sets laws for Israel and for the burnt offerings.
3309. Ezekiel 44:1-3 God sanctifies the Sanctuary outward; (East) gate is reserved for God (or Prince) entry.
3310. Ezekiel 44:4-16 No uncircumcised are allowed in the Temple; duties of all workers and priests.
3311. Ezekiel 44:17-18 No wool garments are allowed for the Priests, they must wear bonnets on their heads and linen breeches; they are not allowed to sweat.

3312. Ezekiel 44:19-21 Priests must change their garments to minister; they may have no short hair and may drink no wine.
3313. Ezekiel 44:22-31 Priests must marry only maidens, they shall judge the people, and they can not touch any dead body except family members.
3314. Ezekiel 45:1-25 God gives instructions for sizes of Holy Places and weights and measures to use.
3315. Ezekiel 46:1-24 God's instructions for Temple worship and the granting of inheritances to royal families.
3316. Ezekiel 47:1-23 God's word on inheritances of land for Israel, food gathering, fishing, and healing waters.
3317. Ezekiel 48:1-29 Holy oblation size, borders and how they touch the twelve tribes' territories.
3318. Ezekiel 48:30-34 Gates of the Holy City are named for the twelve tribes of Israel, including Joseph but not his sons (the one-half tribes).
3319. Ezekiel 48:35 Size of the Holy City and name: "The Lord is There."
