

FIRST CORINTHIANS

1829. 1st Corinthians 1:1-4 Paul's greeting to the Corinthian Church; an apostle of Jesus with Sosthenes, our brother.
1830. 1st Corinthians 1:5-9 Paul, "Be enriched by Jesus in knowledge and testimony; have all gifts; be blameless, Jesus called you."
1831. 1st Corinthians 1:10-11 Speak the same thing and have no divisions; the House of Chloe says you have contentions among you.
1832. 1st Corinthians 1:12-13 Some of you are of Paul, Apollos, Cephas, or Christ; Christ is not so divided; Paul wasn't crucified for you; you weren't baptized in the name of Paul.
1833. 1st Corinthians 1:14-16 Paul, "I only baptized Crispus, Gaius, and the household of Stephen; I never baptized in my own name."
1834. 1st Corinthians 1:17-18 Christ sent me to preach the Gospel, not with big words; preaching the Cross is foolishness to unbelievers.
1835. 1st Corinthians 1:19-21 God says that He will destroy the wisdom of the wise and make foolish the wisdom of the world.
1836. 1st Corinthians 1:22-25 Paul says that the Jews require a sign, the Greeks seek wisdom, and we preach Christ crucified which is a stumbling block to the Jews and foolishness to the Greeks.
1837. 1st Corinthians 1:26 Included in God's calling will not be many wise men after the flesh nor will many mighty or noble be called.
1838. 1st Corinthians 1:27-31 God chooses the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; we may only glory in Jesus.

1839. 1st Corinthians 2:1-6 We do not use excellency of speech, just Jesus crucified and the power of God; the world's wisdom comes to naught.
1840. 1st Corinthians 2:7-8 God ordained hidden wisdom before the world; world princes didn't know it, else they would not have crucified Jesus.
1841. 1st Corinthians 2:9-14 The world hasn't seen nor heard what God has prepared for His; man knows man; God is known through the Spirit; the Spirit searches the deep things of God.
1842. 1st Corinthians 2:15-16 HE THAT IS SPIRITUAL JUDGES ALL THINGS; HE, HIMSELF IS JUDGED OF NO MAN; THE SPIRITUAL HAVE THE MIND OF CHRIST.
1843. 1st Corinthians 3:1-3 Paul speaks to the Corinthians of their spiritual deficits of feeding milk, not meat, to the sinful.
1844. 1st Corinthians 3:4-9 Divisions exist between Paul and Apollos; only God gives the increase; rewards come equal to labor.
1845. 1st Corinthians 3:10-13 Paul has laid the foundation of Jesus Christ; others must build upon it and must withstand fire.
1846. 1st Corinthians 3:14-17 Work brings reward; you are The Temple Of God; His Spirit is in you; it is Holy, do not defile it.
1847. 1st Corinthians 3:18 IF ANY AMONG YOU SEEMS TO BE WISE IN THIS WORLD, LET HIM BECOME A FOOL THAT HE MAY BE WISE.
1848. 1st Corinthians 3:19 THE WISDOM OF THIS WORLD IS FOOLISHNESS WITH GOD; HE TAKES THE WISE IN THEIR OWN

CRAFTINESS.

1849. 1st Corinthians 3:20 THE LORD KNOWS THE THOUGHTS OF THE WISE, THAT THEY ARE VAIN.
1850. 1st Corinthians 3:21-23 Don't glory in men; all things are yours; you are Christ's and Christ is God's.
1851. 1st Corinthians 4:1-2 Ministers and Stewards must give account of the mysteries of God; they must be found faithful.
1852. 1st Corinthians 4:3-4 Paul, "Your judgment is small; I am justified; He that judges me is the Lord."
1853. 1st Corinthians 4:5-6 Don't judge prematurely; the Lord will reveal hidden things; don't be puffed up against another.
1854. 1st Corinthians 4:7-11 Don't claim superiority; as Apostles, we are fools for Christ; we are naked, buffeted, and have no home.
1855. 1st Corinthians 4:12-14 We labor, we are reviled, we bless, we suffer, we are defamed, and we are the filth of the world; I don't shame you, I warn you.
1856. 1st Corinthians 4:15-21 You have many instructors and few fathers; I send Timothy to you; don't be puffed up because I come in love.
1857. 1st Corinthians 5:1 Fornication is reported among you Jews, not Gentiles, even to having your fathers' wives.
1858. 1st Corinthians 5:2-3 You are puffed up, ignoring this terrible deed; the guilty must be purged; I judge this deed for you.
1859. 1st Corinthians 5:4-5 Gather in Jesus' power to deliver the fornicators to Satan for destruction of the flesh to save the spirit.

1860. 1st Corinthians 5:6-8 Your glorying is bad; a little badness leavens the whole with wickedness and must be purged.
1861. 1st Corinthians 5:9-13 I wrote of fornicators; don't keep company with sinners; put away from you wicked persons.
1862. 1st Corinthians 6:1 NO CHRISTIAN HAVING A MATTER AGAINST A FELLOW CHRISTIAN CAN GO TO A CIVIL COURT.
1863. 1st Corinthians 6:2-3 Saints shall judge the world; we shall even judge angels and all things of this life.
1864. 1st Corinthians 6:4-8 Paul shames the Corinthians for the shame of having none wise enough to judge and going to civil courts.
1865. 1st Corinthians 6:9-10 UNRIGHTEOUS, FORNICATORS, IDOLATERS, ADULTERERS AND EFFEMINATE SINNERS WILL NOT INHERIT THE KINGDOM OF GOD.
1866. 1st Corinthians 6:11-12 Some of you are washed, sanctified, and justified by Jesus, yet things you do can be lawful but still sinful.
1867. 1st Corinthians 6:13-17 The body is a temple not for sin, a member of Christ; it is not to be joined to a harlot, joined in one spirit with her.
1868. 1st Corinthians 6:18-20 Fornication is sin against your body; the body is a temple of The Holy Ghost; God owns you.
1869. 1st Corinthians 7:1-2 IT IS BETTER FOR A MAN NOT TO TOUCH A WOMAN; BUT TO AVOID FORNICATION, LET MAN AND WOMAN MARRY.

1870. 1st Corinthians 7:3-6 Give due husband and wife; have power over each other; give sexual relations to avoid sin, except for special reasons.
1871. 1st Corinthians 7:7-9 Paul wishes all men could be like him, but if they can't contain their sexual urges, it is better to marry than to burn.
1872. 1st Corinthians 7:10-13 You can have no divorce; if you separate, remain unmarried; never be married to an unbeliever; you may stay or go.
1873. 1st Corinthians 7:14 An unbelieving husband can be sanctified by a sanctified wife or visa versa, else their children will be unclean and not holy.
1874. 1st Corinthians 7:15-16 Let the unbelieving mate depart; the other is not under bondage; it is unknown if the other will be saved.
1875. 1st Corinthians 7:17-19 Follow your calling; if you are circumcised, stay; if not, it is alright; circumcision is nothing.
1876. 1st Corinthians 7:20-24 Stay in your calling; you are bought with a price; be a servant of God, not of man.
1877. 1st Corinthians 7:25-26 Concerning virgins, Paul has no commandment; it is permissible for a man or a woman to be a virgin.
1878. 1st Corinthians 7:27-31 Stay bound in marriage; marriage brings trouble in the flesh; the world is changing.
1879. 1st Corinthians 7:32-36 The unmarried care for the Lord; married care for their mates; if a virgin is touched, the man must marry her.
1880. 1st Corinthians 7:37-40 A man keeping a virgin is permissible; if one's mate dies, it is alright to marry; the single are happiest.

1881. 1st Corinthians 8:1-5 Idols and offerings to idols are nothing; there are many false gods and false lords.
1882. 1st Corinthians 8:6 We have only one God, The Father, and one Lord Jesus Christ by whom are all things made.
1883. 1st Corinthians 8:7-12 An idol offering eaten is not sin, but may make a brother stumble and perish though; Jesus died for him.
1884. 1st Corinthians 8:13 **IF MEAT OFFENDS MY BROTHER, I WILL NEVER EAT FLESH BECAUSE IT WOULD MAKE HIM STUMBLE.**
1885. 1st Corinthians 9:1-2 Paul, "I'm an apostle, I'm free, I've seen Jesus; you are my work, my seal of apostleship in Jesus."
1886. 1st Corinthians 9:3-10 We have power to lead; war against evil; we are entitled to our rewards; we have hope.
1887. 1st Corinthians 9:11-15 We sow spiritual things; we live what we preach; we reap and we live the Gospel.
1888. 1st Corinthians 9:16-19 I am not proud; I willingly serve Jesus, my reward; I am servant to all to gain souls.
1889. 1st Corinthians 9:20-21 I am a Jew to win Jesus; I'm with or without the law that I might win those with or without the law.
1890. 1st Corinthians 9:22 **TO THE WEAK I AM WEAK; I AM ALL THINGS TO ALL MEN THAT I MIGHT, BY ALL MEANS, SAVE SOME.**
1891. 1st Corinthians 9:23-27 I serve the Gospel, run the race for an incorruptible crown, and bring my body

into subjection.

1892. 1st Corinthians 10:1-3 Be informed of Moses' exodus; all were baptized unto him by cloud and sea, all eating the same spiritual meat.
1893. 1st Corinthians 10:4 All drank the same spiritual drink, the Rock that followed them; that Rock was Jesus.
1894. 1st Corinthians 10:5-12 Wilderness sins and God's reward; 23 thousand die in one day; others are killed by serpents; learn from this.
1895. 1st Corinthians 10:13 **THERE IS NO TEMPTATION ON YOU THAT IS NOT COMMON TO MAN, BUT GOD IS FAITHFUL; HE WILL NOT ALLOW YOU TO BE TEMPTED ABOVE WHAT YOU CAN WITHSTAND, BUT WILL MAKE A WAY TO ESCAPE SO THAT YOU CAN BEAR IT.**
1896. 1st Corinthians 10:14-17 Be free from idolatry; the cup we bless is Jesus' Blood and the Bread is His Body; we are one in it.
1897. 1st Corinthians 10:18-19 Israel is of the flesh; they eat the sacrifices and offer them to idols.
1898. 1st Corinthians 10:20 Gentiles sacrifice to devils, not to God; do not have fellowship with devils.
1899. 1st Corinthians 10:21-23 You can not drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of devils; do not provoke God; lawful things may not be of God.
1900. 1st Corinthians 10:24-26 Work for another's wealth, not yours; eat poor food set before you; the earth is the Lord's.
1901. 1st Corinthians 10:27 When invited to an unbeliever's banquet, eat what is given to you, and ask no questions.

1902. 1st Corinthians 10:28-33 Do not offend in eating with nonbelievers except idol offerings; do all for God's glory to save men.
1903. 1st Corinthians 11:1-2 Paul tells the Corinthians to follow him as he does Jesus and to follow all ordinances given them.
1904. 1st Corinthians 11:3 The head of every man is Jesus; the head of a woman is a man; the head of Christ Jesus is God.
1905. 1st Corinthians 11:4-7 Paul's word on a man and a woman covering their heads at church; a man must not have a covering; a woman must have a covering or have her head shaved.
1906. 1st Corinthians 11:8-13 Woman is of man, created for him; their relationship; woman covering her head for prayer.
1907. 1st Corinthians 11:14-15 Nature teaches that if a man has long hair, it is a shame unto him; long hair is a glory to a woman.
1908. 1st Corinthians 11:16-19 Paul says that some churches may vary and that he hears that there are divisions among them and heresies.
1909. 1st Corinthians 11:20-22 Paul expresses problems of eating in church; only The Lord's Supper should be eaten in church; all other eating should be done at home.
1910. 1st Corinthians 11:23-29 Paul speaks on the ritual and charges of The Lord's Supper; if eaten unworthy, it will bring damnation.
1911. 1st Corinthians 11:30-34 Many are sick and die for unworthy Lord's Supper; for hunger, eat at home.
1912. 1st Corinthians 12:1-3 Paul on Spiritual Gifts, "You were Gentiles with idols; Jesus is Lord only

by the Holy Spirit."

1913. 1st Corinthians 12:4-7 Paul on diversities of Gifts, all by the same Spirit, administrations and operations; the Spirit is given for profit.
1914. 1st Corinthians 12:8-11 THE SPIRITUAL GIFTS ARE: WISDOM, KNOWLEDGE, FAITH, HEALING, MIRACLES, PROPHECY, DISCERNMENT OF SPIRITS, DIVER'S TONGUES, AND INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES; EACH PERSON MAY HAVE SEVERAL GIFTS.
1915. 1st Corinthians 12:12-14 The Body Of Christ has several members; Jews or Gentiles have the same Spirit; bond or free have the same Spirit.
1916. 1st Corinthians 12:15-27 Body members are not superior to each other; all are needed for the whole; when one suffers, all suffer.
1917. 1st Corinthians 12:28 God has set in the church APOSTLES, PROPHETS, TEACHERS, MIRACLE WORKERS, HEALERS, HELPERS, GOVERNMENTS, AND DIVERSITIES OF TONGUES.
1918. 1st Corinthians 12:29-31 None can do everything; covet earnestly the best gifts; Paul shows a more excellent way.
1919. 1st Corinthians 13:1-13 THE LOVE CHAPTER. "THOUGH I HAVE ALL THINGS AND DO NOT HAVE LOVE, I AM NOTHING!"
1920. 1st Corinthians 14:1 Follow charity (love) with desire for Spiritual Gifts and desire to prophesy.
1921. 1st Corinthians 14:2 ONE SPEAKING IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE, SPEAKS TO GOD; MAN DOESN'T UNDERSTAND IT; IN

SPIRIT, HE SPEAKS MYSTERIES.

1922. 1st Corinthians 14:3 One who speaks prophecy, speaks to men for edification, exhortation, and comfort.
1923. 1st Corinthians 14:4 One speaking an unknown tongue edifies himself; prophesying edifies the church.
1924. 1st Corinthians 14:5 PAUL WISHES THAT ALL SPOKE IN TONGUES, BUT MORE, THAT ALL PROPHESED, WHICH IS BETTER UNLESS THERE IS INTERPRETATION OF THE UNKNOWN TONGUES, THAT THE CHURCH MAY RECEIVE EDIFYING.
1925. 1st Corinthians 14:6 Paul says, "WHAT WILL TONGUES PROFIT YOU UNLESS IT IS REVELATION, KNOWLEDGE, PROPHECY, OR DOCTRINE?"
1926. 1st Corinthians 14:7 Tongues are like a pipe or harp out of tune, unless tuned, they make no sense.
1927. 1st Corinthians 14:8-9 A trumpet with an uncertain sound in battle is chaos; tongues not understood are like words in the air.
1928. 1st Corinthians 14:10-12 Paul, "The voice has significance; if I don't understand, I'm a barbarian; seek gifts that edify the church."
1929. 1st Corinthians 14:13-14 HE SPEAKING IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE MUST INTERPRET; IN SUCH, MY SPIRIT PRAYS BUT IT CAN'T BE UNDERSTOOD.
1930. 1st Corinthians 14:15-17 Pray and sing with the Spirit for understanding, else the congregation, unlearned, can't say amen; you give

thanks well, but others are not edified.

1931. 1st Corinthians 14:18 PAUL SAYS, "I THANK MY GOD THAT I SPEAK WITH TONGUES MORE THAN ALL OF YOU."
1932. 1st Corinthians 14:19 Paul: "IN CHURCH I WOULD RATHER SPEAK FIVE WORDS WITH UNDERSTANDING THAT TEACH THAN TEN THOUSAND WORDS IN AN UNKNOWN TONGUE."
1933. 1st Corinthians 14:20-21 Don't be children, but men, in understanding; the Lord says that tongues are not understood.
1934. 1st Corinthians 14:22 Signs are given to unbelievers by tongues; prophesying is for believers.
1935. 1st Corinthians 14:23-24 IF AN UNLEARNED ENTERS THE CHURCH WITH ALL SPEAKING IN TONGUES, HE WILL THINK ALL THERE ARE CRAZY; BUT IF ALL ARE PROPHECYING, HE WILL BE CONVINCED.
1936. 1st Corinthians 14:25-26 Prophesying will save souls; let all of each service edify Jesus with all things.
1937. 1st Corinthians 14:27-28 SPEAK UNKNOWN TONGUES ONLY BY TWO OR THREE; ONE MUST INTERPRET; IF NOT, DON'T SPEAK.
1938. 1st Corinthians 14:29-32 Prophets must speak only by two's or three's so that all may learn, subject to the Spirit.
1939. 1st Corinthians 14:33 GOD IS NOT THE AUTHOR OF CONFUSION, BUT OF PEACE, AS IN ALL CHURCHES OF THE SAINTS.

1940. 1st Corinthians 14:34 PAUL: "LET YOUR WOMEN KEEP SILENCE IN THE CHURCHES; THEY ARE COMMANDED TO OBEY SAYS THE LAW."
1941. 1st Corinthians 14:35 PAUL: "IF THEY MUST LEARN, LET THEM ASK THEIR HUSBANDS AT HOME; IT IS A SHAME FOR WOMEN TO SPEAK IN THE CHURCHES."
1942. 1st Corinthians 14:36-40 You are only one church that God speaks to; you may be ignorant or a prophet; do not forbid tongues; be in order.
1943. 1st Corinthians 15:1-4 Paul declares the Gospel Of Jesus and salvation by His death, burial, and resurrection.
1944. 1st Corinthians 15:5-8 NUMBERS OF PEOPLE JESUS WAS SEEN BY AFTER HIS RESURRECTION AND BEFORE HIS ASCENSION.
1945. 1st Corinthians 15:9-12 Paul, "I am the least apostle; I persecuted the church; Grace saved me; some say that Jesus didn't resurrect."
1946. 1st Corinthians 15:13-18 Paul, "There is resurrection from the dead, if not, our salvation is void and all that are dead in Christ have perished."
1947. 1st Corinthians 15:19-23 If only in life we have Jesus, we are miserable; we die in Adam and live forever in Jesus.
1948. 1st Corinthians 15:24-28 The end comes and the Kingdom is delivered to God; all authority is put down and the last enemy is death.
1949. 1st Corinthians 15:29 What of those baptized for the dead? If the dead do not arise, why then is that done?

1950. 1st Corinthians 15:30-34 Don't stand in jeopardy; die daily for Jesus; if the dead don't arise, eat, drink, and be merry, for tomorrow we die; sin not.
1951. 1st Corinthians 15:35-39 How are the dead raised and in what form? Like seed dying and new grain rises; all flesh is different.
1952. 1st Corinthians 15:40 There are celestial bodies and terrestrial bodies; the glory of each is separate.
1953. 1st Corinthians 15:41 There is one glory of the sun, another of the moon, and another of the stars; they differ.
1954. 1st Corinthians 15:42-43 The dead are sown in corruption and raised in incorruption, sown in dishonor and raised in glory, sown in weakness and raised in power.
1955. 1st Corinthians 15-44 The dead are sown a natural body and raised a spiritual body; each has these two bodies.
1956. 1st Corinthians 15:45 The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam became a quickening spirit.
1957. 1st Corinthians 15:46-49 The natural is first earthly; the heavenly image will be different.
1958. 1st Corinthians 15:50 Flesh and blood cannot enter the Kingdom of God (Heaven); corruption cannot inherit incorruption.
1959. 1st Corinthians 15:51 PAUL: "BEHOLD, I SHOW YOU A MYSTERY; WE SHALL NOT ALL SLEEP (DIE) BUT WE SHALL BE CHANGED."

1960. 1st Corinthians 15:52 IN A MOMENT, IN THE TWINKLING OF AN EYE, AT THE LAST TRUMP, THE TRUMPET SHALL SOUND AND THE DEAD SHALL BE RAISED INCORRUPTIBLE, AND WE SHALL BE CHANGED.
1961. 1st Corinthians 15:53-54 When the corruptible puts on incorruption, then is the saying, "Death is swallowed up in victory."
1962. 1st Corinthians 15:55 OH DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? OH GRAVE, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY?
1963. 1st Corinthians 15:56 The sting of death is sin and the strength of sin is the law.
1964. 1st Corinthians 15:57-58 Thank God for the victory through Jesus; be steadfast in the Lord; your labor is not in vain.
1965. 1st Corinthians 16:1-2 Paul, "Concerning the collection for the Saints, you and Galatia lay up stores as God has prospered you, at the first day of the week, so that there will be no gatherings when I come."
1966. 1st Corinthians 16:3-5 When I come your letters will approve those to Jerusalem; I'll come after passing through Macedonia.
1967. 1st Corinthians 16:6-9 I may winter with you; I'll stay at Ephesus until Pentecost; the doors are opened but there are many adversaries.
1968. 1st Corinthians 16:10-11 If Timothy comes to you, trust and help him without fear; he works for the Lord; he comes with me.
1969. 1st Corinthians 16:12-14 I hoped that Apollos would come but he is delayed; stand fast in the Faith, strong men with charity.

1970. 1st Corinthians 16:15-16 Conduct yourselves as Stephen, the first fruits of Achaia, addicted to ministry of Saints.
1971. 1st Corinthians 16:17-18 I'm glad that Stephen, Fortunatus, and Achaicus have supplied for you; they have refreshed us.
1972. 1st Corinthians 16:19 The Churches of Asia salute you; Aquila and Priscilla salute you in the Lord from their church home.
1973. 1st Corinthians 16:20-21 All brethren salute you and greet you with a kiss; do so too; I salute you.
1974. 1st Corinthians 16:22-24 Anyone not loving Jesus, let him be anathema (prohibited from) Maranatha. The Grace of Jesus be with you; my love to you in Jesus' Name - Amen.
