

## FIRST PETER

2666. 1st Peter 1:1-4 Peter's greeting to missionaries he does not know across Asia Minor, declaring Jesus and salvation by His death, resurrection and mercy.
2667. 1st Peter 1:5-6 You have the power of God through faith; rejoice, it will take you through heaviness and temptations
2668. 1st Peter 1:7 The trials of your faith by fire are more precious than gold; we trust that they be found with honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus.
2669. 1st Peter 1:8 You love Jesus and believe in Him Whom you have not seen and you rejoice with joy unspeakable, full of glory.
2670. 1st Peter 1:9-10 You received the salvation for which the prophets inquired and searched diligently, prophesying that it could come to you.
2671. 1st Peter 1:11 The prophets searched for knowledge of the coming of Jesus, His Suffering, Spirit, and Glory.
2672. 1st Peter 1:12 The prophets learned that their ministry would be given to preachers of Jesus by the Holy Ghost, sent down by angels which saw to its application.
2673. 1st Peter 1:13-14 Keep your minds positive for the Grace and Revelation of Jesus; forget your past lusts and ignorance.
2674. 1st Peter 1:15-16 As God is Holy, we must be holy in all conversation; He wrote: "BE HOLY FOR I AM HOLY."
2675. 1st Peter 1:17-18 FEAR WHEN YOU CALL ON GOD; HE JUDGES WORKS, NOT RICHES,

TRADITION, NOR FAMILY.

2676. 1st Peter 1:19-20 WE ARE REDEEMED ONLY BY JESUS' BLOOD, ORDAINED BEFORE CREATION AND NOW AVAILABLE.
2677. 1st Peter 1:21-23 Jesus brings belief in God; He purifies our souls through Spirit, Love, and The Word Of God.
2678. 1st Peter 1:24-25 Flesh fades like grass; God's Word endures forever as the Gospel preached to us.
2679. 1st Peter 2:1-2 Lay aside all evil things and as newborns, desire sincere milk of the Word to grow.
2680. 1st Peter 2:3-5 The milk proves that God is gracious and that Jesus is a Stone, Precious; we too are chosen as priests to give.
2681. 1st Peter 2:6 God has laid a Cornerstone in Zion, elect and precious; believers on it will not be confounded.
2682. 1st Peter 2:7-8 To believers, He is precious; to unbelievers He is a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense toward God's Word.
2683. 1st Peter 2:9 YOU ARE A CHOSEN GENERATION, A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PECULIAR PEOPLE, SHOWING PRAISE OF HIM WHO CALLED YOU FROM DARKNESS INTO HIS MARVELLOUS LIGHT.
2684. 1st Peter 2:10 In the past you were not a people who had obtained mercy; now you are a people of God and mercy.

2685. 1st Peter 2:11-12 Abstain from fleshly lusts that destroy souls; set an example before the Gentiles to make them ready for Jesus' Coming.
2686. 1st Peter 2:13-15 Submit to secular law and those over you; with well doing, you silence ignorant men.
2687. 1st Peter 2:16-17 Do not use your freedom maliciously, but as servants, honor all men, fear God, and honor the King.
2688. 1st Peter 2:18-20 Servants obey your masters with fear and endure grief patiently, which is acceptable with God.
2689. 1st Peter 2:21-23 We are called because Jesus suffered an example to follow, sinless, He threatened not His tormentors but committed Himself to The Righteous Judge, God.
2690. 1st Peter 2:24-25 HE BORE OUR SINS ON THE CROSS TO GIVE US LIFE; BY HIS STRIPES WE ARE HEALED; AS SHEEP ASTRAY, HE RETURNED US TO HIMSELF, THE SHEPHERD AND BISHOP OF OUR SOULS.
2691. 1st Peter 3:1-2 WIVES, BE SUBJECT TO YOUR HUSBANDS EVEN IF THEY ARE UNBELIEVERS, THAT THEY WILL BE WON BY YOUR CONVERSATION AND CHASTITY, AND BY THEIR FEAR.
2692. 1st Peter 3:3-4 WIVES, DON'T ADORN YOURSELVES WITH JEWELS, EXPENSIVE CLOTHES, OR PLATTING OF YOUR HAIR, BUT ADORN YOURSELVES INSIDE WITH A PURE HEART, MEEKNESS, AND A QUIET SPIRIT; AS SUCH YOU WILL BE OF GREAT VALUE

TO GOD.

2693. 1st Peter 3:5-6 Holy women of old adorned themselves modestly, respecting their husbands as Sarah did Abraham.
2694. 1st Peter 3:7 Husbands, give honor to your wives as the weaker vessel, heirs together for life's grace.
2695. 1st Peter 3:8-9 Be of one mind, compassionate, loving, pitying, courteous, with no evil for evil, called and inheriting blessings.
2696. 1st Peter 3:10-13 Love life, refrain your tongue, and seek peace; The Lord sees and hears us; there is no harm for goodness.
2697. 1st Peter 3:14 Be happy to suffer for your righteousness; don't be afraid of the enemy's terror.
2698. 1st Peter 3:15 Always be ready to give your testimony with meekness; sanctify Jesus in your hearts.
2699. 1st Peter 3:16 Have a good conscience so that if you are accused of being an evildoer, the enemy will be ashamed.
2700. 1st Peter 3:17-18 God wills that we suffer for good rather than evil as Jesus did in the death of His Flesh but not His Spirit.
2701. 1st Peter 3:19 Jesus went and preached to the Spirits in prison (possibly means His imprisoned disciples).
2702. 1st Peter 3:20 Sometimes spirits are disobedient as when God waited for Noah's ark with only eight souls saved.

2703. 1st Peter 3:21            Baptism's spiritual aspect saves us with good conscience toward God and with Jesus' resurrection.
2704. 1st Peter 3:22            JESUS IS IN HEAVEN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD; ALL ANGELS, AUTHORITIES, AND POWERS ARE SUBJECT TO HIM.
2705. 1st Peter 4:1-2            As Jesus suffered in the flesh, we who suffered must live without sin until death, with no fleshly lusts, but in the will of God.
2706. 1st Peter 4:3              The Gentiles were more happy with us when we were lascivious, lusting, drunken, reveling, and having abominable idolatries.
2707. 1st Peter 4:4-5            The Gentiles think that it is strange that we don't still sin with them, but we must give account to God.
2708. 1st Peter 4:6              THE GOSPEL IS PREACHED TO THE DEAD SO THEY CAN BE JUDGED AS ALIVE, LIVING IN THE SPIRIT.
2709. 1st Peter 4:7              The end of things is near, so be sober, watch and pray.
2710. 1st Peter 4:8              ABOVE ALL THINGS, HAVE CHARITY (LOVE) AMONG YOURSELVES, FOR LOVE SHALL COVER A MULTITUDE OF SINS.
2711. 1st Peter 4:9-10          Use hospitality toward each other, ungrudgingly; each of us has a gift or gifts; we are to minister these to each other as good stewards of God's Manifold Grace.
2712. 1st Peter 4:11            Speakers must, as with the oracles of God, minister as God gives, that God

may be glorified through Jesus Christ.

2713. 1st Peter 4:12-13 Do not think that God's fiery trial of you is strange; rejoice to be partakers of Jesus' sufferings so that when His Glory is revealed, you may be joyful.
2714. 1st Peter 4:14 If reproached for Jesus, be happy that God's Spirit Of Glory rests upon you; they speak evil of God; you glorify Him.
2715. 1st Peter 4:15 You do not suffer as a murderer, thief, evildoer, or busybody when another is guilty.
2716. 1st Peter 4:16 If you suffer for being a Christian, be not ashamed, but glorify God for it.
2717. 1st Peter 4:17 THE TIME HAS COME FOR JUDGMENT TO BEGIN IN OUR CHURCHES FIRST; IF WE ARE SINFUL, IMAGINE HOW SINFUL THOSE ARE WHO DON'T OBEY GOD'S GOSPEL, AND THEIR END.
2718. 1st Peter 4:18 IF THE RIGHTEOUS ARE BARELY SAVED, WHERE SHALL THE UNGODLY SINNER APPEAR?
2719. 1st Peter 4:19 If you suffer for the Will Of God, keep your soul to Him in well doing to A Faithful Creator.
2720. 1st Peter 5:1-2 I exhort you as fellow elders who are witnesses of Jesus to feed the people among you, overseeing not with constraint of filthy gain, but willingly with a ready mind.
2721. 1st Peter 5:3-4 Do not be lords, but examples of God's heritage so that when Jesus comes you will receive a Crown Of Glory that never fades.

2722. 1st Peter 5:5  
You who are younger must submit yourselves unto the Elders; be subject to each other, clothed in humility; God resists the proud and gives grace to the humble.
2723. 1st Peter 5:6-7  
HUMBLE YOURSELVES UNDER THE MIGHTY HAND OF GOD SO HE CAN EXALT YOU IN DUE TIME; CAST ALL OF YOUR CARES UPON GOD, FOR HE CARES FOR YOU.
2724. 1st Peter 5:8  
BE SOBER AND VIGILANT; THE DEVIL IS ROARING, MOVING AROUND, SEEKING THOSE HE MAY DEVOUR.
2725. 1st Peter 5:9  
Resist the Devil with your faith, knowing that your brethren have fallen to him.
2726. 1st Peter 5:10  
May The God Of Grace Who called us to Glory by Jesus after we suffered, make us perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle us.
2727. 1st Peter 5:11  
To God be glory and dominion forever. Amen.
2728. 1st Peter 5:12  
Silvanus, my brother helped me write to you that this exhortation and testimony is the true Grace Of God in which we stand.
2729. 1st Peter 5:13  
The Babylon Church, elected together with you, salutes you, as does Marcus, my son.
2730. 1st Peter 5:14  
Greet each other with a love kiss; peace be to all of you who are in Jesus. Amen.
