

FIRST TIMOTHY

2294. 1st Timothy 1:1-3 Paul's greeting to Timothy, having placed him at Ephesus, writing a change from Macedonia.
2295. 1st Timothy 1:4 Ignore fables and endless generalogies that cause questions rather than edifying God.
2296. 1st Timothy 1:5-6 The commandment is charity from a pure heart; some have turned to vain jangling.
2297. 1st Timothy 1:7-8 SOME, WANTING TO TEACH LAW, DON'T KNOW IT; THE LAW IS GOOD IF USED RIGHT.
2298. 1st Timothy 1:9-10 LAW IS NOT MADE FOR THE RIGHTEOUS BUT FOR THE LAWLESS, UNGODLY, MURDERERS, AND UNSOUND.
2299. 1st Timothy 1:11-12 The Glorious Gospel was given to my trust; Jesus counted me faithful and put me into the ministry.
2300. 1st Timothy 1:13 I was before, a blasphemer, persecutor, injurious, ignorantly in unbelief, but I obtained mercy.
2301. 1st Timothy 1:14-15 Jesus gave abundant grace, love, and faith; JESUS CAME INTO THE WORLD TO SAVE SINNERS, OF WHICH I AM CHIEF.
2302. 1st Timothy 1:16-17 I am a longsuffering example for nonbelievers; unto the King Eternal, Immortal, Invisible, The Only Wise God, be honor and glory forever. Amen.

2303. 1st Timothy 1:18-19 Paul to Timothy, "I charge you to follow prophecies and war a good warfare, holding faith while some have lost faith and are shipwrecked."
2304. 1st Timothy 1:20 I have delivered Hymenaeus and Alexander to Satan that they may learn not to blaspheme.
2305. 1st Timothy 2:1-4 Supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanks must be made for kings and authorities.
2306. 1st Timothy 2:5 THERE IS ONE GOD AND ONE MEDIATOR BETWEEN GOD AND MEN, THE MAN JESUS CHRIST.
2307. 1st Timothy 2:6-7 JESUS GAVE HIMSELF A RANSOM FOR ALL, for testimony; I am His preacher to the Gentiles.
2308. 1st Timothy 2:8 MEN SHOULD PRAY EVERYWHERE, LIFTING UP HOLY HANDS, without wrath and doubting.
2309. 1st Timothy 2:9 WOMEN SHOULD ADORN THEMSELVES IN MODEST APPAREL, SOBERLY, WITHOUT BRAIDED HAIR, GOLD, PEARLS, OR COSTLY ARRAY.
2310. 1st Timothy 2:10 WOMEN SHOULD BE MODEST, PROFESSING GODLINESS WITH GOOD WORKS.
2311. 1st Timothy 2:11-12 Women must learn in silence and subjection, silent, not teaching or usurping authority over the man.
2312. 1st Timothy 2:13-15 Adam was first formed; Eve was deceived and transgressed, but she shall be saved in child bearing if she continues in faith, charity, and holiness with sobriety.

2313. 1st Timothy 3:1-2 IF A MAN DESIRES TO BE A BISHOP, HE DESIRES A GOOD WORK; A BISHOP MUST BE BLAMELESS, HUSBAND OF ONE WIFE, VIGILANT, SOBER, OF GOOD BEHAVIOR, HOSPITABLE, AND APT TO TEACH.
2314. 1st Timothy 3:3 A Bishop must not be given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre, patient, no brawler, and not covetous.
2315. 1st Timothy 3:4 A Bishop rules his home well and has children in subjection with all gravity.
2316. 1st Timothy 3:5 If a man can not rule his own home, how can he take care of the Church Of God?
2317. 1st Timothy 3:6-7 A Bishop must be mature, accepting pride without falling, and a good community reputation, lest he fall.
2318. 1st Timothy 3:8-9 A Deacon must be grave, not double tongued, not taking much wine, not greedy, and faithful with a pure conscience.
2319. 1st Timothy 3:10 A Deacon must be proven and only use the Office Of Deacon after being found blameless.
2320. 1st Timothy 3:11 A Deacon's Wife must be grave, not a slanderer, sober, and faithful in all things.
2321. 1st Timothy 3:12 A Deacon must be the husband of one wife, ruling his children and his home well.
2322. 1st Timothy 3:13 A Deacon's Office is a purchase of good degree and great boldness in the faith in Jesus.

2323. 1st Timothy 3:14-15 I come to you soon; behave yourselves in God's House, the Pillar of Truth.
2324. 1st Timothy 3:16 THE MYSTERY OF GODLINESS - GOD IN THE FLESH, IN THE SPIRIT, SEEN OF ANGELS, PREACHED TO GENTILES, BELIEVED UPON IN THE WORLD, AND RECEIVED UP INTO GLORY.
2325. 1st Timothy 4:1 The Spirit says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, given to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils.
2326. 1st Timothy 4:2-3 THEY WILL LIE IN HYPOCRISY, CONSCIENCE SEARED, FORBIDDING TO MARRY, COMMANDED TO OBSTAIN FROM MEATS (VEGETARIAN) WHICH GOD HAS CREATED TO BE EATEN WITH THANKSGIVING BY THOSE BELIEVING THE TRUTH.
2327. 1st Timothy 4:4 Every creature of God is good and shouldn't be refused if given with thanksgiving.
2328. 1st Timothy 4:5-6 Meat is sanctified by god; teach the brethren and be a good minister of Jesus with doctrine and faith.
2329. 1st Timothy 4:7-8 Refuse old wives tales; bodily exercise profits little but godliness profits all and is the promise of life.
2330. 1st Timothy 4:9-10 Accept this faithful saying that we suffer because we believe in God, The Savior of believers.
2331. 1st Timothy 4:11-12 Command and teach these things; let none despise your youth; be examples in word, conversation, charity, spirit, faith, and purity.

2332. 1st Timothy 4:13-14 Give effort to reading, exhortation, and doctrine; don't neglect your gift given by prophesy and the laying on of hands of the presbytery.
2333. 1st Timothy 4:15-16 Mediate and give wholly to gifts; prophet all; concentrate on doctrine, and save yourself and your hearers.
2334. 1st Timothy 5:1 NEVER REBUKE AN ELDER; TREAT HIM AS A FATHER AND YOUNGER MEN AS BROTHERS.
2335. 1st Timothy 5:2 TREAT ELDER WOMEN AS MOTHERS AND YOUNGER WOMEN AS SISTERS WITH ALL PURITY.
2336. 1st Timothy 5:3-4 Honor real widows; if they have family, require their family to support them.
2337. 1st Timothy 5:5 Real widows, desolate, must trust God and stay in prayer and supplication night and day.
2338. 1st Timothy 5:6 She who lives in pleasure (a loose woman) is dead while she lives.
2339. 1st Timothy 5:7-8 Be responsible and blameless; if one doesn't provide for his own, in his home, he has denied his faith and is worse than an infidel.
2340. 1st Timothy 5:9 A WIDOW MUST BE AT LEAST SIXTY YEARS OLD AND HAVE ONLY HAD ONE HUSBAND.
2341. 1st Timothy 5:10 Commend a widow of good works if she has reared children, lodged strangers, washed the Saints' feet, relieved the afflicted, and diligently followed every good work.
2342. 1st Timothy 5:11-12 Many younger widows refuse good conduct and leave Christ, marry, and

receive damnation.

2343. 1st Timothy 5:13 Many younger widows become idle, wander from house to house, and become tattlers and busy bodies, speaking things they shouldn't.
2344. 1st Timothy 5:14-15 Younger widows should marry, have children, guide the house, and give no occasion to sin; many have already turned to sin.
2345. 1st Timothy 5:16 BELIEVERS WITH WIDOWS IN THEIR HOMES MAY RELIEVE THEM AND NOT BE CHARGED BY THE CHURCH.
2346. 1st Timothy 5:17 Good elders who rule well and labor in the Bible and Doctrine should be given double honor.
2347. 1st Timothy 5:18 Don't muzzle an ox harvesting the grain; a laborer is worthy of his reward.
2348. 1st Timothy 5:19 NEVER ACCUSE AN ELDER OF SIN UNLESS YOU HAVE TWO OR THREE WITNESSES.
2349. 1st Timothy 5:20 THOSE WHO SIN, REBUKE PUBLICLY, SO THAT OTHERS WILL BE AFRAID TO SIN.
2350. 1st Timothy 5:21 Paul's charge with God and Jesus and angels that all acts be done without partiality.
2351. 1st Timothy 5:22 Don't attack another in a rage; don't participate in sin; keep yourself pure.
2352. 1st Timothy 5:23 YOU MAY LEAVE OFF WATER AND DRINK A LITTLE WINE FOR YOUR STOMACH AND SICKNESS.

2353. 1st Timothy 5:24-25 Some sin openly or follow others' sins; good works can not be hidden.
2354. 1st Timothy 6:1-2 Servants under yoke must honor their masters; believing masters are believing servants' brothers.
2355. 1st Timothy 6:3-5 Withdraw fellowship from those who teach other doctrines, that gain is godliness.
2356. 1st Timothy 6:6-7 Godliness with contentment is gain; we brought nothing into the world; we can take nothing out.
2357. 1st Timothy 6:8-9 Be content with food and raiment; the rich fall into a snare and foolish lusts which drown them in destruction and perdition.
2358. 1st Timothy 6:10 **THE LOVE OF MONEY IS THE ROOT OF ALL EVIL; COVETING IT IS AGAINST THE FAITH AND BRINGS SORROW.**
2359. 1st Timothy 6:11 The man of God flees from the love of money and is righteous, godly, faithful, loving, patient, and meek.
2360. 1st Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith; grasp eternal life which is your professing.
2361. 1st Timothy 6:13-16 Paul's charge to Timothy to follow Jesus, The Only King and Lord Who is immortal.
2362. 1st Timothy 6:17-19 Charge the rich to be humble, rich in works, laying up treasures for eternal life.
2363. 1st Timothy 6:20-21 Paul charges Timothy to avoid vain babblings and ignore scientific opposition to the faith.
