1. Genesis 1:1 Creation – 6 Days – Man is created on the 6th day.
2. Genesis 1:27 Man is made in the image of God, both spiritually and physically.
3. Genesis 1:28 God tells man, “be fruitful and multiply” on day 6.
4. Genesis 2:2 God rested on the 7th day.
5. Genesis 2:5-6 No rain on earth; rising mist irrigates the earth.
6. Genesis 2:7 Recap of God making man from dust, giving him breath and a soul.
7. Genesis 2:8 God making Garden Of Eden, placing man (Adam) therein (+ v 15).
8. Genesis 2:9 God plants Trees of Knowledge Of Good and Evil and Tree Of life in Garden Of Eden.
9. Genesis 2:10-14 Rivers of Garden Of Eden: (4 heads) Significant two are Gihon, possibly the Nile in Ethiopia and the Euphrates in Assyria. (This places the Garden Of Eden At the north shore of the Persian Gulf).
10. Genesis 2:17 God forbids man to eat from the Tree Of Knowledge Of Good and Evil.
11. Genesis 2:19-20 Adam names all animals.
12. Genesis 2:21-23 Eve is made from Adam’s rib; Adam names her “Woman” (Eve).
13. Genesis 2:24 God instructs man to leave his family for his wife.
14. Genesis 2:25 Adam and Eve are naked – they wear no clothes.

15. Genesis 3:1-6 Serpent comes on the scene and beguiles Eve to take and eat fruit from the Tree Of Knowledge Of Good And Evil.
16. Genesis 3:7 Both Eve and Adam eat of the forbidden fruit, discover sin, discover that they are naked, and make clothes to wear.
17. Genesis 3:8 Adam and Eve hear God coming in the garden and hide.
18. Genesis 3:12-13 Adam blames eating the forbidden fruit on Eve; Eve blames it on the serpent.
19. Genesis 3:14 God puts a curse on the serpent, takes away his legs.
20. Genesis 3:20 Adam gives Eve her name.
21. Genesis 3:21 God kills animals, makes clothes from their skins, and clothes Adam and Eve.
22. Genesis 3:22-23 God expels Adam and Eve from the Garden Of Eden.
23. Genesis 3:24 Cherubims and a flaming sword guard East side (gate) of Eden.
24. Genesis 4:1 First human sexual contact, conception, and birth of Cain (first child born on earth).
25. Genesis 4:2 Birth of Abel and occupations of Cain and Abel.
26. Genesis 4:3-7 Cain and Abel's offerings to God.
27. Genesis 4:8 Cain kills Abel.
28. Genesis 4:9-14 God's condemnation of Cain.
29. Genesis 4:15 God places mark upon Cain.
30. Genesis 4:16 Cain goes and dwells in "Nod", east of Eden.

- 31. Genesis 4:17 Cain takes a sister as his wife, she bears him a son named Enoch, and Cain builds the city of Enoch.
- 32. Genesis 4:18-24 Descendants of Cain.
- 33. Genesis 4:21 Descendant “Jubal” for word “jubilation.”
- 34. Genesis 4:23 Lamech says he has killed two descendants.
- 35. Genesis 4:25 Adam and Eve have third son “Seth.”
- 36. Genesis 4:26 Prayer and praise to God are started.
- 37. Genesis 5:1 Genesis is “book of generations” – man is made in the image of God (1:27).
- 38. Genesis 5:3 Adam is 130 years old when Seth is born.

- 39. Genesis 5:5 Adam lives 930 years.
- 40. Genesis 5:6 Seth is 105 years old when first son Enos is born

EARTH’S AGE IS 235 YEARS + 5 DAYS

- 41. Genesis 5:8 Seth lives 912 years.
- 42. Genesis 5:9 Enos is 90 years old when first son Cainan is born.

EARTH’S AGE IS 325 YEARS + 5 DAYS

62. Genesis 6:4 Giants first appeared on earth, many children are born.

65. Genesis 6:9-10 Noah's family – sons Shem, Ham, and Jepheth.
66. Genesis 6:11-12 Earth is filled with violence and corruption.
67. Genesis 6:13-16 God tells Noah to build an ark and gives him the dimensions.
68. Genesis 6:17 God decides to cover the entire earth's surface with water; all air breathers must die in the flood.
69. Genesis 6:18 God establishes Second Covenant with Noah.
70. Genesis 6:19-20 God instructs Noah on animals to be on the ark.

| 89. | Genesis 8:13 | Earth floodwaters dry up in 1 year. Noah is 601 years old. |

91. Genesis 8:15-19 God sends Noah, his family, and the animals from the ark and tells them to multiply.
92. Genesis 8:20 Noah builds an altar and makes sacrifices.
93. Genesis 8:21-22 God promises to never destroy the earth again because of man's sins.
94. Genesis 9:2 God proclaims that all creatures will fear man.
95. Genesis 9:3-4 God says that all meat is food for humans with certain exceptions.
96. Genesis 9:6 God institutes the "death penalty" – all murderers of humans must be killed.
97. Genesis 9:9-17 God makes another covenant with Noah; the rainbow is the sign that He will never destroy the earth again by a flood.
98. Genesis 9:18-19 Noah's families depart from the ark to replenish the earth.
99. Genesis 9:20 Noah plants a vineyard and becomes a husbandman.
100. Genesis 9:21-22 Noah gets drunk on his wine; Ham sees him naked.
101. Genesis 9:23 Shem and Jephth walk backwards and put a garment on Noah to cover him.
102. Genesis 9:24-27 Noah condemns Canaan; son of Ham to servanthood for his father's seeing his nakedness.
103. Genesis 9:28-29 Noah lives 350 years after the flood, is 950 years old when he dies.

104. Genesis 10:1-32 Lineage of Noah and his sons.

105. Genesis 10:5 There are only Gentiles on earth, divided in lands, and with their own languages. (Later – see 11:1)
106. Genesis 10:8 Nimrod, grandson of Ham, becomes the mightiest man on earth.
107. Genesis 10:9-10 Nimrod, mighty hunter, builds a kingdom, including Babel.
108. Genesis 10:11 Asshur, from Nimrod’s kingdom, goes out and builds the city of Nineveh (on Tigris River south of Mt. Ararat).
109. Genesis 10:14 Philistim (Philistines) is great-grandson of Ham.
110. Genesis 10:15-19 Ham’s son Canaan has son Sidon; city of Sidon is named for him; Canaan is father of the Canaanites.
111. Genesis 10:25 & 32 Earth is divided – probably between Southeast Mediterranean and the Persian Gulf area of Mesopotamia.
112. Genesis 11:1 Whole earth has one language (probably before 10:5).
113. Genesis 11:3 Man begins (or renews) making bricks by burning them.
114. Genesis 11:4 Man tries to build a tower to heaven (Tower Of Babel).
115. Genesis 11:5-9 God examines the tower, restrains man by making languages foreign to each other.
116. Genesis 11:9 God scatters man across the earth and by language differences.
117. Genesis 11:10 Shem is 100 years old at the birth of his first son Arphaxad.

118. Genesis 11:12 Arphaxad is 35 years old at the birth of his first son Salah.

EARTH AGE IS 1,691 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

119. Genesis 11:14 Salah is 30 years old at the birth of his first son Eber.

EARTH AGE IS 1,721 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

120. Genesis 11:16 Eber is 34 years old at the birth of his first son Peleg.

EARTH AGE IS 1,755 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

121. Genesis 11:18 Peleg is 30 years old at the birth of his first son Reu.

125. Genesis 11:26 Terah is 70 years old at the birth of his first son Abram (Abraham).

EARTH AGE IS 1,946 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

126. Genesis 11:28 Abraham's family and uncles live in Ur Of The Chaldees.

127. Genesis 11:29 Abraham marries Sarai (Sarah).

128. Genesis 11:31 Terah takes Abraham, his grandson Lot, and their Families to Haran, located up the Euphrates River At the south-central edge of what is now Turkey.
129. Genesis 11:32 Terah, father of Abraham later dies in Haran at 205 years old.

EARTH AGE IS 2,081 YEARS, ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS.

130. Genesis 12:1 God tells Abram (Abraham) to leave Haran.
131. Genesis 12:2-3 God promises to make Abraham a great nation and will curse his enemies.
132. Genesis 12:3 God: “In thee (Abraham) shall all families of the earth be blessed.”
133. Genesis 12:4 Abraham is 75 years old when he leaves Haran.

EARTH AGE IS 2,021 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

134. Genesis 12:5 & 6 Abraham arrives in Canaan in the Plain of Moreh.
135. Genesis 12:7 God tells Abraham that Canaanland is his – Abraham builds an altar.
136. Genesis 12:9-10 Abraham continues south into Egypt because there is a famine in Canaanland.
137. Genesis 12:11-13 Abraham tells Egyptians that Sarai (Sarah) is his sister so that they will not kill him to take her.
138. Genesis 12:14-16 Sarah (over 65 years old), a beauty, is taken into Pharaoh’s house.
139. Genesis 12:17-20 God plagues Pharaoh’s house – he sends them away.
140. Genesis 13:1-6 Abraham, rich in cattle, silver, and gold, returns to Canaan.

141. Genesis 13:7 Strife between Abraham and Lot's people cause them to separate.
142. Genesis 13:10-11 Lot chooses the Plain of Jordan as his land because "it is like the Garden Of The Lord," Eden.
143. Genesis 13:12 Abraham stays and dwells in Canaan – Lot is in the Plain area at Sodom.
144. Genesis 13:13 Men of Sodom are exceedingly wicked sinners.
145. Genesis 13:14-17 God talks to Abraham: "All the land you can see shall belong to you and your seed forever."
146. Genesis 13:16 God tells Abraham his seed will be as many as the dust of the earth.
147. Genesis 13:18 Abraham moves to Hebron ("Hebrew" origin) and builds an altar
148. Genesis 14:1-2 Other kings of Canaan have war with King of Sodom and King of Gomorrah.
149. Genesis 14:3 The war takes place at the Vale of Siddim, which is the "Salt Sea."
150. Genesis 14:4-9 These wars in the Plain area are between several kingdoms with various little known kings.
151. Genesis 14:10-12 Sodom and Gomorrah are captured and Lot is taken captive.
152. Genesis 14:13-16 Abraham pursues Lot's captors and recovers Lot.
153. Genesis 14:17+21-24 King of Sodom wants to reward Abraham for fighting for them; Abraham refuses.
154. Genesis 14:18-20 Melchizedek (Priest Of The Most High God), special envoy sent from God, a special heavenly being who is not identified as an angel, appears and blesses Abraham.

155. Genesis 15:1-5 God and Abraham talk about him having children.
156. Genesis 15:6 Abraham was “saved” – his salvation was uniquely by righteousness because our Savior Jesus had not yet come to earth.
157. Genesis 15:13 God tells Abraham of the future captivity of his people, their slavery and affliction in Egypt for 400 years and their exodus approximately 600 years before that date.
158. Genesis 15:18 God’s Covenant with Abraham – His seed (family) will own all of the land between the Nile and the Euphrates Rivers forever.
159. Genesis 15:19-21 God names Gentile Tribes in that land area.
160. Genesis 16:1-4 Sarah, unable at that time to bear children, gives her handmaid Hagar to Abraham to bear them a child.
161. Genesis 16:5-6 Hagar hates Sarah and when corrected, runs away.
162. Genesis 16:7-9 Angel finds Hagar; tells her to return home.
163. Genesis 16:10 Angel tells Hagar she will have a multitude of children.
164. Genesis 16:11-12 Angel names Ishmael, says that he will be a despised wildman.
165. Genesis 16:15-16 Ishmael is born. Abraham is 86 years old.
- EARTH AGE IS 2,032 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS.**
166. Genesis 17:1-4 God talks to Abraham, makes Covenant (forever – V7).
167. Genesis 17:5 God changes Abraham’s name from Abram.
168. Genesis 17:6-7 God says Kings will come out of Abraham.

169. Genesis 17:8-9 Land of Canaan shall belong to Abraham and his seed (forever).
170. Genesis 17:10-14 Circumcision is a part of the Covenant – for baby boys at 8 days old.
171. Genesis 17:15 God changes Sarah’s name from Sarai.
172. Genesis 17:16 God says that Sarah will bear a son and will be the mother of kings.
173. Genesis 17:17 Abraham laughs at V16; does not believe he and Sarah can have children at age 100 and 90.
174. Genesis 17:19 God says his Covenant will be with Isaac (+V21).
175. Genesis 17:20 God says Ishmael will be a great nation with 12 Princes.
176. Genesis 17:23-27 All of Abraham’s House is circumcised – Ishmael is 13 years old. Abraham is 99.

EARTH AGE IS 2,045 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS.

177. Genesis 18:1-8 Three angels visit Abraham and eat with him.
178. Genesis 18:10 Angel tells that Sarah will have a son, Isaac.
179. Genesis 18:11-15 Sarah laughs, denies it, and says that she is too old for pleasure.
180. Genesis 18:16-22 Angels look toward Sodom – God reveals His plan to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah.
181. Genesis 18:23-33 Abraham bargains with God about the righteous in Sodom and Gomorrah; for 50 down to 10 righteous God will not destroy them – none are found.
182. Genesis 19:1-3 Two Angels visit Lot’s home in Sodom, eat with him
183. Genesis 19:4-5 Homosexuals of Sodom come to Lot’s home, demand to have sex with the two Angels.

184. Genesis 19:6-8 Lot offers to substitute his two virgin daughters to accommodate Sodom's homosexuals.
185. Genesis 19:9-10 Homosexuals attack Lot; Angels pull him back into the house.
186. Genesis 19:11 Angels smite Sodom's homosexuals with blindness.
187. Genesis 19:12-14 Lot tries to get his sons-in-law to flee Sodom with him, his wife and two daughters; they refuse.
188. Genesis 19:15-16 Angels pull Lot, his wife, and two daughters out of the city of Sodom.
189. Genesis 19:17-22 Lot and his family are told not to look back and to escape to Zoar to the south.
190. Genesis 19:23-25 God destroys Sodom, Gomorrah, all of the plains' cities and all of the people there with raining fire.
191. Genesis 19:26 Lot's wife disobeys, looks back, and turns to pillar of salt.
192. Genesis 19:28 Abraham looks toward Plains, sees the cities burning.
193. Genesis 19:29-30 Lot escapes from Zoar to the mountains to a cave with his two daughters.
194. Genesis 19:31-36 Lot's daughters get him drunk, commit incest with him, and both become pregnant by him.
195. Genesis 19:37 Eldest daughter names her son Moab-start of Moabites.
196. Genesis 19:38 Younger daughter names her son Benammi-start of Ammonites.
197. Genesis 20:1-11 Abraham moves to Gerar; King Abimelech takes Sarah; causes much trouble.

198. Genesis 20:12 Abraham reveals that his and Sarah's father are the same and that she is his sister.
199. Genesis 20:14-18 King Abimelech restores Sarah to Abraham; God opens the closed wombs of Gerar (Philistines).
200. Genesis 21:1-5 Isaac is conceived, born, and circumcised; Abraham is 100 years old.

EARTH AGE IS 2,046 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS.

201. Genesis 21:7-8 Sarah nurses and weans Isaac when she is 90 years old.
202. Genesis 21:9-11 Hagar's son Ishmael mocks Sarah and Isaac and is sent away.
203. Genesis 21:14-18 Hagar and Ishmael are dying in the desert; God intervenes and saves them.
204. Genesis 21:19 God provides well for Hagar and Ishmael in the desert.
205. Genesis 21:20-21 Ishmael becomes an archer, dwells in the wilderness, and marries an Egyptian.
206. Genesis 21:22-34 Abraham makes a covenant with Philistine King Abimelech at Beersheba.
207. Genesis 22:1-4 God tells Abraham to sacrifice Isaac to Moriah.
208. Genesis 22:5-6 Abraham leaves his servants behind and takes the wood, fire, and Isaac and climbs the mountain.
209. Genesis 22:7-9 Altar built, Isaac asks Abraham about the offering; Abraham binds and places him on the altar.
210. Genesis 22:10-13 As the knife is raised, God stops the killing and provides a ram for the sacrifice; Isaac is saved.

211. Genesis 22:14-17 Abraham names the place Jehovah-Jireh (God promises blessings).
212. Genesis 22:18 God promises to bless all nations of the earth through Abraham.
213. Genesis 22:20-24 Abraham receives word of his brother Nahor's children his granddaughter Rebekah, daughter of Bethuel.
214. Genesis 23:1-2 Sarah dies in Hebron, Canaan at age 127.

EARTH AGE IS 2,083 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

215. Genesis 23:16-19 Abraham buys a field and cave from Ephron for a family gravesite.
216. Genesis 24:1-9 Abraham is old; instructs his servant to find a wife for Isaac from among his (Abraham's) family.
217. Genesis 24:10 Servant goes back to city of Abraham's brother Nahor in Mesopotamia (probably Ur of the Chaldees).
218. Genesis 24:11-14 Servant stops at a well at the end of his journey, asks God to bring a wife for Isaac.
219. Genesis 24:15-16 Rebekah, daughter of Bethuel, granddaughter of Nahor comes to the well.
220. Genesis 24:17-21 Rebekah draws water from the well for Abraham's servant and his camels.
221. Genesis 24:22 Servant gives an earring, bracelets, and gold to Rebekah.
222. Genesis 24:23-28 Servant is invited to stay at Rebekah's home.
223. Genesis 24:29-32 Laban, Rebekah's brother comes to the well and greets Abraham's servant and his men.
224. Genesis 24:33-49 Servant tells them of his mission to find a wife for Abraham's son, Isaac.

225. Genesis 24:50-51 Laban and Bethuel give their consent for Rebekah to go for Isaac.
226. Genesis 24:53 Servant gives dowry to Rebekah, her mother, and brother.
227. Genesis 24:58-61 Rebekah is blessed and sent with her nurse to go with Abraham's servant back to Isaac.
228. Genesis 24:63 Isaac sees Rebekah coming on a camel.
229. Genesis 24:64-65 Rebekah gets off the camel and puts on her veil.
230. Genesis 24:67 Isaac takes Rebekah for his wife to Sarah's tent.
231. Genesis 25:1-2 Abraham marries again to Keturah, has 6 sons.
232. Genesis 25:5 Abraham gives all of his wealth to Isaac.
233. Genesis 25:7-8 Abraham dies at age 175 years.

EARTH AGE IS 2,121 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

234. Genesis 25:9 Isaac and Ishmael bury Abraham in the field he bought from the sons of Heth.
235. Genesis 25:12 Ishmael's generations were 12 sons (V13-16, all Princes and Kings of nations).
236. Genesis 25:17 Ishmael dies at age 137 years.

EARTH AGE IS 2,169 YEARS + ONE MONTH AND 22 DAYS

237. Genesis 25:19-20 Isaac's generations and marriage to Rebekah at age 40.

EARTH AGE IS 2,086 YEARS WHEN ISAAC MARRIES REBEKAH

238. Genesis 25:20 Abraham's families were Syrians – from Ur of Chaldees in Mesopotamia.
239. Genesis 25:21-23 Rebekah is pregnant with twins – two nations struggle in her womb.

240. Genesis 25:25 Rebekah's son Esau, red and hairy, is born first.
241. Genesis 25:26 Jacob is born and takes hold of Esau's heel. Isaac is 60 years old.

245. Genesis 26:1-4 There is a famine in the land; God makes a covenant with Isaac, gives him the land promised to Abraham.
246. Genesis 26:7 Isaac goes to Gerer, says that Rebekah is his sister to save his life.
247. Genesis 26:8-11 King Abimelech of the Philistines (the same king who took Sarah from Abraham) reveals that Rebekah is Isaac's wife.
248. Genesis 26:12-14 Isaac becomes rich and powerful; Philistines envy him.
249. Genesis 26:15-18 Isaac unstops all wells of Abraham, which the Philistines had stopped up and covered.
250. Genesis 26:20 Gerer herdsmen fight Isaac over water wells.
251. Genesis 26:22 Isaac digs a well, names it "Rehoboth"; there is no fighting over it.
252. Genesis 26:26-31 Philistine King Abimelech makes peace covenant with Isaac.
253. Genesis 26:34-35 Esau marries Judith at age 40. Rebekah and Isaac are displeased.

270. Genesis 29:33-35 Leah has three more sons by Jacob: Simeon #2, Levi #3, and Judah #4.
271. Genesis 30:1-8 Rachel is upset; gives Bilhah, her maid, to Jacob for children: Dan #5 and Naphtali #6.
272. Genesis 30:9-13 Leah gives Jacob her maid for children: Gad #7 and Asher #8.
273. Genesis 30:17-20 Leah makes mandrakes deal with Rachel for Jacob, births: Issachar #9 and Zebulun #10.
274. Genesis 30:21 Leah has daughter by Jacob, names her Dinah.
275. Genesis 30:22-24 Rachel has son Joseph #11.
276. Genesis 30:25-34 Jacob wants to leave Laban; makes deal for separating the herds.
277. Genesis 30:42-43 Jacob gives Laban weaker stock; Jacob becomes wealthy.
278. Genesis 31:1-3 Laban and sons are mad at Jacob; God tells Jacob to return home.
279. Genesis 31:14-16 Rachel and Leah are mad at Laban because he gave them no dowry.
280. Genesis 31:20 Jacob sneaks away from Laban with his family and goods, including his herds.
281. Genesis 31:21-30 Laban overtakes Jacob, God warns him not to harm Jacob; Laban accuses Jacob of stealing his idols.
282. Genesis 31:32-35 Laban searches for idols, Rachel sits on them, fools Laban.
283. Genesis 31:36-42 Jacob accuses Laban of 20 years of maltreatment.

284. Genesis 31:43-55 Laban and Jacob build heap of stones and call it “Galeed” as a barrier; kisses family good-by.
285. Genesis 32:1-6 Jacob meets angels; sends peace messengers to Esau; Esau comes to meet him.
286. Genesis 32:7-23 Jacob plans, agonizes over meeting Esau.
287. Genesis 32:24-27 Jacob wrestles with angel all night, demands a blessing.
288. Genesis 32:28 Angel gives Jacob a new name – Israel.
289. Genesis 32:30-32 Jacob sees God “face to face”; angel shrinks sinew under Jacob’s thigh, cripples him.
290. Genesis 33:4 Jacob (Israel) and Esau meet, embrace; all is forgiven.
291. Genesis 33:18-20 Israel arrives in Canaan, buys land, and builds an altar.
292. Genesis 34:1-2 Leah’s daughter Dinah goes out, Shechem a royal young Hivite seduces her.
293. Genesis 34:3-4 Shechem, son of Hamor, Prince of Hivites wants to marry Dinah.
294. Genesis 34:5-8 Israel’s sons are aware and angry; Hamor talks to them about marriage between Shechem and Dinah.
295. Genesis 34:9-11 Hivites propose intermarriage; Shechem says they will give anything for approval.
296. Genesis 34:14-15 Sons of Israel demand circumcision of Hivites to enter the marriage.
297. Genesis 34:18-23 Hamor and Shechem tell Hivites that circumcision will bring Israel’s wealth to them.
298. Genesis 34:24 All Hivite men are circumcised

299. Genesis 34:25-29 On the third day when the Hivite men are sore with their circumcision, Simeon and Levi, #2 and #3 sons of Israel kill all Hivite males and take their families and goods.
300. Genesis 34:30 Israel (Jacob) is very upset over the Hivite killings, tells his sons it invites trouble by bad reputation.
301. Genesis 35:1-4 Israel's family travels to Bethel, give up their idols and earrings, bury them in Shechem (place).
302. Genesis 35:5 God puts all cities in Canaan in terror, afraid of Israel.
303. Genesis 35:10 God speaks to Jacob – again changes his name to Israel.
304. Genesis 35:16-19 Rachel has her second son Benjamin (Benoni), at Ephrath, which is Bethlehem; she dies at birth.
305. Genesis 35:22 Reuben, Israel's first-born son has sex with Bilhah who was Rachel's maid and mother of his brothers, Dan and Naphtali; Israel finds out about it.
306. Genesis 35:23-26 Names of all twelve sons of Israel.
307. Genesis 35:27 Israel visits with his father Isaac in Hebron.

308. Genesis 35:28-29 Isaac dies and is buried by Israel (Jacob) and Esau.
309. Genesis 36:1-5 Generations of Esau (Edom).

311. Genesis 36:9-43 Generations of Esau with Dukes and Kings of Edomites named.

312. Genesis 37:1-2 Israel and his family are living in Canaan; Joseph, 17 years old, brings his father evil report of his brothers.
313. Genesis 37:3-4 Israel loves Joseph more than any of his sons; other sons know and hate him.
314. Genesis 37:5-8 Joseph dreams of sheaves of grain; all bowed down to him. He tells his brothers, they hate him more.
315. Genesis 37:9-11 Joseph has a second dream in which the sun, moon, and stars bow to him, tells it; his father rebukes him.
316. Genesis 37:12-17 Israel sends Joseph to find and check on his brothers who are with their flocks; he finds them near Dothan.
317. Genesis 37:18-22 Brothers see Joseph approaching, plot to kill him; Reuben, the eldest brother intercedes.
318. Genesis 37:23 Joseph's "Coat Of Many Colors".
319. Genesis 37:24-25 Joseph's brothers throw him into a pit; Ishmeelites from Gilead (Midianites) come by.
320. Genesis 37:26-28 Judah says sell Joseph to the Ishmeelite merchantmen, brothers agree and they sell Joseph.
321. Genesis 37:29-31 Reuben, absent at the time, returns, finds Joseph gone, is afraid, kills a sheep and dyes Joseph's coat in the blood to fake his death.
322. Genesis 37:32-35 Brothers take coat with blood stains to Israel, he mourns over what seems the death of Joseph.
323. Genesis 37:36 Medianites sell Joseph to Potiphar, the Egyptian Pharaoh's Captain of the Guard.
324. Genesis 38:1-5 Judah takes Canaanite wife, has 3 sons.

325. Genesis 38:6-7 Judah picks a wife for Er, his firstborn. Er is wicked and God kills him.
326. Genesis 38:8-10 Judah tells his second son Onan to take his brother, Er's wife; he spills his seed on the ground; God kills Onan also.
327. Genesis 38:11 Judah tells Tamar, Er's wife to wait for his third son Shelah to grow up and be her husband.
328. Genesis 38:12 Judah's wife Shuah dies; he visits a sheepshearer friend.
329. Genesis 38:13-14 Tamar, Er's wife is not given Shelah for a husband when he is grown; she dresses as a harlot and goes out on the streets.
330. Genesis 38:15-18 Judah sees Tamar with a veil on, doesn't recognize her, and gives her his signet, bracelets, and staff for security for sex until he can pay with a promised goat.
331. Genesis 38:18-19 Judah has sex with Tamar, not knowing it is she; she becomes pregnant by him, goes home and dresses again as a widow.
332. Genesis 38:20-23 Judah sends the promised payment of a goat to Tamar to retrieve his security; she can't be found.
333. Genesis 38:24 Judah learns that Tamar has played the harlot, says, "burn her!"
334. Genesis 38:25-26 Tamar shows the signet, bracelets, and staff to Judah; she is showing her pregnancy, he and she know he is the father.
335. Genesis 38:27-30 Tamar has twins; Pharez and Zerah; Pharez sticks his hand out and a scarlet thread is tied to it to show him as the firstborn; he pulls his hand back inside Tamar's womb and Zerah is born first.
336. Genesis 39:1-6 God prospers Joseph; he is made overseer of all of Potiphar's house, etc.

337. Genesis 39:7-19 Potiphar's wife tries to seduce Joseph; rejected, she accuses Joseph of sexual assault.
338. Genesis 39:20-23 Joseph is cast into prison; God blesses him; he is put in charge of all prisoners.
339. Genesis 40:1-19 Pharaoh's butler and baker are cast into prison with Joseph; he interprets their special dreams.
340. Genesis 40:20-23 Pharaoh has a birthday, restores butler to his duties and hangs the baker.
341. Genesis 41:1-8 Two years later Pharaoh dreams two dreams of famine but cannot interpret them.
342. Genesis 41:9-13 Butler tells Pharaoh of Joseph's dream interpretations.
343. Genesis 41:14-24 Pharaoh tells Joseph his dreams.
344. Genesis 41:25-32 Joseph gives the credit to God, interprets the dreams to be about a coming famine over the world.
345. Genesis 41:33-36 Joseph tells Pharaoh how to handle the famine.
346. Genesis 41:37-44 Pharaoh appoints Joseph second in power over Egypt and overseer of food production for the upcoming famine.
347. Genesis 41:45-46 Pharaoh changes Joseph's name to Zaphnathpaaneah and gives him Asenath, daughter of Potipherah, Priest of On for a wife. Joseph is 30 years old.
348. Genesis 41:47-49 Joseph goes through the land gathering grain and storing it for seven years.
349. Genesis 41:50-52 Asenath gives Joseph two sons, Manasseh and Ephraim.
350. Genesis 41:53-56 The famine begins; all of Egypt comes to Joseph for food.

351. Genesis 41:57 All of the countries of the world are in famine; they come to Egypt to buy grain.
352. Genesis 42:1-5 Israel (Jacob) sends ten sons to Egypt from Canaan to buy grain; Benjamin, the youngest stays home.
353. Genesis 42:6-8 Joseph's brothers come before him, he recognizes them, they do not recognize him; he treats them roughly.
354. Genesis 42:9-17 Joseph accuses his brothers of being spies; they tell him about their family; he locks them up for 3 days.
355. Genesis 42:18-20 Joseph releases 9 brothers, keeps one locked up, and sends them for Benjamin.
356. Genesis 42:21-22 Joseph's brothers accuse each other of the selling of Joseph as the cause of their troubles.
357. Genesis 42:23-24 Joseph understands their Hebrew speech, speaks to them only in Egyptian; he is overcome, goes away and weeps; he keeps Simeon, sends others away.
358. Genesis 42:25-28 Joseph sells them grain but returns their money in their sacks; they discover it later as they travel.
359. Genesis 42:29-36 Brothers return home to Canaan, relate whole story to their father, Israel, that they must take Benjamin to Egypt if they return; Israel is very afraid.
360. Genesis 42:37-38 Israel refuses to let Benjamin go, Reuben tells him to slay his 2 sons if there is a problem.
361. Genesis 43:1-15 Famine drives Israel to let Benjamin go to Egypt.
362. Genesis 43:16-17 Joseph sees Benjamin; invites all to dine in his home.

363. Genesis 43:19-22 Brothers tell Joseph's steward about money in bags and circumstances.
364. Genesis 43:23 Stewart tells them not to fear because God is with them; he brings Simeon out.
365. Genesis 43:24-29 Joseph comes out, they bow and give him gifts; he asks of Israel and Benjamin.
366. Genesis 43:30 Joseph sees Benjamin, departs from them to weep.
367. Genesis 43:32 They all sit to eat; Egyptian guests go and eat separately – say Hebrews are inferior.
368. Genesis 43:34 Benjamin is given five times more food than his brothers because he is Joseph's favorite.
369. Genesis 44:1-3 Joseph again puts their money back into their sacks; he puts his cup also in Benjamin's sack.
370. Genesis 44:4-13 Stewart overtakes brothers, finds cup in Benjamin's sack; returns them all to the city.
371. Genesis 44:14-17 Joseph says Benjamin must stay as his servant.
372. Genesis 44:18-34 Brother Judah pleads for Benjamin, says Israel will die if he doesn't return, offers himself to stay.
373. Genesis 45:1-5 Joseph sends servants out from them, weeps, tells brothers who he is, says that God sent him to Egypt.
374. Genesis 45:6-8 Joseph says that God sent him to save the earth from starvation.
375. Genesis 45:9-25 Joseph sends brothers with wagons to return Israel and all of the family and possessions to Goshen, Egypt.
376. Genesis 45:26-28 Israel (Jacob) is told that Joseph lives; he readies to go to Egypt.

377. Genesis 46:1-7 Israel travels to Egypt; God speaks to him about return to Canaan.
378. Genesis 46:8-28 Total of Israel's family, 66 travel to Goshen, Egypt; all of their names are given.
379. Genesis 46:29 Joseph and Israel meet again, embrace and weep.
380. Genesis 46:30-33 Joseph instructs Israel on meeting Pharaoh and giving his occupation.
381. Genesis 46:34 Shepherds are an abomination to Egyptians.
382. Genesis 47:1-6 Israel is presented to Pharaoh who wants him to tend his cattle.
383. Genesis 47:7-9 Israel blesses Pharaoh, Pharaoh asks his age; he is 130 years old.

389. Genesis 47:23-26 Pharaoh and Joseph institute "share cropping" in Egypt.
390. Genesis 47:27 Israel's family grows and multiplies in Egypt.
391. Genesis 47:28-31 Israel prepares to die at 147 years old, says he is to be buried in Canaan.

392. Genesis 48:1-7 Israel is sick, talks to Joseph about God's promises to him.
393. Genesis 48:8-22 Israel blessing, favors Ephraim (younger of Joseph's sons) over Manasseh; Joseph is displeased.
394. Genesis 49:1-4 Israel addresses all of his sons; chastises Reuben #1 over his relations with his concubine Bilhah.
395. Genesis 49:5 Israel says Simeon #2 and Levi #3 are cruel for slaying Hivites over Tamar's abuse.
396. Genesis 49:8-12 Israel praises Judah #4, says he will be head over all.
397. Genesis 49:13 Israel says Zebulun #5 will be seafaring tribe.
398. Genesis 49:14-15 Israel says Issachar #6 shall be a servant to tribute and shall bear burdens.
399. Genesis 49:16-18 Israel says Dan # 7 will be a tribe judge and a serpent against others.
400. Genesis 49:19 Israel says Gad #8 shall be overcome and will then later prevail.
401. Genesis 49:20 Israel says Asher #9 will be rich and royal.
402. Genesis 49:21 Israel says Naphtali #10 is like a free deer with wise words.
