3647. Habakkuk 1:1-4 Prophet Habakkuk's questions to God over Chaldean (Babylonian) captivity.
3648. Habakkuk 1:5-11 God explains the terror of the Chaldeans and the invasion and conquering of Israel.
3649. Habakkuk 1:12-17 Prophet Habakkuk conversing with God and asking why He allows the enemy to come.
3650. Habakkuk 2:1-3 Habakkuk is standing watch; he receives a vision from God and the answer.
3651. Habakkuk 2:4-5 The just shall live by faith but the enemy's desire is like hell; he wants to conquer and enslave all nations.
3652. Habakkuk 2:6-8 Habakkuk is assuming that the captives will eventually prevail against Babylon.
3653. Habakkuk 2:9-13 Woe to the covetous enemy; his sins will bring him doom.
3654. Habakkuk 2:14 Habakkuk: "THE EARTH SHALL BE FILLED WITH THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE GLORY OF THE LORD AS THE WATERS COVER THE SEA!"
3655. Habakkuk 2:15 Habakkuk: "WOE UNTO HIM THAT GIVES HIS NEIGHBOR DRINK TO LOOK ON HIS NAKEDNESS!"
3656. Habakkuk 2:16-17 Woe to those with shame for glory with uncovered foreskin; the violence of Lebanon will cover Nineveh.
3657. Habakkuk 2:18-19 Woe to the makers of graven images who tell them to do wonders.
3658. Habakkuk 2:20 Habakkuk: "THE LORD IS IN HIS HOLY TEMPLE; LET ALL THE EARTH KEEP SILENCE BEFORE HIM!"

3659. Habakkuk 3:1-2 Habakkuk praying to God for fear, mercy, and turning wrath away.
3660. Habakkuk 3:3 GOD'S AND JESUS' COMINGS AND GOINGS IN EARTH AND HEAVEN.
3661. Habakkuk 3:4-6 God's appearance to Habakkuk; horns coming out of His hands; pestilence and burning coals at His feet; He stood and measured the earth; destruction comes.
3662. Habakkuk 3:7-10 The earth, rivers, and seas trembling before God and uttering His voice.
3663. Habakkuk 3:11-12 THE SUN AND MOON STAND STILL AT GOD'S COMING; GOD MARCHES THROUGH THE LAND IN ANGER; HE EVEN THRESHES THE HEAVEN IN ANGER.
3664. Habakkuk 3:13-14 God brings salvation to His people, wounds to the wicked and destruction to their villages.
3665. Habakkuk 3:15-16 Horses of God walk through the sea; Habakkuk trembles as God's troops come.
3666. Habakkuk 3:17-19 The harvests fail and there is no meat, yet Habakkuk rejoices because God is his strength.
