

HEBREWS

2431. Hebrews 1:1 God spoke sometimes in divers manners to your forefathers by the prophets.
2432. Hebrews 1:2 GOD SPEAKS THROUGH JESUS, HEIR OF ALL THINGS; JESUS CREATED THE WORLD AND THE UNIVERSE.
2433. Hebrews 1:3 JESUS, PHYSICALLY MADE IN THE EXACT IMAGE OF GOD, SITS AT GOD'S RIGHT HAND IN HEAVEN.
2434. Hebrews 1:4 JESUS IS OF MUCH HIGHER VALUE THAN ANGELS BECAUSE OF HIS INHERITANCE.
2435. Hebrews 1:5 GOD SAYS THAT ANGELS ARE NOT HIS SONS (ALL MALE) AND HE IS NOT THEIR FATHER.
2436. Hebrews 1:6 God said, when Jesus was born, that all angels were to worship Him.
2437. Hebrews 1:7 GOD MAKES ANGELS SPIRITS AND FLAMES OF FIRE.
2438. Hebrews 1:8 GOD CALLS JESUS "GOD" AND SAYS THAT HIS THRONE IS FOREVER, A SCEPTRE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS IS THE SCEPTRE OF JESUS' KINGDOM.
2439. Hebrews 1:9 Jesus has loved righteousness and hated iniquity; God anointed Him above His fellows.
2440. Hebrews 1:10 GOD SAYS THAT JESUS, AS LORD, LAID THE EARTH'S FOUNDATION AND MADE THE HEAVENS.
2441. Hebrews 1:11-12 CREATION SHALL PERISH, GROW OLD LIKE A GARMET (WEAR OUT), AND BE FOLDED UP; JESUS

WILL REMAIN.

2442. Hebrews 1:13-14 Angels have no position but to minister to all heirs of salvation.
2443. Hebrews 2:1-3 We must remember God's Word; we will perish without salvation spoken by His Ministers.
2444. Hebrews 2:4 God bears witness with ministers, with signs, wonders, divers' miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost.
2445. Hebrews 2:5 ANGELS WILL NOT BE IN CHARGE OF HEAVEN.
2446. Hebrews 2:6 One asks why God is mindful of man or even mindful of Jesus in having visited Him.
2447. Hebrews 2:7-8 JESUS AND MAN ARE MADE, IN A WAY, LOWER THAN ANGELS, CROWNED WITH GLORY AND HONOR, SET OVER THE WORKS OF GOD'S HANDS; ALL THINGS SUBJECT TO AND UNDER JESUS.
2448. Hebrews 2:9 JESUS IS MADE LOWER THAN ANGELS TO SUFFER DEATH (ANGELS DO NOT DIE), WITH GLORY AND HONOR FOR EVERY MAN.
2449. Hebrews 2:10 Jesus, Head of all things, brings many sons into glory, giving perfect salvation through His suffering.
2450. Hebrews 2:11 JESUS AND ALL SANCTIFIED (SAVED) ARE ONE; UNASHAMED, JESUS CALLS US BRETHREN.
2451. Hebrews 2:12 Christians are to declare Jesus to one another and sing praises to Him in church.

2452. Hebrews 2:13 Jesus set the example of putting trust in God and claims The Body Of Christ (Christians).
2453. Hebrews 2:14 Jesus became flesh and blood like us so that He could die and destroy the Devil who is the cause of death.
2454. Hebrews 2:15 Jesus takes away our fear of death which was a lifetime bondage.
2455. Hebrews 2:16 Jesus didn't take on the nature of angels, but the seed (human) of Abraham.
2456. Hebrews 2:17 Jesus took on our human nature to know our frailties and represent us to God.
2457. Hebrews 2:18 Jesus went through temptations to know how to comfort and save us from temptation.
2458. Hebrews 3:1 We are titled "Holy Brethren," partakers of the heavenly calling; Jesus is an Apostle and High Priest of the Christian profession.
2459. Hebrews 3:2-4 Jesus and Moses were both faithful to their Houses but Jesus was more honorable than His House.
2460. Hebrews 3:5-6 Moses was faithful to a short history; Jesus was and is faithful to His House for eternity.
2461. Hebrews 3:7-8 The Holy Ghost tells us to hear Jesus always and do not harden our hearts and provoke Him as was done in the wilderness.
2462. Hebrews 3:9-11 God relates the forty years of sin in the wilderness; He is grieved and in His wrath, forbids Israel from entering the Promised Land.

2463. Hebrews 3:12-13 Do not be unbelievers nor depart from God; exhort each other daily to avoid sin.
2464. Hebrews 3:14-15 We are partners with Jesus if we obey; we are to hear His Voice and not harden our hearts nor provoke Him.
2465. Hebrews 3:16-19 Almost all of Israel in the exodus from Egypt sinned and grieved God and died in the wilderness.
2466. Hebrews 4:1-11 God rested on the seventh day; He preaches salvation to receive rest and that we must labor after we are saved.
2467. Hebrews 4:12 Word of God's power and its sharpness to our hearts, souls, and bodies, discerning our hearts.
2468. Hebrews 4:13-14 All creatures are manifest to God; we have Jesus, our High Priest in heaven.
2469. Hebrews 4:15-16 **JESUS IS OUR HIGH PRIEST AND WAS TEMPTED LIKE US; WE MUST COME BOLDLY TO HIS THRONE OF GRACE.**
2470. Hebrews 5:1-5 Earth priests are ordained by God to serve men; God ordained Aaron and especially Jesus.
2471. Hebrews 5:6 **GOD REPEATS FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT, "JESUS IS A PRIEST FOREVER AFTER THE ORDER OF MELCHISEDEC."**
2472. Hebrews 5:7-9 Jesus is alive; He worshipped God in all ways, learned obedience, suffered death, and became the Author Of Salvation.
2473. Hebrews 5:10 Jesus is again called of God An High Priest after The Order Of Melchisedec.

2474. Hebrews 5:11-14 You are dull of hearing; you must be taught repeatedly as babies, with milk; you should be capable of strong meat and should have learned righteousness.
2475. Hebrews 6:1-3 We must leave doctrine learning and go on to perfection, baptisms, laying on of hands, resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment if God permits.
2476. Hebrews 6:4-6 **IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR PARTAKERS OF THE GIFTS AND HOLY GHOST (SAVED) TO FALL AWAY...AND THEN RETURN AGAIN TO SALVATION.**
2477. Hebrews 6:7-10 God blesses the ground and good plants; He expects better growth and Christian service from us.
2478. Hebrews 6:11-15 We must show diligence and patience and will receive the same promises as Abraham.
2479. Hebrews 6:16-17 God's promise of reward for faithfulness is immutable and confirmed by His Oath.
2480. Hebrews 6:18-19 **IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR GOD TO LIE; OUR HOPE IS AN ANCHOR OF THE SOUL AS IN THE HOLY OF HOLIES.**
2481. Hebrews 6:20 Jesus is our Forerunner, made a High Priest forever after The Order of Melchisedec.
2482. Hebrews 7:1 **MELCHISEDEC - KING OF SALEM, PRIEST OF THE MOST HIGH GOD, MET ABRAHAM AND BLESSED HIM.**
2483. Hebrews 7:2 Abraham gave title to Melchisedec: King Of Righteousness, King Of Salem, King Of Peace.

2484. Hebrews 7:3 MELCHISEDEC, WITHOUT FATHER, MOTHER, AND DESCENT, HAS NO BEGINNING NOR END OF LIFE; HE WAS MADELIKE THE SON OF GOD AND ABIDES A PRIEST FOREVER.
2485. Hebrews 7:4 Melchisedec, not a Jew nor Levite, with no demand by law to receive, took Patriarch Abraham's tithe.
2486. Hebrews 7:5-6 The tithe was a Levite thing by law through Abraham's lineage; Melchisedec's receipt of the tithe was unusual.
2487. Hebrews 7:7-8 Melchisedec blessed Abraham; Abraham, dead, receives tithes; Melchisedec, alive, receives tithes.
2488. Hebrews 7:9-10 Levi received from and paid tithes to Abraham and was met by Melchisedec in his father before birth.
2489. Hebrews 7:11 If perfection came via Levitical Law and Priesthood, why was there another priesthood (Melchisedec) which was not under the Order of Aaron?
2490. Hebrews 7:12-13 Has Melchisedec changed the Priesthood? The Law? Is his new tribe not attending the altar?
2491. Hebrews 7:14 JESUS OUR LORD CAME FROM THE TRIBE OF JUDAH, WHICH BY MOSES, GAVE NO POWER OF PRIESTHOOD.
2492. Hebrews 7:15-16 MELCHISEDEC IS ANOTHER PRIESTHOOD, NOT BY HUMAN COMMANDMENT, BUT BY GOD'S POWER OF ENDLESS LIFE.

2493. Hebrews 7:17-18 THERE IS A CHANGE OF GOD'S
COMMANDMENT OF PRIESTHOOD
IN THE REVEALING EXISTENCE
OF MELCHISEDEC.
2494. Hebrews 7:19-20 The Law made no perfection, but hope
in God; without an oath or law,
Melchisedec was made Priest.
2495. Hebrews 7:21-22 Two priests were made without an oath,
Jesus and Melchisedec, both under the
Order Of Melchisedec.
2496. Hebrews 7:23-24 Regular priests terminated at death;
Jesus, as Priest, continues forever with
unchangeable Priesthood.
2497. Hebrews 7:25 Jesus is able to change forever, those
coming to God by Him; He lives forever
to make intercession.
2498. Hebrews 7:26-28 Jesus, as High Priest, is made higher
than the heavens; no need for daily
sacrifice, He is consecrated forever.
2499. Hebrews 8:1-2 We have a High Priest (Jesus) who sits
at the Right Hand Of Majesty, a
Minister to sanctuary and true
tabernacle, pitched by Him and not by
man.
2500. Hebrews 8:3-5 Earthly Priests offer sin sacrifices;
Moses made The Tabernacle according
to God's pattern.
2501. Hebrews 8:6-7 Jesus brought a more excellent ministry
and a new covenant with better
promises.
2502. Hebrews 8:8-9 God makes a New Covenant with Israel
and Judah because they failed the
Exodus Covenant.
2503. Hebrews 8:10-11 God puts laws into Israel's minds and
hearts; no teaching; all will know God.

2504. Hebrews 8:12-13 God, "I will be merciful to Israel's unrighteousness, their sins will I remember no more." The old, decayed covenant is exchanged for a new covenant.
2505. Hebrews 9:1-2 The Old Covenant had ordinances of Divine Service, a worldly sanctuary inside an ornamental Tabernacle.
2506. Hebrews 9:3-5 THE HOLY OF HOLIES IS INSIDE THE VEIL; THE ARK HOLDS THE GOLDEN POT OF MANNA, AARON'S ROD THAT BUDDDED, AND THE TABLES OF THE COVENANT (TEN COMMANDMENTS); HOLY ORNAMENTS FILL THE REST OF THE HOLY OF HOLIES.
2507. Hebrews 9:6-7 PUBLIC SERVICES ARE HELD IN THE FIRST (FRONT) AREA OF THE TABERNACLE; ONLY THE HIGH PRIEST IS ALLOWED IN THE HOLY OF HOLIES FOR A BLOOD OFFERING ONCE EACH YEAR.
2508. Hebrews 9:8-9 THE HOLY GHOST KEPT THE HOLY OF HOLIES SECRET WHILE SACRIFICES FOR SIN WERE OFFERED IN THE FRONT ROOM.
2509. Hebrews 9:10-11 THE OLD TABERNACLE EXISTED UNTIL THE REFORMATION; JESUS AS HIGH PRIEST, BROUGHT A NEW TEBERNACLE NOT MADE WITH HANDS, PERFECT.
2510. Hebrews 9:12-14 Jesus' Blood made eternal redemption, so much greater than animal flesh and blood, it purged us.
2511. Hebrews 9:15 Jesus is mediator of the New Testament; through His death we have the promise

of eternal inheritance.

2512. Hebrews 9:16-17 For a testament to exist, the testator must have died; it has no strength while the testator lives.
2513. Hebrews 9:18-21 Moses dedicated the first testament with blood and water, scarlet wool, and hyssop with which he sprinkled the book and people with an oath relayed from God.
2514. Hebrews 9:22 **ALMOST ALL THINGS ARE PURGED WITH BLOOD; WITHOUT THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD THERE IS NO FORGIVENESS OF SIN.**
2515. Hebrews 9:23-24 Heaven too was purified with better sacrifices; High Priest Jesus entered the Holy Of Holies not made with hands.
2516. Hebrews 9:25-26 There was no yearly entering of Jesus into the Holy Of Holies; He will enter at the end of the world.
2517. Hebrews 9:27-28 Man dies once, then the judgment; Jesus will appear the second time to those who are saved.
2518. Hebrews 10:1 The law of sacrifice is a shadow of purity only and must be repeated continually.
2519. Hebrews 10:2-3 A perfect sacrifice offering would remove sins permanently and no more sin would occur; a regular sacrifice remembers sin every year.
2520. Hebrews 10:4 **IT IS NOT POSSIBLE THAT THE BLOOD OF ANIMALS SHOULD TAKE AWAY SINS.**
2521. Hebrews 10:5-6 Jesus says that He will do away with sacrifice which brings no pleasure by

His Own Body sacrificed.

2522. Hebrews 10:7-8 Jesus says that He came as promised to do God's will and to stop sacrifices which have no pleasure but are only by law.
2523. Hebrews 10:9-10 Jesus' life was taken away first to give salvation and second, His Body was sacrificed once for all.
2524. Hebrews 10:11-12 Priests offer sacrifices that can never take away sin; Jesus made one sacrifice, then sat down at the right hand of God.
2525. Hebrews 10:13-14 Jesus remains until His enemies become His footstool; by one offering He perfected and saved us forever.
2526. Hebrews 10:15-16 The Holy Ghost is witness of the New Covenant wherein Jesus puts His law into our hearts and minds.
2527. Hebrews 10:17-18 Jesus: "Their sins I remember no more." Remission allows no more offering for sin.
2528. Hebrews 10:19-20 We can now enter the Holiest by His Blood, a new living way through the veil which is His Flesh
2529. Hebrews 10:21-22 With a High Priest over the House Of God, we draw near with true hearts and evil is washed away.
2530. Hebrews 10:23 We must hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; He is faithful that promises.
2531. Hebrews 10:24-25 WE MUST PROVOKE EACH OTHER TO LOVE AND GOOD WORKS, FORSAKING NOT THE ASSEMBLING OF OURSELVES TOGETHER.

2532. Hebrews 10:26 IF WE SIN WILFULLY AFTER SALVATION, THERE IS NO SECOND CHANCE FOR BEING SAVED.
2533. Hebrews 10-27 For unforgiven sin there is judgment and fiery indignation to devour us.
2534. Hebrews 10:28-29 During Moses day the law condemned those who despised it; the worst punishment now is under grace.
2535. Hebrews 10:30 God has said: "VENGEANCE BELONGS TO ME; I WILL RECOMPENSE AND JUDGE MY PEOPLE."
2536. Hebrews 10:31-33 Don't fall into God's condemnation; remember your afflictions after you were saved for helping those who worked for me.
2537. Hebrews 10:34-35 You loved me and endured hardship for it, knowing your reward was coming, you kept confidence.
2538. Hebrews 10:36-39 Keep patience, the promise is coming in a little while; THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY FAITH; we can't turn back.
2539. Hebrews 11:1 FAITH IS THE SUBSTANCE OF THINGS HOPED FOR, THE EVIDENCE OF THINGS NOT SEEN.
2540. Hebrews 11:2-3 By faith our elders did well; through faith we believe creation and the Word of God.
2541. Hebrews 11:4 By faith Abel's sacrifice exceeded Cain's, his righteousness spoke even from the grave.
2542. Hebrews 11:5 BY FAITH ENOCH WAS TRANSLATED (NEVER DIED)

BECAUSE HE PLEASED GOD.

2543. Hebrews 11:6 Without faith it is impossible to please God; we must come to Him believing for reward.
2544. Hebrews 11:7 BY FAITH NOAH, BEING WARNED OF GOD, BUILT THE ARK, SAVED HIS FAMILY, AND BECAME HEIR OF GOD.
2545. Hebrews 11:8 BY FAITH ABRAHAM LEFT HIS HOMELAND AND OBEYED GOD, THOUGH NOT KNOWING WHERE HE WAS GOING.
2546. Hebrews 11:9-10 Abraham dwelled in the Promised Land with Isaac and Jacob, looking for a City Made By God.
2547. Hebrews 11:11-12 BY FAITH SARAH, AT AGE 90, HAD SON ISAAC BY ABRAHAM, BOTH AT AN AGE NEAR DEATH, AND LEFT INNUMERABLE HEIRS.
2548. Hebrews 11:13-15 All heirs died with faith that they would find their country, not aware that they had been there.
2549. Hebrews 11:16 God's people always desired a better country, heaven, a city God is not ashamed to give them.
2550. Hebrews 11:17-18 By faith, when ordered, Abraham would have offered his son Isaac as God offered Isaac's seed, Jesus.
2551. Hebrews 11:19-20 God raised His Son Jesus; by faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning their future.
2552. Hebrews 11:21 By faith Jacob, while dying, blessed Manasseh and Ephraim, Joseph's sons.

2553. Hebrews 11:22 By faith, Joseph, when dying, spoke of Israel going to Canaan and commanded that his bones go too.
2554. Hebrews 11:23 BY FAITH MOSES' PARENTS HID HIM FOR THREE MONTHS FROM THE KING'S COMMANDMENT TO KILL ALL CHILDREN.
2555. Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he was grown, refused to be called son of the pharaoh's daughter.
2556. Hebrews 11:25-27 Moses chose affliction with his people, esteeming Christ's riches greater than Egypt's.
2557. Hebrews 11:28-29 By faith Moses kept the Passover to save Israel's eldest sons and passed through the Red Sea as Egypt drowned.
2558. Hebrews 11:30-31 By faith Jericho was taken and Rahab was saved for protecting Israel's spies.
2559. Hebrews 11:32 The faith and courage of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthae, David, Samuel, and the Prophets.
2560. Hebrews 11:33-34 Such heroes subdued kingdoms, did God's due, stopped the mouth of Lyons, and won wars.
2561. Hebrews 11:35 Women received their dead raised to life; some tortured refused deliverance to receive heaven.
2562. Hebrews 11:36 Others had cruel mockings, scourgings, bonds, and imprisonment for their beliefs.
2563. Hebrews 11:37 Some were stoned, sawed in two, tempted, slain by sword, and wondered in animal skins, destitute, afflicted, and tormented.

2564. Hebrews 11:38 The world was not worthy of them; they wondered in deserts, mountains, dens, and caves.
2565. Hebrews 11:39-40 These received a good report by faith; they didn't get the promise but better, though not perfect.
2566. Hebrews 12:1 Crowded by witnesses, let's lay sin aside and run with patience the race set before us.
2567. Hebrews 12:2 We must look to Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith Who was crucified, and shamed, and sits at the Right Hand Of God.
2568. Hebrews 12:3-4 Keep Jesus, enduring sinners against Him, to keep faith; we have not resisted unto death against sin.
2569. Hebrews 12:5 Don't forget childhood spankings; likewise understand the chastisement of God; don't faint in rebuke.
2570. Hebrews 12:6 God chastens all that He loves and scourges every son He has received.
2571. Hebrews 12:7 If we have endured chastening, God has treated us as sons; no son is without chastisement
2572. Hebrews 12:8 WITHOUT CHASTISEMENT, WHICH ALL MUST BEAR, WE ARE BASTARDS AND NOT SONS.
2573. Hebrews 12:9-11 Chastisement by fathers benefits; by God, though painful, it produces righteousness.
2574. Hebrews 12:12-15 Lift yourselves to faithful paths; follow peace and holiness; don't defile with bitterness.

2575. Hebrews 12:16-17 No fornication nor profane acts like Esau who sold his birthright for food and found no place for repentance; he lost his inheritance though he sought it with tears.
2576. Hebrews 12:18-21 As His Chosen, we avoid what is prohibited, like the Holy Mountain of Moses.
2577. Hebrews 12:22 We are come to Mt. Zion to God's City, The Heavenly Jerusalem, to innumerable angels.
2578. Hebrews 12:23 We come to the General Assembly, Church Of The Firstborn, where names are written by God.
2579. Hebrews 12:24 We come to Jesus, the Mediator of the New Covenant to blood sprinkling exceeding that of Abel.
2580. Hebrews 12:25 Never refuse Jesus' speaking; greater is His speaking from heaven than from earth.
2581. Hebrews 12:26-27 Jesus' Voice shook the earth; He shakes heaven as well; there only remain things that can't be shaken.
2582. Hebrews 12:28-29 We receive a Kingdom that can't be moved; we have grace, serve, and reverence God with fear; God is a Consuming Fire.
2583. Hebrews 13:1-2 Continue brotherly love; ENTERTAIN STRANGERS, THEY MAY BE ANGELS UNAWARE TO US.
2584. Hebrews 13:3 Remember and identify with those in bonds, suffering adversity as though in their place.

2585. Hebrews 13:4 HONOR THE SANCTITY OF MARRIAGE; NEVER DEFILE THE BED; GOD JUDGES WHOREMONGERS AND ADULTERERS.
2586. Hebrews 13:5 Never covet; be content with what you have; Jesus said: "I will never leave or forsake you."
2587. Hebrews 13:6-7 Boldly say, "The Lord is my Helper, I'll not fear man." Listen to those over you who speak the Word Of God and have faith.
2588. Hebrews 13:8-9 JESUS IS ALWAYS THE SAME; DON'T LISTEN TO STRANGE DOCTRINES; establish with grace and not with unprofitable meats which have defiled others.
2589. Hebrews 13:10-11 We have an altar and none eat there; blood is sacrificed in the sanctuary and meat is burned outside the camp.
2590. Hebrews 13:12 Jesus is sanctifying the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.
2591. Hebrews 13:13-14 Let us go outside the camp with Him, bearing His reproach; we have no city here but seek one in heaven.
2592. Hebrews 13:15 By Jesus let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, our words thanking Him.
2593. Hebrews 13:16 Do not forget to do good and communicate; God is well pleased with such sacrifices.
2594. Hebrews 13:17 Obey your rulers; submit to those who watch our souls because they must give account with joy.

2595. Hebrews 13:18-19 Pray for God's servants to live honestly that they may be restored to us sooner.
2596. Hebrews 13:20-21 May God, Who gave us Jesus and The Covenant, make us perfect workers for Him.
2597. Hebrews 13:22-23 Receive this exhortation in few words; Timothy is free; I hope to see you if I can come with him (Sounds like writings of Paul or Luke).
2598. Hebrews 13:24-25 Salute your rulers and Saints; Italians salute you; grace to you. Amen.
