

HOSEA

3457. Hosea 1:1 Prophet Hosea served in Judah under Kings Uzziah, Ahaz, Hezekiah, and Jeroboam, who was King of Israel at that time.
3458. Hosea 1:2 God tells Hosea to go and marry a whore to symbolize Judah's whoredom against Him.
3459. Hosea 1:3 Hosea goes, finds, and marries Gomer, a whore; they soon have a son.
3460. Hosea 1:4 –5 God: "Name the son Jezreel; I will avenge Jezreel upon the House of Jehu and end Israel."
3461. Hosea 1:6-7 Gomer has a daughter named Lo-ruhamah; God is destroying Israel and saving Judah.
3462. Hosea 1:8-9 Gomer has another son named Lo-ammi; God says: "You are not my people and I am not your God!"
3463. Hosea 1:10-11 God says Israel will recover and grow, will turn back to Him, and will be joined to Judah.
3464. Hosea 2:1-2 God instructs Hosea to plead with his family and wife, Gomer to stop her whoring.
3465. Hosea 2:3-5 God chastises Gomer and the children of whoredoms; He mocks Gomer's whoredoms.
3466. Hosea 2:6-13 God compares Gomer to Israel and Judah and says how He will punish all of them.
3467. Hosea 2:14-23 God speaks of a new covenant, a rescue of His people.
3468. Hosea 3:1-3 God sends Hosea to buy Gomer back from her lovers for fifteen pieces of silver.
3469. Hosea 3:4-5 Israel is astray but will come back to God and to King David in latter years.

3470. Hosea 4:1-5 God chastises Israel, tells of their sins, says they will fall, and he will destroy their mother.
3471. Hosea 4:6 God: “MY PEOPLE ARE DESTROYED FOR LACK OF KNOWLEDGE; THEY HAVE REJECTED KNOWLEDGE.”
3472. Hosea 4:7-19 God continues to chastise Israel, says Judah is all right, and tells of Israel’s sins.
3473. Hosea 5:1-15 God’s condemnation of Israel, Ephraim, and now Judah; God turns from them.
3474. Hosea 6:1-11 God calls out to them to return to Him and tells of their awaiting pitfalls.
3475. Hosea 7:1-2 God is about to heal Israel but discovers the wickedness of Ephraim and Samaria; they are all in sin.
3476. Hosea 7:3-8 God says they are all like an unattended oven with a cake not turned and burned up.
3477. Hosea 7:9-16 Ephraim has turned to Egypt and Assyria; they will be in derision in Egypt.
3478. Hosea 8:1-6 God condemns Israel for trespasses and making idols: “The Calf of Samaria.”
3479. Hosea 8:7 God: “THEY HAVE SOWN THE WIND AND THEY SHALL REAP THE WHIRLWIND.”
3480. Hosea 8:8-14 Israel is mixing with the Gentiles and aligned with Assyria; Ephraim and Judah have left God.
3481. Hosea 9:1-3 God expels Israel to Assyria and Ephraim to Egypt for whoring; they are both expelled from His land.
3482. Hosea 9:4-5 God refuses Israel’s offerings; there will be no solemn days and no Day of the Feast of The Lord.

3483. Hosea 9:6 Egypt shall gather Ephraim; Memphis, Egypt will bury them; they reap thorns.
3484. Hosea 9:7-9 Israel's prophet is a fool; Ephraim's watchmen are corrupted in the days of Gibeah.
3485. Hosea 9:10-16 God is condemning the womb and children of Israel and Ephraim; they have dry breasts and no escape.
3486. Hosea 9:17 Hosea says that God will cast away all Israelis; they will be wanderers among nations.
3487. Hosea 10:1-6 Israel and Ephraim lose their covenant; they are cut off with no king and with idols; they have only shame.
3488. Hosea 10:7-8 Samaria is cut off and destroyed: "THEY SHALL SAY TO THE MOUNTAINS, 'COVER US' AND TO THE HILLS, 'FALL ON US.'"
3489. Hosea 10:9-15 God is comparing Israel and Ephraim to farming wickedness; Israel is cut off.
3490. Hosea 11:1 God: "When Israel was a child, then I loved him and called my son out of Egypt."
3491. Hosea 11:2-12 Israel from Egypt to Assyria, backsliding; Ephraim is lost; Judah is still with God.
3492. Hosea 12:1-14 God's controversy with Ephraim and Judah; a review of Israel from Egypt and from Jacob.
3493. Hosea 13:1-3 God's continued chastisement of Ephraim; her idols to Baal are blown like chaff.
3494. Hosea 13:4-8 God says He is still Israel's God, watching, protecting, and devouring them.
3495. Hosea 13:9-16 God: "Israel has destroyed itself and also Ephraim of Israel; infants shall be dashed in pieces and women with child shall be ripped up.

3496. Hosea 14:1-3 God telling Israel to return to him; He will grant mercy.
3497. Hosea 14:4-7 God will heal their backsliding and love them; His anger will be turned away and there will be new growth.
3498. Hosea 14:8-9 Ephraim will turn from idols; the just shall be wise; transgressors will fall.
