

ISAIAH

2926. Isaiah 1:1
Isaiah is the son of Amos; he is a major prophet during the reigns from Uzziah to Hezekiah, kings of Judah.
2927. Isaiah 1:2-9
Isaiah is calling Judah sinful and desolate, the only remnant of Israel not in exile.
2928. Isaiah 1:10-15
Judah is like Sodom and Gomorrah; none of their sacrifices are acceptable to God and their prayers are not heard.
2929. Isaiah 1:16-20
Judah is ordered to “clean up;” (V18) God says, “COME LET US REASON TOGETHER; THOUGH YOUR SINS BE AS SCARLET, THEY SHALL BE WHITE AS SNOW... CRIMSON...BE AS WOOL.”
2930. Isaiah 1:21-24
Jerusalem has become a harlot, her princes are rotten and God says, “I will purge and avenge!”
2931. Isaiah 1:25-31
God says, “I will restore Judges and counselors and transgressors will burn!”
2932. Isaiah 2:1-3
Isaiah prophesies: “Jerusalem (Zion) “Mountain of The Lord” will be the world’s headquarters.
2933. Isaiah 2:4
The judgment of God: “THEY SHALL BEAT THEIR SWORDS INTO PLOWSHARES, SPEARS INTO PRUNING HOOKS; NATION SHALL NOT LIFT UP SWORD AGAINST NATION, NEITHER WAR NO MORE.”
2934. Isaiah 2:5-9
The House of Jacob is forsaken; Philistine soothsayers and idols have drawn Judah away.
2935. Isaiah 2:10-22
The day of the Lord (destruction) is coming; hide in caves and the cleft of the rock; put all of your idols away.

2936. Isaiah 3:1-4 Children princes will replace all mighty men of Judah and babes shall rule.
2937. Isaiah 3:5-9 Oppression comes; Jerusalem is ruined, Judah is fallen, God is provoked, and evil is come.
2938. Isaiah 3:10-12 The righteous will be okay but children will be oppressors and women will rule over them.
2939. Isaiah 3:13-18 Judgment to the daughters of Zion; take away ornaments, caul, and round tires like the moon.
2940. Isaiah 3:19-20 Take away bracelets, mufflers, bonnets, leg ornaments, head bands, tablets, and earrings.
2941. Isaiah 3:21-23 Take away rings and nose jewelry, suits, mantles, wimples, crimping pins, glasses, linen hoods, and veils.
2942. Isaiah 3:24-26 Stink will replace sweet smell, baldness will replace hair, and there will be sackcloth, defeat, and desolation.
2943. Isaiah 4:1-6 On the final day of judgment sin will be abolished, all will claim God, and Zion will shine.
2944. Isaiah 5:1-12 Israel (Judah) is compared to a bad vineyard; God promises desolation and says Judah is drunk..
2945. Isaiah 5:13-14 God says Judah has gone into captivity for ignorance and dishonor, and headed for hell.
2946. Isaiah 5:15-24 Woe unto Judah who calls evil good; Judah is unwise, drinkers, justifying wickedness; they have cast away the law.
2947. Isaiah 5:25-30 God is angry and invites foreign nations to take Judah and to give her darkness and sorrow.
2948. Isaiah 6:1-4 Isaiah has a vision like the Book of Revelation in the year that King Uzziah died of the Lord on His throne with seraphims.

2949. Isaiah 6:5-7 Isaiah says, “Woe is me of unclean lips;” A seraphim lays hot coals upon his lips and cleanses him.
2950. Isaiah 6:8 God says, “WHOM SHALL I SEND?” Isaiah says, “HERE AM I, SEND ME!”
2951. Isaiah 6:9-13 Judah is blind and condemned but God will preserve a tenth of Judah for seed.
2952. Isaiah 7:1 King Uzziah’s son, Ahaz, is now King of Judah; Syria and Israel war against Judah.
2953. Isaiah 7:2-9 God speaks to Isaiah and tells him to tell King Ahaz that Ephraim has joined his enemies, Israel and Syria against him but they will not win.
2954. Isaiah 7:10-13 God speaks to King Ahaz of Judah, “Ask of me a sign.” Ahaz refuses to ask and God says, “You weary me; here is a sign anyway.”
2955. Isaiah 7:14 God’s sign: “BEHOLD, A VIRGIN SHALL CONCEIVE AND BEAR A SON, AND SHALL CALL HIS NAME ‘EMMANUEL’.”
2956. Isaiah 7:15-16 God: “EMMANUEL WILL REFUSE EVIL AND CHOOSE GOOD; BEFORE HE COMES THE KINGS OF JUDAH AND ISRAEL WILL BE GONE.
2957. Isaiah 7:17-25 God’s transformation of Ephraim and Assyria; He causes desolation, briers, and thorns in the lands.
2958. Isaiah 8:1-3 God tells Isaiah to write concerning a prophetess; he impregnates her and has a son named Maher-shalah-hash-baz.
2959. Isaiah 8:4 God says that before Maher-shalah-hash-baz says “mother” and “father” Damascus and Syria’s riches shall be taken away.

2960. Isaiah 8:5-8 God says He will bring river waters and flood all of Assyria and Judah up to the armpits.
2961. Isaiah 8:9-22 God's further condemnation of Israel, Judah, and Jerusalem will be hunger and darkness.
2962. Isaiah 9:1-2 God says the darkness will change, "THE PEOPLE THAT WALKED IN DARKNESS HAVE SEEN A GREAT LIGHT...."
2963. Isaiah 9:3-5 God will break the yoke of sin's oppression of Judah and the oppressor will release her.
2964. Isaiah 9:6 God: "FOR UNTO US A CHILD IS BORN, UNTO US A SON IS GIVEN; AND THE GOVERNMENT SHALL BE UPON HIS SHOULDER; AND HIS NAME SHALL BE CALLED WONDERFUL, COUNSELLOR, THE MIGHTY GOD, THE EVERLASTING FATHER, THE PRINCE OF PEACE."
2965. Isaiah 9:7 God: "OF THE INCREASE OF HIS GOVERNMENT AND PEACE THERE SHALL BE NO END, UPON THE THRONE OF DAVID, AND UPON HIS KINGDOM, TO ORDER IT, AND TO ESTABLISH IT WITH JUDGMENT AND WITH JUSTICE FROM HENCEFORTH EVEN FOREVER; THE ZEAL OF THE LORD OF HOSTS WILL PERFORM THIS."
2966. Isaiah 9:8-21 God's continued anger against Judah and Israel; their bad leaders and civil war consume each other.
2967. Isaiah 10:1-2 Woe to the unrighteous, grieving the needy and poor, making the widows their prey, and robbing the fatherless.
2968. Isaiah 10:3-10 On the "Day of Visitation," Assyria will be sent against Judah and take it as prey for its godlessness.
2969. Isaiah 10:11 God says that Judah (Jerusalem) deserves the same fate as Israel (Samaria) for its idols and sins.

2970. Isaiah 10:12-15 After punishing Zion (Jerusalem), God will punish Assyria for its bragging.
2971. Isaiah 10:16-19 God will send leanness upon Assyria and rekindle the fire of Israel and consume Assyria.
2972. Isaiah 10:20-23 God says He will rescue the remnant of Israel (Jacob) and they will return home.
2973. Isaiah 10:24-26 God tells Zion, "Don't be afraid of Assyria; I will punish Assyria as I did Egypt.
2974. Isaiah 10:27-34 God says that the yoke shall be lifted from Israel and Judah and the enemy, including Lebanon will be destroyed.
2975. Isaiah 11:1 PROPHECY OF JESUS' COMING FROM THE STEM OF JESSE; CHRISTIANITY WILL GROW FROM HIM.
2976. Isaiah 11:2 GOD'S SPIRIT WILL REST UPON JESUS, OF WISDOM, UNDERSTANDING, COUNSEL, AND KNOWLEDGE.
2977. Isaiah 11:3-4 HE SHALL JUDGE THE POOR, REPROVE WITH EQUITY, SMITE THE EARTH, AND SLAY THE WICKED.
2978. Isaiah 11:5 RIGHTEOUSNESS SHALL BE THE GIRDLE OF HIS LOINS AND FAITHFULNESS SHALL BE THE GIRDLE OF HIS REINS.
2979. Isaiah 11:6-9 END TIMES; THE WOLF SHALL DWELL WITH THE LAMB, LEOPARD WITH THE KID, LION WITH THE CALF; A LITTLE CHILD SHALL LEAD THEM; THE LION SHALL EAT STRAW; THE SUCKLING CHILD SHALL BE IMMUNE FROM HARM OF THE ASP AND COCKATRICE; THE LORD SHALL COVER THE EARTH.

2980. Isaiah 11:10 JESUS, THE ROOT OF JESSE SHALL STAND AS AN ENSIGN; GENTILES WILL SEEK JESUS; HIS REST WILL BE GLORIOUS.
2981. Isaiah 11:11-12 GOD SHALL RECOVER HIS PEOPLE (JEWS) AND GATHER THE DISPERSED OF JUDAH FROM THE FOUR CORNERS OF THE EARTH.
2982. Isaiah 11:13-16 God will deal with Israel's enemies, smite the Egyptian Sea and River, and build a highway.
2983. Isaiah 12:1-6 There will be praise of God's power in that day, singing, crying, shouting from Zion, and no more anger from God.
2984. Isaiah 13:1-5 GOD GATHERING HIS ARMIES FOR A FINAL BATTLE IN THE END DAYS TO DESTROY THE LAND.
2985. Isaiah 13:6-8 THE DAY OF THE LORD IS AT HAND; DESTRUCTION FROM THE ALMIGHTY; IN HORROR MEN'S HEARTS SHALL MELT.
2986. Isaiah 13:9 THE LORD COMES, CRUEL, WITH WRATH AND FIERCE ANGER TO LAY THE LAND DESOLATE AND DESTROY SINNERS.
2987. Isaiah 13:10 IN THESE END DAYS THE STARS, SUN, AND MOON WILL CEASE TO SHINE.
2988. Isaiah 13:11-13 GOD WILL PUNISH THE WORLD'S EVIL; THE PROUD WILL CEASE; HE WILL SHAKE THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH WILL MOVE OUT OF ITS PLACE.
2989. Isaiah 13:14-18 WARRIORS WILL COME AND KILL ALL THEY FIND, CHILDREN DASHED TO PIECES, KILLED EVEN IN THE WOMB.

2990. Isaiah 13:19-22 PROPHECY DESTRUCTION OF BABYLON AND THE CHILDEES; THEY WILL BE UNINHABITED BY HUMANS AND DESOLATE.
2991. Isaiah 14:1-11 PRESERVATION OF ISRAEL; BABYLON IS STRICKEN; HELL HAS COME UPON BABYLON.
2992. Isaiah 14:12-14 LUCIFER (SATAN) IS CAST FROM HEAVEN; HE IS STILL CLAIMING HIS THRONE OVER HEAVEN AND EARTH.
2993. Isaiah 14:15-20 PROPHECY OF LUCIFER'S FAILURES, DESTRUCTION, AND OUTCASTING, NEVER TO BE RENOWNED.
2994. Isaiah 14:21-32 Destruction of God's enemies, including Assyria; Palestine recovery; poor trusting in Zion.
2995. Isaiah 15:1-9 Moab laid waste, bald heads, beards shaved, land dried up, and blood in its waters.
2996. Isaiah 16:1-14 God's word against Moab; oppressors consumed; King David's throne established again.
2997. Isaiah 17:1-7 Destruction of Damascus and Syria; famine; harvest failure; turning to "The Holy One of Israel."
2998. Isaiah 17:8-14 Desolation of cities; harvest failure; people will mourn like rushing waters roar.
2999. Isaiah 18:1-7 People beyond Ethiopia will come and discover a Holy Land destroyed by floods.
3000. Isaiah 19:1-4 Destruction of Egypt by civil war; it will be given over to a cruel king.
3001. Isaiah 19:5-10 Egypt's waters will dry up; there will be no industry from fishing, flax, reeds, etc.
3002. Isaiah 19:11-16 Egypt's pharaohs, wise men, and ancient kings shall have perverse spirits.

3003. Isaiah 19:17-21 Judah shall be a terror to Egypt; Egypt will cry out for a savior.
3004. Isaiah 19:22-25 God will send a savior to Egypt, which will join in friendship with Assyria and Israel and build a great highway in between.
3005. Isaiah 20:1-4 GOD CALLS ISAIAH TO WALK NAKED FOR THREE YEARS AND PROPHECY; Assyria will take Egypt and Ethiopia; both will be carried away naked for a shame upon them.
3006. Isaiah 20:5-6 Fear and shame in Egypt and Ethiopia; wishing to escape from Assyria.
3007. Isaiah 21:1-17 God's grievous burden and failures in desert Arabia; Babylon is fallen.
3008. Isaiah 22:1-5 Burden of the Valley of Vision, walls falling, mountains crying.
3009. Isaiah 22:6-12 Chariots of men shall array and fill the choicest valleys and at the gate; the walls have holes; houses are torn down to breach and fortify the walls; God calls all to weeping, mourning, baldness, and wearing sackcloth.
3010. Isaiah 22:13 The final feast; joy and gladness; "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we shall die!"
3011. Isaiah 22:14-25 God's purging of the land; God calling a servant that is fastened to God like a nail.
3012. Isaiah 23:1-18 The burden of Tyre; destruction for seventy years; ship fleets wasted; return to God.
3013. Isaiah 24:1-6 God laying the earth waste because of all kinds of perversion; few men are left.
3014. Isaiah 24:7-18 Music and joy ceases; cries for wine; people begin singing "Woe is me!" People are falling into a pit.

3015. Isaiah 24:19-23 The earth is broken, dissolved, shaken, and leaders are imprisoned; the sun and moon hide.
3016. Isaiah 25:1-5 Isaiah praising God for His powerful acts against the evil ones.
3017. Isaiah 25:6-8 God's feast; rescue of his people; swallowing up death in victory; no more tears.
3018. Isaiah 25:9-12 Israel giving recognition to God and His destruction of its enemies.
3019. Isaiah 26:1-4 Israel sings songs made up for God; in "Jehovah" God is eternal strength.
3020. Isaiah 26:5-21 God's bringing down of the evil; Israel's pain; the dead are risen.
3021. Isaiah 27:1 GOD'S DESTRUCTION OF LEVIATHAN, "THE DRAGON THAT IS IN THE SEA."
3022. Isaiah 27:2-6 Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit.
3023. Isaiah 27:7-13 Purging Jacob; trumpet will sound and all exiles will come to Zion.
3024. Isaiah 28:1-29 Woe to drunkards of Ephraim; God's glorious beauty; Zion foundation laid.
3025. Isaiah 29:1-8 King David's city "Ariel" punished; destruction against nations fighting Zion.
3026. Isaiah 29:9-24 God retarding the enemy; showing the wise to be fools; making the deaf, blind, meek, and poor fulfilled.
3027. Isaiah 30:1-7 God speaks to Israel of the reason for its Egyptian exile; anguish sent to Egypt.
3028. Isaiah 30:8-24 God tells Isaiah to write a book of Israel's rebellion; God's gifts withheld; teaching refused.

3029. Isaiah 30:25-26 Day of the great slaughter; moon is as bright as the sun and the sun is seven times brighter than usual; God's healing.
3030. Isaiah 30:27-33 God's devouring entry; keeping the Holy Solemnity; God's consuming fire to His enemies.
3031. Isaiah 31:1-9 God's pronouncements against Egypt and Assyria; their destruction; Zion's strength.
3032. Isaiah 32:1-20 A king shall reign in righteousness; devices of liberals; a call for women; judgment.
3033. Isaiah 33:1-24 Woe to spoilers; rewards for good and bad; hell fire is everlasting; look to Zion.
3034. Isaiah 34:1-3 God's message to earth: indignation upon all nations; the slain will stink; the mountains will be melted with the blood of the dead.
3035. Isaiah 34:4 HEAVEN SHALL BE DISSOLVED (STARS AND SKIES); SKIES SHALL BE ROLLED TOGETHER AS A SCROLL (THE EXPANDING UNIVERSE SHALL COME BACK TOGETHER).
3036. Isaiah 34:5-10 The sword of God; land soaked with blood; God's vengeance for Zion; dust to brimstone; land burning as pitch; fire and smoke forever; the land shall lie waste forever (End Times).
3037. Isaiah 34:11-17 Order to read the Book of God; Animals, vultures, etc; the land will be a habitation for dragons.
3038. Isaiah 35:1-10 Streams in the desert; God's reversal for the redeemed; grass and a highway where the dragons were.
3039. Isaiah 36:1-11 In the fourteenth year of King Hezekiah, King Sennacherib of Assyria besieges Jerusalem.
3040. Isaiah 36:12-22 Rabshakeh speaks for Assyria to Zion, "You are doomed, there is no escape, God won't help!"

3041. Isaiah 37:1-5 King Hezekiah is in sackcloth and ashes in the Temple; he sends Eliakim to Isaiah for hope.
3042. Isaiah 37:6-7 Isaiah sends word to King Hezekiah, "God will blast King Sennacherib and he will die."
3043. Isaiah 37:8-13 Assyrian King Sennacherib brags of his conquests and warns King Hezekiah; then other nations attack Assyria's army.
3044. Isaiah 37:14-35 King Hezekiah prays; Isaiah brings a message from God: "I will save my remnant."
3045. Isaiah 37:36 The Angel of Death smites one hundred eighty-five thousand Assyrians; the rest awake among the dead corpses in camp.
3046. Isaiah 37:37-38 King Sennacherib returns home to Assyria and is worshipping his idol when his two sons murder him and escape.
3047. Isaiah 38:1-5 King Hezekiah is told he is dying, turns his face to the wall, cries, and begs God to let him live; GOD CHANGES HIS MIND and gives Hezekiah fifteen more years to live.
3048. Isaiah 38:6-22 God gives a sign that Assyria will stay away; as a sign, God rolls the sun back ten degrees; Isaiah orders a lump of figs to put on King Hezekiah's boil; it heals and he recovers.
3049. Isaiah 39:1-4 The son of the King of Babylon pays a visit to sick King Hezekiah; while there, Hezekiah shows him all over the palace and all of the riches and treasures of Jerusalem.
3050. Isaiah 39:5-8 God and Isaiah are angry with King Hezekiah and tell him that Babylon will take Israel captive with all of its treasures, and his sons will become eunuchs in the palace of the King of Babylon.
3051. Isaiah 40:1-2 God's word to Jerusalem that she has finally paid for all of her sins.

3052. Isaiah 40:3-5 THE PROPHECY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST AND THE COMING OF JESUS; GOD HAS SPOKEN IT.
3053. Isaiah 40:6-11 The earth is perishable and God is imperishable; God's love and care for Zion.
3054. Isaiah 40:12-30 God's mighty power is spoken of the foundations of the earth and creation; God faints not.
3055. Isaiah 40:31 THEY THAT WAIT UPON THE LORD SHALL...MOUNT UP WITH WINGS...AND NOT FAINT.
3056. Isaiah 41:1-29 God speaking to Israel; His control and might; He calls Jacob (Israel) a worm and weak without God.
3057. Isaiah 42:1-4 GOD'S WORD ON A MESSIAH (JESUS) WHO WILL CAUSE THE GENTILES TO BE SAVED.
3058. Isaiah 42:5-25 God's word to Israel; bringing a new age, a new song, and praise; God leading Israel.
3059. Isaiah 43:1-17 God's ownership and control over Israel; their Savior; Jews returning to Jerusalem from all directions.
3060. Isaiah 43:18-28 God tells Israel not to look back; rivers in the desert; dragons will honor Him.
3061. Isaiah 44:1-5 God's birth of Israel; His Spirit poured out on them; many fakers will come.
3062. Isaiah 44:6 God declaring Himself as King of Israel and (Jesus) Redeemer, the Lord of Hosts; God is the first and the last, there is no other God.
3063. Isaiah 44:7-20 God declares Israel and speaks woe to idol makers.
3064. Isaiah 44:21-28 God again declares Israel and His creation, might, and Lordship over them.

3065. Isaiah 45:1-8 God's protection; declaring His oneness and power over the elements and universe.
3066. Isaiah 45:9 Woe to any who strive against their maker as clay against the potter.
3067. Isaiah 45:10-25 THE WORLD WILL BOW DOWN TO ISRAEL; GOD HAS SWORN TO IT AND JUSTIFIED THEM.
3068. Isaiah 46:1-13 God talking directly to Israel; orders of conduct; woe to the enemies of Zion.
3069. Isaiah 47:1-15 Woe to Babylon and Chaldeans; "Your nakedness is uncovered; no enchantments will save you."
3070. Isaiah 48:1-22 God declares the unrighteousness but deliverance of Israel; He reminds them of the Exodus.
3071. Isaiah 49:1-26 Israel's word back to God, declaring Him; God gives Israel power and gives salvation to the Gentiles.
3072. Isaiah 50:1-11 God speaks His power; Israel acknowledges through the words of Isaiah.
3073. Isaiah 51:1-23 God tells Israel to remember Abraham; "Be aware, strong, and know My power."
3074. Isaiah 52:1-15 God speaks: "Awaken Zion!, you're free of captivity!, know that your God reigns!"
3075. Isaiah 53:1-12 "WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT..." PROPHECY, LIFE, PERSECUTION, DEATH, AND RESURRECTION OF JESUS.
3076. Isaiah 54:1-17 God's message of the parallel of Israel and Jesus; Gentiles saved; God's protection.
3077. Isaiah 55:1-5 God's call to Israel; "My protection is free; call upon Me; I will glorify you."

3078. Isaiah 55:6-13 God: "Seek ye the Lord; My ways and thoughts are higher than yours; the trees shall clap their hands."
3079. Isaiah 56:1-12 God's blessings to all who obey; eunuchs are special; outcasts deserve condemnation.
3080. Isaiah 57:1-21 God's message to the evil; their many sins; they will have no peace.
3081. Isaiah 58:1-14 God's word to Israel on fasting, rewards, and following his guidance.
3082. Isaiah 59:1-21 God tells Israel of her multitude of sins, repentance, redemption, and covenant forever.
3083. Isaiah 60:1-13 God's prophesy of the end times, "Thy light is come," The Gentiles shall come to thy light.
3084. Isaiah 60:14-17 All shall bow down to Zion, The Holy One of Israel, The City of The Lord.
3085. Isaiah 60:18-22 GOD'S WORD ON THE NEW JERUSALEM; NO MORE SUN NOR MOON; THE SMALL WILL BE GREAT.
3086. Isaiah 61:1-11 God's Spirit and anointing to the Gentiles and Jews who preach God's Word.
3087. Isaiah 62:1-12 GOD'S CHOSEN NEW NAME "BEULAH," THE HOLY PEOPLE; THE REDEEMED OF GOD; "SOUGHT OUT."
3088. Isaiah 63:1-19 God's vengeance against Edom (Esau), the Exodus, and Israel's inheritance.
3089. Isaiah 64:1-12 Israel's repentance; sermon to God, declaring Him the Potter and Israel, the clay.
3090. Isaiah 65:1-25 God is angry and provoked, "I will create a new heaven and earth; the wolf and lamb, lion and bullock will eat straw and the devil will eat dust (serpent)."
3091. Isaiah 66:1-14 God: "Heaven is my Throne, earth is my footstool, I will give glory to the Gentiles."

3092. Isaiah 66:15-24

God's fire will come; gather all nations; new heavens and earth; transgressors will burn forever.
