2599. James 1:1 James (Probably the brother of Jesus) writing to the Scattered (Ten Lost) Tribes Of Israel.
2600. James 1:2-3 Count divers temptations as joy because trying your faith causes patience.
2601. James 1:4 Let patience do its work to make you perfect and complete, wanting nothing.
2602. James 1:5 If you need wisdom, ask God; He won't criticize you and will give you what you ask.
2603. James 1:6 We must ask for faith, never wavering; those who waver are tossed like the sea by the wind.
2604. James 1:7-9 A wavering person is unstable; let the lowly rejoice when exalted by wisdom.
2605. James 1:10-11 The rich will be made low and fade away like the bloom of grass as the sun burns it.
2606. James 1:12 Blessed is he who endures temptation; tried, he will receive the Crown Of Life God promised to those that love Him.
2607. James 1:13 God can cause no temptation; He can have no part with evil.
2608. James 1:14-15 Man drawn by lust and enticed, is drawn into sin; sin, when finished, brings death.
2609. James 1:16-17 Do not err; every good gift is from above and comes down from The Father Of Lights Who has no variableness nor shadow of turning.
2610. James 1:18-20 Be swift to hear and slow to speak and cause wrath; wrath does not do the

righteousness of God.

2611. James 1:21 Lay aside filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness; receive meekness and the engrafted Word Of God.
2612. James 1:22 BE DOERS OF GOD'S WORD AND NOT HEARERS ONLY, DECEIVING YOURSELVES.
2613. James 1:23-25 Do not just hear, like looking in a mirror and forgetting; be a doer and remember.
2614. James 1:26 IF ONE SEEMS RILIGIOUS BUT DOESN'T CONTROL HIS TONGUE, HE DECEIVES HIS HEART AND HIS RELIGION IS IN VAIN.
2615. James 1:27 TRUE UNDEFILED RELIGION BEFORE GOD IS TO VISIT THE FATHERLESS AND WIDOWS IN AFFLICTION AND TO KEEP UNSPOTTED FROM THE WORLD.
2616. James 2:1 Jesus can respect persons as He is perfect; we are limited by our human frailties.
2617. James 2:2-4 We must not show more respect to the rich except in terms of their possessions.
2618. James 2:5 GOD HAS CHOSEN THE POOR AS HIS FAVORITE BECAUSE THEY ARE MORE RICH IN FAITH AND LOVE FOR HIM.
2619. James 2:6-9 We are transgressors of the law if we love by wealth; we must love our neighbors as ourselves.
2620. James 2:10-12 One law broken equals all laws broken and transgression of the law, and calls for judgment.

2621. James 2:13 If we show no mercy in judgment, we will be judged likewise without mercy.
2622. James 2:14-17 **FAITH WITHOUT WORKS IS DEAD; WE CANNOT SPEAK HELP FOR THE NEEDY, WE MUST DO THE HELP.**
2623. James 2:18 Works are a better indicator of faith; show works when speaking of faith.
2624. James 2:19-20 Believing that there is one God is not proof of faith; devils believe that; **WE MUST HAVE WORKS TO SHOW FAITH.**
2625. James 2:21-22 Abraham showed faith when he placed Isaac on the altar; see how you must do so to make faith perfect.
2626. James 2:23 **ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD AND IT WAS COUNTED FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS (SALVATION BEFORE JESUS CAME).**
2627. James 2:24-26 Man is justified by works with faith such as Rahab at Jericho hiding and saving the spies of Israel; **AS A BODY WITHOUT A SPIRIT IS DEAD, SO IS FAITH WITHOUT WORKS.**
2628. James 3:1 Many wanting to be leaders (masters) should not be, for leaders receive greater condemnation for their mistakes.
2629. James 3:2 We often offend everyone; if we never offend, we are perfect and able to control our entire body.
2630. James 3:3-4 Horses and ships are controlled by small things, bits and rudders; so should be our tongues.
2631. James 3:5-6 **THE TONGUE (SMALL) BOASTS GREAT THINGS AND CAN START**

HELL FIRES AND DEFILE THE
WHOLE BODY.

2632. James 3:7-9 Creatures can be tamed; an untamed tongue is unruly, evil, and full of poison; the tongue can bless God and curse men.
2633. James 3:10-12 The same mouth should not emit blessings and cursing but like a fountain, give only water, or a tree, give only fruit.
2634. James 3:13 If one is wise and educated, let his conversation show works and meekness of wisdom.
2635. James 3:14-15 If we have envying and strife in our hearts, we must not glory or lie; such "wisdom" is earthly and devilish.
2636. James 3:16 Where there is envying and strife, there is confusion and every evil work.
2637. James 3:17-18 Wisdom from heaven is pure, peaceable, gentle, easily given, and merciful, with good fruits and without partiality and hypocrisy; the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by peacemakers.
2638. James 4:1 Wars among you come from lusts that war in your carnal bodies.
2639. James 4:2-3 Lusts, killing, and war cannot bring gain; YOU HAVE NOT BECAUSE YOU ASK NOT; you ask amiss with lust.
2640. James 4:4 Adulterous conduct is friendship with the world and enmity with God; a friend of the world is the enemy of God.
2641. James 4:5 The Scripture never lies; the human spirit lusts to envy.

2642. James 4:6 God gives more grace; He resists the proud but gives grace to the humble.
2643. James 4:7 **SUBMIT YOURSELVES TO GOD; RESIST THE DEVIL AND HE WILL FLEE FROM YOU.**
2644. James 4:8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you; cleanse yourselves and purify your hearts you sinners and double minded.
2645. James 4:9 Sinners, turn your laughter to mourning and your joy to heaviness.
2646. James 4:10 **HUMBLE YOURSELVES IN GOD'S SIGHT AND HE WILL LIFT YOU UP.**
2647. James 4:11 If you speak evil of a brother, it is judging and speaking evil of the law, and can be sinful.
2648. James 4:12 Only God gives the law and ability to save or destroy. Should we judge?
2649. James 4:13-16 Don't say that you will do something tomorrow without saying, "IF IT IS GOD'S WILL."
2650. James 4:17 If one knows to do good and does evil, it is a sin (accountability exists).
2651. James 5:1 **RICH PEOPLE SHOULD PREPARE TO WEEP AND HOWL, FOR MISERY IS ON ITS WAY.**
2652. James 5:2-3 **YOUR RICHES ARE CORRUPT, YOUR CLOTHING ROTTEN, YOUR GOLD CANKERED AND RUSTY, AND A WITNESS AGAINST YOU WHICH WILL EAT YOU LIKE FIRE; YOU'VE HEAPED TREASURES FOR DEATH.**

To the poor: Be patient, wait for the

2656. James 5:9
GRUDGE NOT THE RICH
PERSECUTING YOU; DO NOT
CONDEMN YOURSELF; THE
JUDGE (GOD) IS STANDING AT
THE DOOR.
2657. James 5:10
God's Prophets have spoken in the
Name of The Lord; theirs is an example
of long suffering.
2658. James 5:11
Be happy, with endurance like Job; God
is ready with tender mercy and pity.
2659. James 5:12
NEVER "SWEAR" BY HEAVEN OR
EARTH; MAKE NO OATHS, JUST
BE TRUTHFUL, WITH "YES" OR
"NO" OR GOD COULD CONDEMN
YOU.
2660. James 5:13
If you are afflicted, pray; if you are
happy, sing Psalms.
2661. James 5:14
FOR THE SICK, CALL THE
CHURCH ELDERS TO PRAY OVER
AND ANOINT THEM WITH OIL IN
THE NAME OF JESUS.
2662. James 5:15
The prayer of faith will save the sick;
God will raise them and if they have
sinned, He will forgive them.

2663. James 5:16 Confess your faults to each other; pray for each other for healing; prayers of the righteous are very effective.
2664. James 5:17-18 Elijah was like us; he prayed for rain to cease and it ceased for three and a half years; he prayed again and rain came and fruit grew.
2665. James 5:19-20 IF ONE ERRS AND YOU CONVERT HIM, YOU SAVE A SOUL FROM DEATH AND HIDE A MULTITUDE OF SINS.
