

## JEREMIAH

3093. Jeremiah 1:1 Priest/Prophet Jeremiah, son of Hilkiah in Anathoth, Land of Benjamin.
3094. Jeremiah 1:2-3 Time Line: Josiah, son of Amon, is King of Judah, through Kings Jehoiakim and Zedekiah.
3095. Jeremiah 1:3-4 Judah enters Babylonian captivity; God's Word comes to Jeremiah.
3096. Jeremiah 1:5-12 God sanctifies Jeremiah from birth and says, "Have no fear and mind what I say."
3097. Jeremiah 1:13-19 God: "The enemy will come from the North, Kings of Judah will fight against you."
3098. Jeremiah 2:1-25 God chastises Judah and the House of Jacob for falling away and changing to idols.
3099. Jeremiah 2:26-37 The House of Israel is a shame to God; it refuses correction and claims innocence.
3100. Jeremiah 3:1-8 God condemns both Israel and sister Judah as harlots; He divorces them for adultery.
3101. Jeremiah 3:9-25 God calls Israel and Judah back to Him and to be together, all at Jerusalem (Zion).
3102. Jeremiah 4:1-31 God declares judgment upon Israel and Judah; He talks of their sins and pain.
3103. Jeremiah 5:1-31 God can find no righteousness in Israel and Judah with their false kings and false prophets.
3104. Jeremiah 6:1-30 Jeremiah's word against Jerusalem, their multi-sins; they are about to be attacked.
3105. Jeremiah 7:1-7 God tells Jeremiah to stand in the Temple gate and to preach repentance to Judah.

3106. Jeremiah 7:8-16                      Jeremiah preaching, warning Judah and Benjamin; telling how God has expelled Ephraim.
3107. Jeremiah 7:17-34                    God says He will send desolation to Judah; idols, valley of hinnom, burning their sons and daughters.
3108. Jeremiah 8:1-3                        Bones of all kings will be dug up and lie around Zion; death will be chosen over life.
3109. Jeremiah 8:4-20                      God says the wise are fools; they say “peace” when there is none; diseases are coming (including AIDS), sorrow and death.
3110. Jeremiah 8:21-22                    God is hurt and says, “I AM BLACK and astonished; there is no balm in Gilead and there are no physicians!”
3111. Jeremiah 9:1-6                        God is crying tears; he says all are liars; none can be trusted; neighbors are all deceitful.
3112. Jeremiah 9:7-11                      God will melt Judah; Jerusalem will be desolate, a den of dragons.
3113. Jeremiah 9:12-26                    God’s continued condemnation of Judah; His call for mourning; He says there are no circumcised hearts.
3114. Jeremiah 10:1-25                    Jeremiah preaching God’s wrath; pastors are brutish; flocks are scattered; “you are a den of dragons!”
3115. Jeremiah 11:1-23                    God recalls the Exodus; the covenant is now broken; there is conspiracy; God’s chosen are no more.
3116. Jeremiah 12:1-17                    Jeremiah discusses Judah’s sin; God condemns, then gives a possibility of hope.
3117. Jeremiah 13:1-14                    God instructs Jeremiah with a girdle; says it is a symbol of Israel and Judah’s destruction.
3118. Jeremiah 13:15-27                    God says evil of his chosen, that they can’t change, like an Ethiopian can’t change his black skin.

3119. Jeremiah 14:1-6 Judah is mourning her dearth, no water, no grass, ground is chapt, and their animals are like dragons.
3120. Jeremiah 14:7-22 Iniquity is upon Judah; Jeremiah asks God; God says Judah has false prophets and doom.
3121. Jeremiah 15:1-14 God says Moses and Samuel couldn't correct Judah (Israel); and King Manasseh was the worst king.
3122. Jeremiah 15:15-21 God's revenge and dispersal of Israel will reverse if they repent, saying He will protect them.
3123. Jeremiah 16:1-9 God tells Jeremiah to not marry or have children because they will die and not be buried.
3124. Jeremaih 16:10-21 God speaks doom to Israel for the sins of their fathers and now their sons, idol worshippers.
3125. Jeremiah 17:1-4 God says their condemnation is written by a pen of iron with a point of diamond, on their altars.
3126. Jeremiah 17:5-14 Cursed is man trusting man; the heart is deceitful and wicked; Israel trying to repent.
3127. Jeremiah 17:15-27 Jeremiah preaching in Zion; reverence for the Sabbath; godly conduct doesn't work.
3128. Jeremiah 18:1-6 God sends Jeremiah to the potter's house; says Israel must be clay in God's hands.
3129. Jeremiah 18:7-17 God tells Jeremiah to speak to Judah but that there is no hope, "My people have forgotten Me."
3130. Jeremiah 18:18-23 Jeremiah tells God that Judah is conspiring to abuse him; their fathers and sons are wicked.
3131. Jeremiah 19:1-8 God sends Jeremiah with potter's clay bottle to the Valley of Hinnom; change to Valley of Slaughter.

3132. Jeremiah 19:9-15 God says fathers shall eat the flesh of their sons and friends; tells Jeremiah to break the clay bottle as a symbol of no healing.
3133. Jeremiah 20:1-6 Pashur, governor of the Temple puts Jeremiah in stocks; Jeremiah tells him of the coming Babylonian captivity.
3134. Jeremiah 20:7-18 Jeremiah accuses God of deceiving him; speaks sorrow of his birth (like Job).
3135. Jeremiah 21:1-14 God refuses protection to King Zedekiah; says that many will die in Zion and the rest taken into captivity by King Nebuchadrezzar of Babylon.
3136. Jeremiah 22:1-30 God's prophesy against Zion and Jehoiakim and their captivity, desolation, and death.
3137. Jeremiah 23:1-2 God's woe to pastors who don't lead nor feed God's people, "I will visit evil upon them."
3138. Jeremiah 23:3-12 God says He will revive King David's branch: "THE SAVIOR WILL BE "THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS."
3139. Jeremiah 23:13-29 God says that Samaria (Israel) and Judah (Zion) are like Sodom and Gomorrah.
3140. Jeremiah 23:30-40 God against prophets using tongues (false interpretations); they are a perpetual shame.
3141. Jeremiah 24:1-10 Judah's captivity to Babylon completed; God shows Jeremiah good and bad baskets of figs; the good basket represents the good taken captive that God will rescue.
3142. Jeremiah 25:1-38 God speaks desolation to the whole Canaan area and of their seventy-year captivity in Babylon.
3143. Jeremiah 26:1-9 Jeremiah speaks God's word to priests and prophets of Judah taken prisoner.

3144. Jeremiah 26:10-15 The prophets tell the Zion princes Jeremiah's words and condemn him.
3145. Jeremiah 26:16-24 The princes rescue Jeremiah and tell of other prophets who helped save them.
3146. Jeremiah 27:1-22 God sends Jeremiah with yokes and bonds for all of the countries facing Babylon captivity.
3147. Jeremiah 28:1-17 Prophet Hananiah rebuts Jeremiah, breaks the yoke, and lies about the prophesy; God takes his life.
3148. Jeremiah 29:1-14 God speaks to the Babylonian captives and tells them they have prophets and to raise families and keep the faith for seventy years.
3149. Jeremiah 29:15-32 God condemns the remnant left in Canaan and the false prophet to the Babylonian captives.
3150. Jeremiah 30:1-24 God tells Jeremiah to write a book the of rescue of Israel and Judah and death to Babylon.
3151. Jeremiah 31:1-14 God's great rescue of Israel and Judah and the greatness of life after the rescue.
3152. Jeremiah 31:15 God reminds Israel of Ramah (in Egypt) and Rahel weeping for her children Pharaoh slayed.
3153. Jeremiah 31:16-30 God tells Israel to wipe her tears and calls for repentance and no more sour grapes.
3154. Jeremiah 31:31-40 God promises a New Covenant to Israel and Judah and a cleaning up of the Holy Land.
3155. Jeremiah 32:1-5 Jeremiah is captive of King Zedekiah in Judah; the King of Babylon besieges Jerusalem.
3156. Jeremiah 32:6-36 God speaks words to Jeremiah of buying lands and claiming the rights God gave.

3157. Jeremiah 32:37-44 GOD SPEAKS THE RETURN OF THE JEWS TO THE HOLY LAND (SAME PROPHECY AND COVENANT THAT TOOK PLACE IN 1948).
3158. Jeremiah 33:1-26 Jeremiah is a captive; relates God's words on Israel and Judah captivity and throne of King David.
3159. Jeremiah 34:1-7 Jeremiah speaks God's plan for King Zedekiah of Judah while King Nebuchadrezzar is in siege.
3160. Jeremiah 34:8-22 King Zedekiah proclaims the freedom of all bondsmen; Judah complies, then reverses.
3161. Jeremiah 35:1-19 God's word to the Rechabites, non-drinking tent dwellers who obey Jonadab, but not God.
3162. Jeremiah 36:1-4 God tells Jeremiah to write his book from the date of Josiah through Jehoiakim.
3163. Jeremiah 36:5-19 Scribe Baruch finishes the Book of Jeremiah; he is sent to read it to Judah; it scared them.
3164. Jeremiah 36:20-26 Jeremiah book is read to King Jehoiakim who takes a knife, cuts it to pieces, and burns it; he is very angry.
3165. Jeremiah 36:27-32 Jeremiah and Baruch are told of God to write the book again and to add some.
3166. Jeremiah 37:1-4 King Nebuchadrezzar of Babylon makes Zedekiah King of Judah, not Jehoiakim's son.
3167. Jeremiah 37:5-12 The Egyptians come against Jerusalem and run the Chaldeans off for a while and go home.
3168. Jeremiah 37:13-17 Jeremiah is accused of going to the Chaldeans; King Zedekiah rescues him.
3169. Jeremiah 37:18-21 Jeremiah is taken from the dungeon and allowed to be a prisoner in the court of Zion.

3170. Jeremiah 38:1-6 The princes of Judah are angry about the Book of Jeremiah and are allowed to cast Jeremiah into the dungeon mire.
3171. Jeremiah 38:7-13 An Ethiopian eunuch, Ebedmelech asks King Zedekiah for the rescue of Jeremiah; granted, he ties old rags together and pulls Jeremiah out of the mire; he then resides in the court.
3172. Jeremiah 38:14-28 Jeremiah confers with King Zedekiah to be taken to Babylon so as to save Jerusalem.
3173. Jeremiah 39:1-8 King Zedekiah refuses to surrender to Babylon's siege; Jerusalem is destroyed; Zedekiah's sons are slain before him and his eyes are put out; he is bound and taken captive; Jerusalem's walls are torn down.
3174. Jeremiah 39:9-18 A remnant of Judah is left on the land under Nebuzaradan; Jeremiah is saved and in turn he saves the Ethiopian eunuch, Ebedmelech for rescuing him from the mire of the dungeon.
3175. Jeremiah 40:1-6 Gedaliah is made Governor of Judean cities and allows Jeremiah his freedom.
3176. Jeremiah 40:7-16 All captains in remote Judah come to Gedaliah and say that Ishmael wants to kill him.
3177. Jeremiah 41:1-18 Ishmael of Judah's seed royal kills Gedaliah and all opposition and goes to live near Egypt.
3178. Jeremiah 42:1-22 A remnant of Judah comes to Jeremiah and to God; they are told to not go into Egypt and that if they do, they will die there; and if they stay, God will protect them if they live right.
3179. Jeremiah 43:1-7 Proud men of Judah's remnant of Jews say that Jeremiah speaks falsely about their danger in going down into Egypt to escape the Chaldeans; they go anyway.
3180. Jeremiah 43:8-13 God tells Jeremiah that King Nebuchadrezzar of Babylon will take Egypt.

3181. Jeremiah 44:1-30 Jeremiah's exchange with the Judah remnant in Egypt; they have worshipped the "Queen of Heaven" and God has condemned them to death in Egypt.
3182. Jeremiah 45:1-5 Jeremiah has Baruch write Judah's condemnation; Baruch's life is spared.
3183. Jeremiah 46:1-28 God's word of doom against the Gentiles and Egypt; death is coming from the north.
3184. Jeremiah 47:1-7 God's word against the Philistines at Gaza, Tyrus, Zidon, and Ashkelon.
3185. Jeremiah 48:1-47 God's condemnation of Moab and the Plains area, their fleeing to caves, howling, and death.
3186. Jeremiah 49:1-6 God's condemnation on Ammon; it shall be a desolate heap and its daughters burned.
3187. Jeremiah 49:7-17 God's condemnation of Edom (Esau), despised heathens; God will save the widows and children.
3188. Jeremiah 49:18-22 GOD'S WORD ON ERASING SODOM AND GOMORRAH WITH THE JORDAN RIVER.
3189. Jeremiah 49:23-32 God's condemnation of Damascus, Syria, and Kedar; tells them to flee from King Nebuchadrezzar.
3190. Jeremiah 49:33 God says Hazor shall be a dwelling for dragons, desolation forever, no dwellers.
3191. Jeremiah 49:34-39 God's condemnation of Elam and rescue in latter days.
3192. Jeremiah 50:1-46 God's destruction of Chaldea and Babylon and His rescue of Israel and Judah and their return back to Zion.
3193. Jeremiah 50:40 SODOM AND GOMORRAH ARE DESTROYED FOREVER; NO PERSON CAN EVER DWELL THERE.

3194. Jeremiah 51:1-18 God's destroying wind against Babylon; Israel, and Judah saved even though they grossly sinned against the Holy One of Israel.
3195. Jeremiah 51:19-64 God's further condemnation of Chaldea and Babylon; words to Jeremiah about throwing book into the Euphrates River; Babylon shall be a dwelling place for dragons.
3196. Jeremiah 52:1-6 Story of Zedekiah's reign at Jerusalem, siege by King Nebuchadrezzar, and the famine.
3197. Jeremiah 52:7-11 Repeat of Zedekiah's capture, death of his sons, and his eyes put out.
3198. Jeremiah 52:12-16 Jerusalem destroyed by Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard of King Nebuchadrezzar of Babylon.
3199. Jeremiah 52:17-30 Four thousand six hundred Jews are taken captive to Babylon; the eunuchs and others are executed.
3200. Jeremiah 52:31-34 King Jehoiachin of Judah is given freedom by the new King of Babylon, Evil-merodach; he is a free prisoner in Babylon all the rest of his life.
