

LEVITICUS

671. Leviticus 1:1-3 Burnt offerings must be “male without blemish.”
672. Leviticus 1:5 The sprinkling of burnt offering blood upon the altar.
673. Leviticus 1:6-17 Preparing all offerings of meat; wringing off heads of fowl.
674. Leviticus 2:1-16 Other than meat offerings, priests’ portions, frying, no leaven nor honey; salt must be offered with each sacrifice.
675. Leviticus 3:1 Peace offerings may be male or female without blemish.
676. Leviticus 3:17 Perpetual statute: Israelis may eat neither fat nor blood (+7:23).
677. Leviticus 4:35 Offerings for breaking commandments through ignorance: placing the blood and burning.
678. Leviticus 5:1-11 Sins and offerings; flour may substitute for animal if sinner is poor.
679. Leviticus 6:4-5 Penalty for stealing; offender must add one fifth more for penalty.
680. Leviticus 6:11 Priests must change to regular clothes to carry offering ashes from the camp.
681. Leviticus 6:13 The fire on the altar must never go out.
682. Leviticus 6:29 Only male priests may eat certain meat offerings.
683. Leviticus 7:1-6 Trespass offerings – every male priest must eat from it (V14 – heave offering + V32).
684. Leviticus 7:19 Penalty for touching unclean things or eating sacred offering is banishment.

685. Leviticus 7:30 Wave offerings (+ 8:27-29).
686. Leviticus 8:1-9 Moses calls the congregation to the tabernacle to witness the dressing of Aaron as priest.
687. Leviticus 8:10-22 Moses anoints Aaron and dresses his sons in priest vesture.
688. Leviticus 8:23-24 Moses and the priests kill the sacrifice, place blood on their right ears, right thumbs, and right big toes.
689. Leviticus 8:30 Moses sprinkles oil and blood upon Aaron and his sons in consecration.
690. Leviticus 8:33-36 Moses confines Aaron and his sons to the tabernacle for 7 days for consecration.
691. Leviticus 9:1-22 Burnt offerings made by Aaron and sons on 8th day after their confinement.
692. Leviticus 9:23-24 God appears before Israel at the Tabernacle; He brings down fire, consumes the sacrifice, and the people fall on their faces.
693. Leviticus 10:1-2 Nadab and Abihu, Aaron's sons are consumed by God's fire for doing "strange fire" ritual.
694. Leviticus 10:3-7 Aaron's dead sons are carried out of the camp; Aaron and remaining sons are restricted to the Tabernacle.
695. Leviticus 10:9 Priests are forbidden to drink wine or strong drink.
696. Leviticus 10:12-20 Aaron's other two sons, Eleazer and Ithamar make bad decision on sin offerings.
697. Leviticus 11:1-8 God instructs Israel on unclean animals which they are forbidden to eat.
698. Leviticus 11:9-12 Unclean water creatures: those with scales are clean; those with no scales are unclean.
799. Leviticus 11:13-20 Flying creatures that are prohibited from eating.

700.	Leviticus 11:21-22	Flying insects Israel is permitted to eat: Locust, Grasshopper, and beetle.
701.	Leviticus 11:24-28	One touching dead things is unclean until the end of the day.
702.	Leviticus 11:29-30	Unclean creeping things: Weasel, Mouse, Tortoise, Ferret, Chameleon, Lizard, Snail, and Mole.
703.	Leviticus 11:31-41	One touching a dead creature which has fallen into a utensil must break the utensil, etc.
704.	Leviticus 11:42	All creatures that “go” on their bellies are unclean.
705.	Leviticus 12:2	A woman is unclean for 7 days after giving birth.
706.	Leviticus 12:3	Males must be circumcised on the 8 th day.
707.	Leviticus 12:4	A woman’s purifying after giving birth to a male child lasts for 40 days in which time she may touch no hallowed thing.
708.	Leviticus 12:5	For birthing a female child, a woman’s purifying must be for 80 days from the birthing.
709.	Leviticus 12:6-8	A woman must make a cleansing sacrifice after her purifying period from birthing.
710.	Leviticus 13:1-8	A priest for diagnosis must check boils on the skin.
711.	Leviticus 13:9-44	Diagnosis for leprosy – kinds of sores, color of hairs on the sores (boils).
712.	Leviticus 13:45	A leper must tear his clothes, wear no head covering, cover the upper lip, and cry, “Unclean! Unclean!”
713.	Leviticus 13:46	A leper is defiled, unclean, and must dwell alone outside the camp.

714.	Leviticus 13:51-52	The burning of clothes containing leprosy.
715.	Leviticus 14:1-32	Priest's cleansing and sacrifice ritual over a leper: blood on ear, thumb, and toe + oil.
716.	Leviticus 14:33-57	Laws of leprosy in cleansing a house in Canaan or destroying it.
717.	Leviticus 15:1-15	Uncleanness of issue from penis; anything touched is unclean.
718.	Leviticus 15:16-17	Uncleanness of copulation and cleansing.
719.	Leviticus 15:18	Woman involved in copulation – cleansing.
720.	Leviticus 15:19-23	Woman with menstrual issue – isolation for 7 days and cleansing.
721.	Leviticus 15:24	Sex during menstrual period – unclean for 7 days.
722.	Leviticus 15:25-30	Extended menstrual period – isolation, cleansing, and offering.
723.	Leviticus 16:1-7	God is angered with Aaron over his burned sons; instructs him on sacrificing.
724.	Leviticus 16:8-10	Scapegoat – ceremony and release (+V21, 22, and 26).
725.	Leviticus 16:11-28	Making sacrifice for Israel's atonement.
726.	Leviticus 16:29-34	Seventh month, seventh day statute – Sabbath of Rest and Atonement.
727.	Leviticus 17:1-16	Slaughtering sacrifices, law against consuming blood, and eating nothing previously dead.
728.	Leviticus 18:1-18	God gives His law against incest and sex with another near of kin.
729.	Leviticus 18:19	Law against touching menstruating woman or an unclean woman.
730.	Leviticus 18:20	Law against sex with a neighbor's wife.

731.	Leviticus 18:21	Law against masturbation to Molech and using profanity and God's ' name in profanity.
732.	Leviticus 18:22	Law against Homosexuality.
733.	Leviticus 18:23	Law against bestiality from man or woman.
734.	Leviticus 18:24-30	All Canaanites (multi-tribes) have committed all of these abominations.
735.	Leviticus 19:1-8	God gives laws on being Holy, respect for parents, sacrifices, and eating meat that is 3 days old.
736.	Leviticus 19:9-10	God's law on leaving a part of the harvest for the poor.
737.	Leviticus 19:11	Law against stealing, dealing falsely, and lying.
738.	Leviticus 19:12	Law against swearing falsely, profanity against God
739.	Leviticus 19:13	Law against defrauding a neighbor; must not withhold wages until the next morning.
740.	Leviticus 19:14	Law against cursing or treating the handicapped badly.
741.	Leviticus 19:15	Law against treating the rich better than the poor.
742.	Leviticus 19:16	Law against gossip, being a talebearer.
743.	Leviticus 19:17-18	Law against hating one's brother – must love thy neighbor as thyself.
744.	Leviticus 19:19	Cattle must remain purebred, seed in field must be pure, and woven cloth must be pure, woven of only one material per garment.
745.	Leviticus 19:20-22	Sex with a married bondmaid; she must be scourged and man must make a trespass offering.

746.	Leviticus 19:23-24	Tree fruit must not be eaten for first 4 years because it is uncircumcised.
747.	Leviticus 19:26	Law against eating blood with meat, enchantments, and “observing times.”
748.	Leviticus 19:27	Law against rounding corners of head and beard hair.
749.	Leviticus 19:28	Law against cutting markings on one’s flesh and taboo on tattoos.
750.	Leviticus 19:29	Law against prostituting daughters.
751.	Leviticus 19:31	God’s law against wizards and those with “familiar spirits.”
752.	Leviticus 19:32-34	Law on honoring the aged and hospitality to strangers.
753.	Leviticus 19:35-37	God orders honesty in commerce, weights and measurements.
754.	Leviticus 20:1-8	God’s law and death penalty against masturbation and sex with heathens and devils.
755.	Leviticus 20:9	Death penalty for cursing father or mother.
756.	Leviticus 20:10	Death for adultery with neighbor’s wife or husband.
757.	Leviticus 20:11	Death penalty for sex with father’s wife (does not have to be one’s mother).
758.	Leviticus 20:12	Death penalty for sex with daughter-in-law.
759.	Leviticus 20:13	Death penalty for practicing homosexual.
760.	Leviticus 20:14	Death penalty for sex both with one’s wife and mother-in-law.
761.	Leviticus 20:15	Death penalty for sex with an animal (bestiality).

762.	Leviticus 20:16	Death penalty for woman having sex with an animal.
763.	Leviticus 20:17	Expulsion from Israel for having sex with a sister or brother.
764.	Leviticus 20:18	Expulsion for having sex during menstrual period.
765.	Leviticus 20:19-20	No sex allowed with one's extended family, i.e. uncle or brother's wife. If committed all will die childless.
766.	Leviticus 20:21-26	God demands Godly conduct of Israel in Canaan.
767.	Leviticus 20:27	Death by stoning of Wizards and those with "familiar spirits"(19:31).
768.	Leviticus 21:1-4	Bring defiled (touching the dead) is permitted only for family members.
769.	Leviticus 21:5	Prohibition against self-baldness, shaving the corners of the beard, and cutting of flesh of humans.
770.	Leviticus 21:6-8	Profaning God's Name and marrying a whore are prohibited.
771.	Leviticus 21:9	Death penalty for the daughter of a priest who becomes a whore; death must be by burning with fire.
772.	Leviticus 21:10-15	A High Priest must have pure conduct and marry a virgin.
773.	Leviticus 21:17-24	The handicapped or blemished cannot make a sacrifice or come before the temple altar.
774.	Leviticus 22:1-16	Law on touching Holy Things and those excluded from eating holy sacrifice meat.
775.	Leviticus 22:17-27	No blemished animal may be a sacrifice and unblemished animal must be put up for 7 days before being offered.

776. Leviticus 22:28 Prohibition against killing an animal and its young on the same day.
777. Leviticus 22:29-33 Eating of a sacrifice must be done on the same day and one must hallow God.
778. Leviticus 23:1-8 Holy Feasts and Convocations are: (1) Passover, (2) Unleavened Bread, and (3) Feast Of Tabernacles.
779. Leviticus 23:10-21 Reaping harvests of Canaan, various offerings, and timetables.
780. Leviticus 23:22 Leaving corners of fields and parts of reapings for the poor.
781. Leviticus 23:42-43 Booths dwelling, 7 days during Feast Of Tabernacles at harvest time.
782. Leviticus 24:1-4 God demands perpetual olive oil in temple lamps and they must burn always.
783. Leviticus 24:5-9 Baking cakes; there must be two rows on the table of 6 each and they must be sprinkled with frankincense for an offering.
784. Leviticus 24:10 A part Egyptian son of an Israeli woman fights and curses God; he is stoned to death outside the camp (+V23).
785. Leviticus 24:17 Death penalty for murder (+V21).
786. Leviticus 24:18-23 One who blemishes another must himself be blemished, animal for animal, eye for eye, one set of laws for all.
787. Leviticus 25:4-5 On the 7th year of farming in Canaan, there must be neither sowing nor reaping.
788. Leviticus 25:8-13 50th year in Canaan is proclaimed “Jubilee”; all must return home for a reunion.
789. Leviticus 25:14-17 Buying and selling during Jubilee – there must be no oppression of debtors.

790. Leviticus 25:20-22 On the 6th year, crops must yield for 3 years, an amount to last through the 8th year.
791. Leviticus 25:23 Canaan land cannot be sold; it belongs to God perpetually for Israel's use.
792. Leviticus 25:28 All Canaan land possessions return to the original Israeli owners at Jubilee.
793. Leviticus 25:29 If a house in a walled city is sold, it may be redeemed within one year.
794. Leviticus 25:34 A field within the city suburbs may not be sold.
795. Leviticus 25:35-43 A poor brother may live with his Israeli family and if bought, may be a laborer but not a servant.
796. Leviticus 25:44-46 Buying of heathens is permitted and may be passed down from generation to generation.
797. Leviticus 25:47-55 A stranger may buy a poor Israeli but he may be redeemed with the price depending upon the length of time he was owned.
798. Leviticus 26:1-28 God promises to bless Israel for good conduct and punishment for bad conduct.
799. Leviticus 26:29 God promises terror for sins in Israel to the extent that Israelis will eat their own children.
800. Leviticus 26:44 God will save a remnant of Israel even if they are in captivity.
801. Leviticus 27:1-31 "Estimation" of value of Israeli people and property for tax accessing.
802. Leviticus 27:32 The Tithe shall be 10 percent.
