3630. Nahum 1:1 The burden of Nineveh revisited; vision of Nahum, the Elkoshite prophet.
3631. Nahum 1:2 God is jealous, revengeful, furious, and holds wrath for His enemies.
3632. Nahum 1:3-5 Prophet Nahum tells of God's great power: seas quake, hills melt, and the earth burns.
3633. Nahum 1:6-8 None can stand but those who trust God; darkness to His enemies.
3634. Nahum 1:9-11 Though once forgiven, God's vengeance will return to Nineveh while the enemy is drunk; "You have again raised up a wicked counselor in Nineveh!"
3635. Nahum 1:12-14 God's punishment for the sins of Nineveh is shown to Israel.
3636. Nahum 1:15 God's message of rescue to Judah: "The enemy is cut off!"
3637. Nahum 2:1-2 Nahum: "The enemy is before you; keep the munition, watch, and fortify; Jacob and Israel are mighty no more; their emptiers have ruined them!"
3638. Nahum 2:3-4 The enemy's shields and men are scarlet red; their chariots are like flames, raging in the streets, and running like lightning.
3639. Nahum 2:5-8 Despite its fierceness, Nineveh shall be captured fleeing from the enemy.
3640. Nahum 2:9-13 Nineveh's spoils are taken; they were like lions, but destruction has come upon them.
3641. Nahum 3:1-3 Woe to the bloody city of Nineveh; multitudes are slain; there are so many corpses that the horses stumble over them.

3642. Nahum 3:4-7 Whoredoms and witchcraft destroy Nineveh; onlookers look and flee.
3643. Nahum 3:8-11 Nineveh and Assyria are accused, once had strength from Ethiopia and Egypt; now death and captivity come from God.
3644. Nahum 3:12-15 The strongholds of Assyria will fall; you are weak women; fire is coming.
3645. Nahum 3:16-17 Nineveh's merchants are multiplied but cankerworms and locusts destroy them.
3646. Nahum 3:18-19 Assyria's shepherds sleep; her kings and nobles are dead; her people are scattered; no healing is possible, her wounds are grievous; her people clap over the destruction.
