3558. Obadiah 1:1-2 God, through Obadiah, pronounces doom on Edom, which is small and despised.
3559. Obadiah 1:3-4 Edom is accused of highmindedness; God says He will bring them down.
3560. Obadiah 1:5-7 Edom has been deceived; friends steal from Edom.
3561. Obadiah 1:8-10 God is to destroy the wise men of Edom and their army for violence against Jacob (Israel).
3562. Obadiah 1:11-12 Edom is condemned for standing by as Judah is taken captive and their rejoicing over it.
3563. Obadiah 1:13-14 Edom steals from Judah during the calamity and captures the escapees in distress.
3564. Obadiah 1:15-16 The Day of The Lord has come upon Edom bringing revenge and annihilation from God.
3565. Obadiah 1:17 Mt. Zion will be delivered and have holiness; the House of Jacob will be rebuilt.
3566. Obadiah 1:18 The House of Jacob shall be on fire; the House of Joseph will be a flame; Edom will be stubble.
3567. Obadiah 1:19 Judah shall possess the Mt. of Esau (Edom), the Philistines, the fields of Ephraim, and Samaria; Benjamin will possess Gilead.
3568. Obadiah 1:20 Judah shall possess Israel and the Canaanites; Jerusalem will possess the cities of the South.
3569. Obadiah 1:21 Saviors will come upon Zion to judge Edom and the whole kingdom will be God's.
