

PHILIPPIANS

2158. Philippians 1:1-5 Paul's salutation to Philippi for him and Timothy, for fellowship in the Gospel.
2159. Philippians 1:6 Paul, "I am confident that He that began a good work in you will perform until the Day Of Jesus."
2160. Philippians 1:7-10 Paul, "You are in my heart, partakers of my grace, and I long for you; stay without offense until Jesus comes."
2161. Philippians 1:11-14 Be filled with righteousness; my imprisonment has made the church grow and given boldness to many.
2162. Philippians 1:15-20 Some preach Jesus for strife, some for contention, but most for love; Christ be magnified.
2163. Philippians 1:21 PAUL, "FOR TO ME TO LIVE IS CHRIST AND TO DIE IS GAIN."
2164. Philippians 1:22-23 Paul, "Living is difficult; I want life, but desire to depart to be with Jesus which is better."
2165. Philippians 1:24-27 If I live it is more beneficial to you; you rejoice in my coming; stand fast in the Spirit.
2166. Philippians 1:28-30 Don't fear your enemies; suffer for Jesus; don't avoid conflicts.
2167. Philippians 2:1-2 Fulfill my joy; be in one accord; there is in Jesus, consolation, comfort, love, spirit, and mercies.
2168. Philippians 2:3 Have no strife or vain glory; be in lowliness of mind; esteem others better than yourselves.
2169. Philippians 2:4-7 Look out for others; have the mind of Jesus; Jesus, equal with God, became a "Servant Man."

2170. Philippians 2:8-9 As a man, Jesus was obedient even to the Cross; God exalted Him and gave Him a "Name Above All."
2171. Philippians 2:10-11 AT THE NAME OF JESUS ALL KNEES SHOULD BOW AND EVERY TONGUE CONFESS JESUS AS LORD.
2172. Philippians 2:12 Beloved, obey Jesus; work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
2173. Philippians 2:13-15 God works in you to do His pleasure; work without murmurings and disputes; be light to a crooked world.
2174. Philippians 2:16-18 Hold forth the Word Of Life so that I can rejoice in my labors; If I am sacrificed in service, rejoice.
2175. Philippians 2:19-24 I am sending Timothy to you to help you and report back to me; he is good; I hope to come someday too.
2176. Philippians 2:25-30 I hope to also send Epaphroditus; he is sick; he almost died serving Jesus and me; receive him.
2177. Philippians 3:1-2 Rejoice in Jesus; my writings are grievous but safe; beware of dogs, evil workers, and concision.
2178. Philippians 3:3-4 We the circumcision worship God in Spirit with no confidence in flesh; I have more trust than you.
2179. Philippians 3:5 PAUL, "I WAS CIRCUMCISED THE EIGHTH DAY, OF THE STOCK OF ISRAEL, TRIBE OF BENJAMIN, A HEBREW, A PHARISEE."
2180. Philippians 3:6-7 In zeal, I persecuted the church; self righteous, blameless; gain I counted as loss for Jesus.
2181. Philippians 3:8-9 I've lost everything for Jesus; count it all as dung to win Jesus; righteousness is only from God.

2182. Philippians 3:10-11 I want to know the power of His resurrection, suffering to attain the resurrection for me.
2183. Philippians 3:12-14 PAUL, "I'VE NOT YET ATTAINED BUT I DON'T LOOK BACK; REACHING FORWARD, I PRESS TOWARD THE MARK FOR THE PRIZE OF THE HIGH CALLING OF GOD IN CHRIST JESUS."
2184. Philippians 3:15-17 Be perfect; walk all by the same rule; be followers together of me; use us for an example.
2185. Philippians 3:18-21 There are enemies of Jesus' Cross; their end is destruction; we shall change to glorious bodies.
2186. Philippians 4:1-2 Paul, "I long for you Philippians; I beseech Euodias, Syntyche, and all with the same mind in the Lord."
2187. Philippians 4:3 I ENTREAT YOU, TRUE YOKEFELLOWS, HELP THE WOMEN WHO LABOR WITH ME IN THE GOSPEL AND WITH CLEMENT AND OTHERS OF MY FELLOW LABORERS WHOSE NAMES ARE IN THE BOOK OF LIFE.
2188. Philippians 4:4 PAUL, "REJOICE IN THE LORD ALWAYS; AND AGAIN I SAY REJOICE."
2189. Philippians 4:5-7 Be moderate, be careful for nothing; in prayer and thanks request of God; the Peace Of God through Jesus will keep you.
2190. Philippians 4:8 Whatsoever things are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and good, with virtue and praise think of these.
2191. Philippians 4:9-10 Do the things I have done and God will be with you; you have cared for me but lacked opportunity.
2192. Philippians 4:11 PAUL, " I DON'T SPEAK IN WANT, FOR I HAVE LEARNED IN WHATSOEVER

STATE I AM, THEREWITH TO BE
CONTENT."

2193. Philippians 4:12 I know how to be abased, hungry, and in need, but how also to abound and be full.
2194. Philippians 4:13 PAUL, "I CAN DO ALL THINGS THROUGH CHRIST WHICH STRENGTHENETH ME."
2195. Philippians 4:14-15 You have served me well; at the beginning you were the only church who supported me.
2196. Philippians 4:16-18 In Thessalonica you sent gifts to Me; I pray fruit for your account; I've received of Epaphroditus from you.
2197. Philippians 4:19 PAUL, "BUT MY GOD SHALL SUPPLY ALL YOUR NEED ACCORDING TO HIS RICHES IN GLORY BY CHRIST JESUS.
2198. Philippians 4:20-23 Glory to God; salute every saint in Jesus; we all greet you; saints of Caesar's household salute you; the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
