2761. Proverbs 1:1-4 Proverbs of King Solomon, son of King David, to give wisdom, equity, etc.
2762. Proverbs 1:5-6 The wise will hear, learn, attain to wise counsel, and understand proverbs.
2763. Proverbs 1:7 “THE FEAR OF THE LORD IS THE BEGINNING OF KNOWLEDGE;” Fools despise....
2764. Proverbs 1:8-9 Hear the instruction of your father and obey the law of your mother.
2765. Proverbs 1:10-19 Do not align with sinners; they are evil, greedy, and shedders of blood.
2766. Proverbs 1:20-23 Wisdom cries out to simplicity; fools hate knowledge and turn around.
2767. Proverbs 1:24-33 Refuse God’s counsel and He will mock your calamity; the prosperity of fools.
2768. Proverbs 2:1-9 Search for knowledge and understanding like hidden treasure.
2769. Proverbs 2:10-22 Discretion shall preserve you from strange women, which would lead you to death.
2770. Proverbs 3:1-6 God’s law lengthens life; “Trust...lean not unto your self;” God will direct your paths.
2771. Proverbs 3:7-10 Don’t be wise in your own eyes; having God gives health to your navel, marrow to your bones, and fills your barns.
2772. Proverbs 3:11-12 Despise not God’s chastening; God corrects those He loves like a father.
2773. Proverbs 3:13-35 Value of wisdom; don’t fear, help the poor, don’t fight without a cause, and do not envy others.

2774. Proverbs 4:1-13 Exhalt wisdom for honor, grace, long life, and instructions in your life.
2775. Proverbs 4:14-27 The path of the just is a shining light; keep your heart right and look straight ahead.
2776. Proverbs 5:1-14 Avoid strange women; their mouths are like honey but their steps take hold on hell.
2777. Proverbs 5:15-23 Bless your fountain; rejoice with the satisfaction of your wife's breasts; be ravished always with her love.
2778. Proverbs 6:1-5 Don't be surety (co-sign a loan) for a friend with a stranger; it will snare you.
2779. Proverbs 6:6-11 Sluggard, go and observe the ant; he is self-directed, preparing, neither sleeping nor lazy.
2780. Proverbs 6:12-15 The wicked has a froward mouth, winks, devises mischief, and calamity comes quickly.
2781. Proverbs 6:16-19 Seven things God hates: A proud look, lying, murder, a wicked heart, mischief, false witness (lying again), and sowing discord (as in church).
2782. Proverbs 6:20-35 The wise avoid evil women (or men) and the neighbor's wife (or husband); no amount of atonement will satisfy a husband (or wife).
2783. Proverbs 6:30 Do not despise a thief if he steals to satisfy his soul when he is hungry.
2784. Proverbs 7:1-27 Story of death with a prostitute or an unfaithful wife (or husband); how they take you to hell.
2785. Proverbs 8:1-36 The history of wisdom, its place now and before and during creation, and its value.
2786. Proverbs 9:1-12 The use of wisdom; reprove not a scorner for he will hate you; the wise, when reprov'd, will love you.

2787. Proverbs 9:13-18 A foolish woman is clamorous and ignorant and her guests are in the depths of hell.
2788. Proverbs 10:1-32 The story of the use and ignorance of wisdom; the length of life is connected.
2789. Proverbs 11:1-13 Rewards of the righteous and unrighteous, wicked, hypocrites, and talebearers.
2790. Proverbs 11:14 IN THE MULTITUDE OF COUNSELORS THERE IS SAFETY.
2791. Proverbs 11:15 Surety (co-signing for another's debt) for a stranger or anyone is unwise.
2792. Proverbs 11:16-21 Gracious women and strong, merciful men are rewarded; the wicked are punished.
2793. Proverbs 11:22 As jewels of gold in a swine's mouth is a fair woman without discretion.
2794. Proverbs 11:23-31 The righteous are a tree of life; the stingy trust in riches and will fall.
2795. Proverbs 12:1-28 Love instruction, a virtuous woman, and truth; deceit and slothfulness give death.
2796. Proverbs 13:1-25 A wise son follows a father's instruction; spare the rod and you hate the son; use it with love and it chastises.
2797. Proverbs 14:1-35 The wise have rewards, the foolish have destruction; sin looks good but causes death.
2798. Proverbs 15:1 "A SOFT ANSWER TURNS AWAY WRATH; GREIVIOUS WORDS STIR UP ANGER."
2799. Proverbs 15:2-33 God sees all; a merry heart is good; the wicked perish; before honor is humility.
2800. Proverbs 16:1-33 The way of the good prospers, the wicked fail, and pride goes before destruction.
2801. Proverbs 16:31 The hoary (gray) head is a crown of glory if it is in the way of righteousness.

2802. Proverbs 17:1-5 Peace in the home, control of children, kindness to the poor, and false lips.
2803. Proverbs 17:6 GRANDCHILDREN ARE A CROWN OF OLD MEN; THE GLORY OF CHILDREN ARE THEIR FATHERS.
2804. Proverbs 17:7-16 A fool in his folly rewards evil for good; fools cannot get wisdom.
2805. Proverbs 17:17 A friend loves at all times; a brother is born for adversity.
2806. Proverbs 17:18 The foolish become surety (co-sign a loan) with a witness.
2807. Proverbs 17:19-27 Foolish sons grieve their fathers; he with knowledge spares his words.
2808. Proverbs 17:28 Even a fool, when he holds his peace, is counted wise.
2809. Proverbs 18:1-18 Flirting with wisdom, a fool's lips, laziness, and haughtiness bring destruction.
2810. Proverbs 18:19-24 Winning an offended brother; power of the tongue; a friend sticks closer than a brother.
2811. Proverbs 19:1-12 The poor with integrity; rich versus poor treatment; false witnesses; deferring anger.
2812. Proverbs 19:13-14 A foolish wife; a contentious wife is a continual dropping; a prudent wife is from the Lord.
2813. Proverbs 19:15-17 Slothfulness; the idol soul suffers hunger; we are to pity and help the poor.
2814. Proverbs 19:18 CHASTISE YOUR SON (CHILDREN) WHILE THERE IS HOPE; DO NOT WEAKEN.
2815. Proverbs 19:19-29 Wrath brings punishment; smite a scorner; ungodly witnesses; stripes for fools.

2816. Proverbs 20:1 WINE IS A MOCKER; STRONG DRINK IS RAGING; BEING DECEIVED BY IT IS NOT WISE.
2817. Proverbs 20:2-28 Fear kings; sluggards; integrity; the spirit of man is God's candle.
2818. Proverbs 20:29-30 THE GLORY OF THE YOUNG IS THEIR STRENGTH; THE BEAUTY OF OLD MEN (OR WOMEN) IS THEIR GRAY HAIR.
2819. Proverbs 21:1-9 Justice and judgment; it is better to dwell in the corner of your roof than in a wide house with a brawling woman.
2820. Proverbs 21:1-18 Soul of the wicked; punishment; hearing the poor; loving pleasure and wine.
2821. Proverbs 21:19 It is better to dwell in the wilderness than with a contentious and angry woman.
2822. Proverbs 21:20-31 Wisdom; watch your tongue; laziness, false witness; safety is of the Lord.
2823. Proverbs 22:1 A GOOD NAME IS RATHER TO BE CHOSEN THAN GREAT RICHES AND LOVING FAVOR RATHER THAN SILVER AND GOLD.
2824. Proverbs 22:2-5 Humility and fear of God give riches, honor, and life; thorns are for the froward.
2825. Proverbs 22:6 TRAIN UP A CHILD IN THE WAY HE (SHE) SHOULD GO AND WHEN HE (SHE) IS OLD, HE (SHE) WILL NOT DEPART FROM IT.
2826. Proverbs 22:7-14 Rich rule the poor; cast out a scorner; the mouth of a strange woman is a pit.
2827. Proverbs 22:15 FOOLISHNESS IS BOUND IN THE HEART OF A CHILD; THE ROD OF CORRECTION DRIVES IT FAR FROM HIM (HER).

2828. Proverbs 22:16-29 Rob not the poor; make no friendship with an angry man; do no surety; remove no ancient landmarks.
2829. Proverbs 23:1-12 Before a ruler, don't eat much; don't labor to be rich; don't change landmarks.
2830. Proverbs 23:13-14 WITHHOLD NOT CORRECTION FROM THE CHILD; BEAT HIM (HER) WITH THE ROD; HE (SHE) WILL NOT DIE AND IT SHALL DELIVER HIS (HER) SOUL FROM HELL.
2831. Proverbs 23:15-20 Instructions to young people on wisdom and lifestyle.
2832. Proverbs 23:21 The drunkard, glutton, and lazy shall come to poverty.
2833. Proverbs 23:22-35 More instruction to the young; joy of a wise child; whores; wine that bites and numbs.
2834. Proverbs 24:1-23 Wise counsel; don't envy the rich; don't rejoice when an enemy falls.
2835. Proverbs 24:24 He who calls the wicked righteous; curse of people and nations.
2836. Proverbs 24:25-34 Rebuke the wicked; don't witness without cause; laziness equals poverty.
2837. Proverbs 25:1-10 King Solomon's proverbs that King Hezekiah copied; honor of kings; don't assume importance.
2838. Proverbs 25:11 A WORD FITLY SPOKEN IS LIKE APPLES OF GOLD IN PICTURES OF SILVER.
2839. Proverbs 25:12-18 Faithful messengers; don't visit a neighbor too much lest he grow weary of you and begin to hate you.
2840. Proverbs 25:19 Confidence in an unfaithful man is like a broken tooth and a foot out of joint.

2841. Proverbs 25:20-23 Don't sing songs to a heavy heart; feed your enemies and God will reward you.
2842. Proverbs 25:24 It is better to dwell in the corner of a housetop than in a wide house with a brawling woman.
2843. Proverbs 25:25-28 The righteous don't bow before the wicked; searching out your own glory is not glory.
2844. Proverbs 26:1-28 Fools have no honor; they need the rod; they are full of self-conceit, slothful, talebearers, and liars.
2845. Proverbs 27:1-27 Boast not for tomorrow; don't praise yourself; secret love is bad.
2846. Proverbs 27:15 A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike.
2847. Proverbs 28:1-27 Actions of rich and poor; righteous; evil; robber of parents; giving to the poor.
2848. Proverbs 28:28 When the wicked rise, men hide themselves; when the wicked perish, the righteous increase.
2849. Proverbs 29:1 One who does not accept reproof will suddenly be destroyed.
2850. Proverbs 29:2 When the righteous rule, people rejoice; when the wicked rule, people mourn.
2851. Proverbs 29:3-12 Wise and foolish acts; if a ruler harkens to lies, all of his servants are wicked.
2852. Proverbs 29:13-17 The rod and reproof bring wisdom; a child left to himself brings his mother to shame; correct a child and he will give you rest and be a delight to your soul.
2853. Proverbs 29:18 WHERE THERE IS NO VISION, THE PEOPLE PERISH.
2854. Proverbs 29:19-27 Correcting servants; anger; pride; judgment comes from the Lord.

2855. Proverbs 30:1-10      Prophecy of Agur speaking of God's might, "Every Word of God is pure."
2856. Proverbs 30:11-14      A bad generation curses their fathers and mothers and are pure in their own eyes; they are destroying the poor.
2857. Proverbs 30:15-17      Four things never satisfied: The grave, a barren womb, dry earth, and fire.
2858. Proverbs 30:18-19      Four wonderful things: The way of an eagle, a serpent, a ship on the sea, and the way of a man with a maiden.
2859. Proverbs 30:20      The way of an adulterous woman, she eats, wipes her mouth, and denies her wickedness.
2860. Proverbs 30:21-23      Four things the earth cannot bear: Servant reign, a fool filled with meat, an odious married woman, and a handmaid heir to her mistress.
2861. Proverbs 30:24-28      Four little wise things: Ants, conies, locusts, and spiders.
2862. Proverbs 30:29-31      Four comely things: The lion, the greyhound, a he goat, and a strong king.
2863. Proverbs 30:32-33      Rectify evil; churning makes butter; nose wringing brings blood; forcing wrath brings strife.
2864. Proverbs 31:1-5      King Lemuel's mother's prophecy: the conduct of kings giving their strength to women and strong drink.
2865. Proverbs 31:6-7      GIVE STRONG DRINK TO THE PERISHING AND WINE TO THOSE OF HEAVY HEART SO THAT THEY MIGHT DRINK AND FORGET THEIR POVERTY AND MISERY.
2866. Proverbs 31:8-9      Stand up for the dumb and executed (condemned), judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy.
