

PSALMS

2590. Psalms 1:1-6 Differences in the Godly and the ungodly.
2591. Psalms 2:1-12 Earthly rebellion against God, the penalty, and reward to the good.
2592. Psalms 3:1-8 King David's accusations of his enemies and his calling upon God, assured of God's help.
2593. Psalms 4:1-8 David's conversation with God for rescue and assurance of God's protection.
2594. Psalms 5:1-12 David asks God to hear his prayers, to punish the evil and bless the righteous.
2595. Psalms 6:1-10 King David is in tears, begging for God's mercy and assuring himself that God will hear.
2596. Psalms 7:1-17 David admits his sins and need for chastisement; he says that God punishes the wicked.
2597. Psalms 8:1-9 David telling of God's might in creation and man's place in caring for it.
2598. Psalms 9:1-20 David is praising God and declaring His might and justice to the good and wicked.
2599. Psalms 10:1-18 A psalm asking God why He allows the wicked and petitioning for the humble.
2600. Psalms 11:1-7 King David voicing trust in God to destroy the wicked and upholding the upright.
2601. Psalms 12:1-8 David says the good are falling and that the wicked and vilest are exalted.
2602. Psalms 13:1-6 David lamenting over God ignoring him but he is trusting in God's mercy.
2603. Psalms 14:1-7 King David: "The fool says there is no God." God sees the people totally fallen.

2604. Psalms 15:1-5 David identifies the righteous.
2605. Psalms 16:1-11 David declaring his trust in God and saints on the earth; says, “The Holy One won’t see corruption.”
2606. Psalms 17:1-15 David declares his confidence in God and protection against his enemies.
2607. Psalms 18:1-50 David praising God for protection from his enemies, he says, “Blessed be the Rock, the Exalting God.”
2608. Psalms 19:1-14 David declaring God’s majesty; David’s prayer, “Let the words of my mouth...”
2609. Psalms 20:1-9 David asks God to help the righteous and anointed and to protect them from their enemies.
2610. Psalms 21:1-13 David speaks of God’s blessing the king, crowning him, and destroying his enemies.
2611. Psalms 22:1-31 King David is in misery; he rehearses the phrases Jesus used regarding persecution.
2612. Psalms 23:1-6 King David’s psalm of God’s protection, “The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want...”
2613. Psalms 24:1-10 David’s declaration, “The earth is the Lord’s;” he says the pure will be blessed and the King of Glory shall come in.
2614. Psalms 25:1-22 David praying for mercy from God; asking God to redeem him and Israel.
2615. Psalms 26:1-12 David declaring his purity and integrity before God and his love for God.
2616. Psalms 27:1-14 David, “The Lord is my Light...;” asking God not to forsake him, “I will wait upon the Lord.”
2617. Psalms 28:1-9 David praying for God’s help; he asks God to save his inheritance and lift them up.

2618. Psalms 29:1-11 David, “The power of God and the power of His voice.”
2619. Psalms 30:1-12 David rejoicing over God saving him from his enemies, he says, “Joy comes in the morning!”
2620. Psalms 31:1-24 David’s lamentation over his enemies and trust that God will protect him.
2621. Psalms 32:1-11 David speaks of God’s deliverance when He is called upon.
2622. Psalms 33:1-22 David on praising God with musical instruments and God’s might in creation.
2623. Psalms 34:1-22 David on God’s power in rescuing the righteous and curing their afflictions.
2624. Psalms 35:1-28 David calling upon God to avenge him against his many enemies.
2625. Psalms 36:1-12 David on the attitude of the wicked and God’s mercy and judgment against man.
2626. Psalms 37:1-40 David on God’s punishment against the wicked; says the meek shall inherit the earth and “I have been young, and now am old, yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, nor His seed begging for bread.”
2627. Psalms 38:1-22 David in distress, calling upon God, declaring his iniquity, and sorry for his sins.
2628. Psalms 39:1-13 David on being silent, praying for God to spare him, and give him strength.
2629. Psalms 40:1-17 David praising God for lifting him up, his preaching for God, and speaking of the evils that compass against him.
2630. Psalms 41:1-13 David on God’s help of the poor and forsaken by friends, God favors him.
2631. Psalms 42:1-11 David’s soul panting for God; asking why he is cast down.

2632. Psalms 43:1-5 David asking God to deliver him, rescue him from being cast down.
2633. Psalms 44:1-26 Israel is in confusion and begs God to deliver them from the “Place of Dragons.”
2634. Psalms 45:1-17 A song of the king’s might, God’s throne, and the king’s daughter of Tyre.
2635. Psalms 46:1-11 Israel: “God is our refuge and strength...” “Be still and know that I am God.”
2636. Psalms 47:1-9 Israel’s praise to God, shout with the voice of triumph; God is their shield.
2637. Psalms 48:1-14 Israel: “God is our refuge, Mt. Zion is joy, and God is our God forever.”
2638. Psalms 49:1-20 A psalm to the rich; they trust in their wealth but can take nothing with them.
2639. Psalms 50:1-23 A psalm declaring the might of God, His owning the cattle on a thousand hills, and protecting us.
2640. Psalms 51:1-19 King David lamenting his sins, begging God to cleanse him, and making promises to God.
2641. Psalms 52:1-9 David speaking against deceitful and evil betrayers.
2642. Psalms 53:1-6 Psalm: “A fool says there is no God;” man has become filthy; sin has the people in captivity.
2643. Psalms 54:1-7 King David when his enemy is pursuing him, declaring that God will protect him.
2644. Psalms 55:1-23 David seeking deliverance from his enemy, says, “Oh that I had wings like a dove...!”
2645. Psalms 56:1-13 David is fighting daily; he is afraid, trusting in God, and trying to be brave.
2646. Psalms 57:1-11 David is in torment, asking mercy, praising God, and seeking protection.

2647. Psalms 58:1-11 David on the “wicked from birth” and asking God to condemn them.
2648. Psalms 59:1-17 David asking God for deliverance from his enemies and of their cursing and pride.
2649. Psalms 60:1-12 David expressing God’s help in giving Israel victory over their lands.
2650. Psalms 61:1-8 David’s prayer to God, “Lead me to the rock that is higher than I, Thou hast....”
2651. Psalms 62:1-12 David on salvation, defense against enemies, and reward for man’s works.
2652. Psalms 63:1-11 David’s longing for God, lifting hands, praising, “In the shadow of Thy Wings.”
2653. Psalms 64:1-10 David on words of the wicked being like arrows; saying God would wound them.
2654. Psalms 65:1-13 David on God’s mighty power on earth, watering, crops, and animals.
2655. Psalms 66:1-20 Psalm of praise on God’s works, deliverance, and answer to prayers.
2656. Psalms 67:1-7 Psalm of praise asking for God’s mercy, singing for joy, and God’s blessings on the earth.
2657. Psalms 68:1-35 David on the wicked perishing, God’s name “JAH;” God’s blessing the poor, and the Holy Hill of God.
2658. Psalms 69:1-36 David is weary of crying, he is punished by the enemy for his sins, and is asking God for deliverance.
2659. Psalms 70:1-5 David asking for emergency deliverance, asking God to confuse his enemies, saying he is poor and needy.
2660. Psalms 71:1-24 Psalm on persecution, old age weakness, and faith in God’s salvation.

2661. Psalms 72:1-20 Solomon's psalm on judgment, and redeeming the needy; the prayers of King David are ended.
2662. Psalms 73:1-28 Asaph on foolish, wicked rich; the ungodly prosper but are consumed with terrors.
2663. Psalms 74:1-23 Asaph asking God for safety from the enemy and might in destroying the dragon, Leviathan.
2664. Psalms 75:1-10 Asaph says the horns of the wicked shall be cut off. God's judgment to the wicked.
2665. Psalms 76:1-12 God judging the earth's leaders and kings; all should fear God.
2666. Psalms 77:1-20 The psalmist can't get God's attention for his grievances; he reminds God of His past miracles.
2667. Psalms 78:1-72 God's guidance and protection over Israel in Egypt, during the Exodus, and in Canaan.
2668. Psalms 79:1-13 Asaph begging God to again bless Israel and to send a revival spirit.
2669. Psalms 80:1-19 Asaph asking God to hear Israel's lamentations, "visit the vine" again.
2670. Psalms 81:1-16 Psalm says, "Make music to God;" Asaph of their haters of God laments Israel's sins.
2671. Psalms 82:1-8 Asaph asking God to bless the poor and fatherless who are walking in darkness.
2672. Psalms 83:1-18 Asaph asks God to prove His might to heathens by confusing and blinding them.
2673. Psalms 84:1-12 Psalm blessing God, "I'd rather be a doorkeeper in the House of my God...."
2674. Psalms 85:1-13 A psalm declaring God's mercy to Israel and reward for their repentance.

2675. Psalms 86:1-17 King David's prayer for God to hear him, praising God, and asking for a sign.
2676. Psalms 87:1-7 Psalm declaring the Holy Mountain of God, Zion, the City of God, and praise and glorious things to God.
2677. Psalms 88:1-18 Lamentation to God, crying, prayer, affliction, suffering, and needing God.
2678. Psalms 89:1-52 Singing of God's mercy, uplifting King David, and seeking God's protection for him.
2679. Psalms 90:1-17 A prayer of Moses, declaring God, the length of man's life (seventy to eighty years), and satisfying our needs.
2680. Psalms 91:1-16 Abiding under God's wings, protection from evil, and having angels to protect us.
2681. Psalms 92:1-15 Giving thanks to God with musical instruments; the righteous shall flourish.
2682. Psalms 93:1-5 The majesty of God, His Throne; He is mightier than the waves of the sea.
2683. Psalms 94:1-23 Asking God to punish the wicked and to raise up a Savior to save us from the evildoers.
2684. Psalms 95:1-11 Calling for praise and worship of God, His might, and the forty years that Israel sinned.
2685. Psalms 96:1-13 Sing a new song to God and bless His Name; honor and majesty to God.
2686. Psalms 97:1-12 God's might, the earth melts, the heavens declare Him, and the saints are delivered.
2687. Psalms 98:1-9 Music for God, victories of God, and His mercy; He righteously judges the earth.
2688. Psalms 99:1-9 The Holiness of God; Moses, Aaron, and Samuel kept His testimonies.

2689. Psalms 100:1-5 “Make a joyful noise unto the Lord..., serve and know Him, and enter into His presence with thanksgiving....”
2690. Psalms 101:1-8 King David promising God good conduct; he will rid the land of sinners.
2691. Psalms 102:1-28 Prayer of the afflicted, praising God’s power, and putting oneself down.
2692. Psalms 103:1-22 David blessing God and affirming God’s mercy and slowness to anger.
2693. Psalms 104:1-35 Psalm of God’s creation and manipulation of man, earth, and animals; psalm speaks also of the dragon.
2694. Psalms 105:1-45 Psalm of God’s wondrous works through leaders of Israel, the Exodus, and Canaan.
2695. Psalms 106:1-48 Psalm of man’s failures, idol worship, and punishment through Israel’s history.
2696. Psalms 107:1-43 Psalm of Israel’s sins, ups and downs of Israel, and the chastisement of Israel’s leaders.
2697. Psalms 108:1-13 King David affirming God’s blessings, mercy and control of Israel.
2698. Psalms 109:1-31 David asking God to punish his enemies with many kinds of condemnation.
2699. Psalms 110:1-7 David identifying Jesus at the right hand of God; a priest after the order of Melchizedek.
2700. Psalms 111:1-10 A psalm of praise of and power of God; “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.”
2701. Psalms 112:1-10 A psalm blessing the man who fears God; he shall have wealth and protection.
2702. Psalms 113:1-9 Psalm praising God for rescuing the poor and needy and making joyfulness.

2703. Psalms 114:1-8 God's relationship with Israel and Judah; the earth moved at His protection of Isaac and Jacob.
2704. Psalms 115:1-18 God's power against the heathen and blessings to His people.
2705. Psalms 116:1-19 Psalm prayer of troubles, surety that God will help, and a vow to do better; SAINTS DIE GOOD.
2706. Psalms 117:1-2 Psalm of praise to God, and His merciful kindness; His truth endures forever.
2707. Psalms 118:1-29 Psalm of assurance of God's blessing; He is the cornerstone; "THIS IS THE DAY THAT THE LORD HAS MADE...."
2708. Psalms 119:1-8 Aleph – Blessing the undefiled, keeping His statutes, and His righteous judgments.
2709. Psalms 119:9-16 Beth – Cleansing from sin; hiding His Word in our hearts; I will not forget.
2710. Psalms 119:17-24 Gimel – Prayer for God's help; man declaring his weaknesses.
2711. Psalms 119:25-32 Deleth – Prayer asking forgiveness and help to overcome sin.
2712. Psalms 119:33-40 He – Asking God to control his life, rid him of sin, and give him righteousness.
2713. Psalms 119:41-48 Vau – Asking God's mercy, promising to serve Him, and speaking for Him.
2714. Psalms 119:49-56 Zain – Promising to remember and observe God's laws.
2715. Psalms 119:57-64 Cheth – Keeping God's Word; "The wicked have robbed me; I fear Thee."
2716. Psalms 119:65-72 Teth – "Suffering affliction, I've been astray; I love Thy law."

2717.	Psalms 119:73-80	Jod – Prayer for cleansing; “Have mercy, let me not be ashamed.”
2718.	Psalms 119:81-88	Caph – Asking comfort and execution of judgment against persecutors.
2719.	Psalms 119:89-96	Lamed – Praising God’s Word; delighting in God’s precepts.
2720.	Psalms 119:97-104	Mem – Praising God’s law which gives more knowledge than teachers.
2721.	Psalms 119:105-112	Nun – God’s Word is a lamp; “Though afflicted, I will always obey God.”
2722.	Psalms 119:113-120	Samech – Asking God to hold him up, give safety, and put away the wicked.
2723.	Psalms 119:121-128	Ain – Asking God to punish oppressors; they have made God’s law void.
2724.	Psalms 119:129-136	Pe – “Thy testimonies are wonderful; have mercy and deliver me.”
2725.	Psalms 119:137-144	Tzaddi – “God is righteous, I am small and troubled; help me live.”
2726.	Psalms 119:145-152	Koph – Crying and dismay; can’t see the light, but hope in God.
2727.	Psalms 119:153-160	Resh – Asking God to plead his cause and deliver him; God endures forever.
2728.	Psalms 119:161-168	Schin – “Declaring innocence of sin and having persecution, I endure.”
2729.	Psalms 119:169-176	Tau – “God, hear my cry and deliver me; I will always praise Thee.”
2730.	Psalms 120:1-7	In distress, Psalmist asks God for deliverance from a lying enemy.
2731.	Psalms 121:1-8	Lifting eyes to the hills, help comes from God, his protector; He never sleeps.

2732. Psalms 122:1-9 David: "I WAS GLAD WHEN THEY SAID, LET US GO INTO THE HOUSE OF THE LORD." God gives peace to Jerusalem.
2733. Psalms 123:1-4 Lifting eyes to heaven; seeking God's mercy from the contempt of the proud.
2734. Psalms 124:1-8 David: "God is on our side, protection against our enemies."
2735. Psalms 125:1-5 The power of trusting in God; the wicked are always present; peace be upon Israel.
2736. Psalms 126:1-6 Captivity of Zion; SOW IN TEARS, REAP IN JOY; REJOICING, BRINGING IN THE SHEAVES.
2737. Psalms 127:1-5 Solomon: "EXCEPT GOD BUILD THE HOUSE..." Happy is a man with a quiver full of children.
2738. Psalms 128:1-6 The fear of God brings a blessed wife, children, and a good life with peace.
2739. Psalms 129:1-8 Affliction from Zion's enemy; they shall be cut down and wither as grass.
2740. Psalms 130:1-8 Out of the depths, a cry for God's help; Israel shall be redeemed.
2741. Psalms 131:1-3 David claiming his innocence and seeking Israel's hope in God.
2742. Psalms 132:1-18 Psalmist claiming David's desire for righteousness and hopes for Zion.
2743. Psalms 133:1-3 David speaking of pleasantries of brethren living in unity.
2744. Psalms 134:1-3 Servants of God in the Temple lifting hands and blessing God for Zion.
2745. Psalms 135:1-21 Praising God for choosing Israel, leading Israel into Canaan, and exiling the enemy.

2746. Psalms 136:1-26 Giving God thanks for the earth and Israel's guidance... "FOR HIS MERCY ENDURES FOREVER."
2747. Psalms 137:1-9 "BY THE RIVERS OF BABYLON WE WEPT AS WE REMEMBERED ZION; WE WERE ASKED TO SING THE SONGS OF ZION --- WE COULD NOT, FOR WE WERE GRIEVED."
2748. Psalms 138:1-8 David praising God for answered prayer, respecting the lowly, and being merciful.
2749. Psalms 139:1-24 David: "God knows me completely, He is with me even in hell, I am fearfully and wonderfully made, search me, Oh Lord, and know my heart; lead me.
2750. Psalms 140:1-13 David asking protection from the wicked and asking God to destroy them.
2751. Psalms 141:1-10 David to God, "Hear my prayers, control my lips, and keep me from my enemies.
2752. Psalms 142:1-7 King David begging for God's help in danger and faith that God will rescue him.
2753. Psalms 143:1-12 David praying for God's deliverance, teaching, and leading from his enemies.
2754. Psalms 144:1-15 David thanking God for strength to war, "What is man...?" I will sing.
2755. Psalms 145:1-21 David praising God and declaring God's many mighty works and comfort.
2756. Psalms 146:1-10 Praising God's might and trusting only in Him; He reigns over Israel.
2757. Psalms 147:1-20 Praising God with singing, His wondrous works, and His watch over Israel.
2758. Psalms 148:1-14 Praising God in every creation; all creatures and people must praise Him.

2759. Psalms 149:1-9

Praise with singing, dance, and instruments;
saints be joyful; God punish the heathen.

2760. Psalms 150:1-6

Praise God with all musical instruments for
His excellent greatness; “LET
EVERYTHING THAT HAS BREATH
PRAISE THE LORD!”
