

SECOND CORINTHIANS

1975. 2nd Corinthians 1:1-2 A letter of greetings from Paul, Timothy, and all Saints from Achaia (Greece); grace from Jesus.
1976. 2nd Corinthians 1:3-7 Blessed is God; He comforts us so that we may comfort others; You also receive our consolations.
1977. 2nd Corinthians 1:8-10 Paul tells of their near death experience in Asia, "We had to trust God Who delivered us from it."
1978. 2nd Corinthians 1:11-14 Paul acknowledges their prayers and testimonies and their rejoicing with each other in the day of Jesus.
1979. 2nd Corinthians 1:15-24 Paul expresses positive ministry, no maybes, just yea; by faith we stand.
1980. 2nd Corinthians 2:1-3 Paul determines to be joyous, not sad, so that the Corinthians feel good in the Faith.
1981. 2nd Corinthians 2:4-8 Paul is writing in agony but love, seeking forgiveness for those contrary toward Jesus.
1982. 2nd Corinthians 2:9-17 Paul is wanting proof of their love and obedience, their resisting Satan, certifying Corinth for Jesus.
1983. 2nd Corinthians 3:1-2 Paul, "We don't commend ourselves, you do; you are an epistle written in men's hearts."
1984. 2nd Corinthians 3:3-4 Paul declares Corinth an epistle written in men's hearts with trust in Jesus and God.
1985. 2nd Corinthians 3:5-6 God made us ministers with sufficiency from Him, not by the letter of the New Testament, but by the Spirit of It.

1986. 2nd Corinthians 3:7-8 **MOSES AND THE LAW DIES AND IS DONE AWAY; THE SPIRIT LIFE LIVES AND IS SUPERIOR AND GLORIOUS.**
1987. 2nd Corinthians 3:9-12 Moses' administration, now condemned as unrighteous, has given way to Christianity.
1988. 2nd Corinthians 3:13-16 Continued reminding of the "Veil" of Moses appraisal confuses New Testament believers.
1989. 2nd Corinthians 3:17-18 The liberty of the Lord's Spirit; we followers see the glory from earth to heaven.
1990. 2nd Corinthians 4:1-2 Our Christian ministry is mercy; we faint not; we've renounced sin and preach truth to men.
1991. 2nd Corinthians 4:3-4 The Gospel is hidden from the lost; they are blind of mind to the Light of God.
1992. 2nd Corinthians 4:5-7 We preach Jesus and us as His servants and His light; we are earthen vessels given power by God.
1993. 2nd Corinthians 4:8-9 **WE ARE TROUBLED ON EVERY SIDE, YET NOT DISTRESSED; WE ARE PERPLEXED, BUT NOT IN DESPAIR; PERSECUTED, BUT NOT FORSAKEN; CAST DOWN, BUT NOT DESTROYED.**
1994. 2nd Corinthians 4:10-11 We bear the death of Jesus for His Life in us; we die for Jesus so that He can live in us.
1995. 2nd Corinthians 4:12-16 The death of Jesus works in us for your sakes; our bodies perish but the inward man renews daily.
1996. 2nd Corinthians 4:17-18 Our light affliction works for eternity, looking at things not seen, but are

eternal.

1997. 2nd Corinthians 5:1-4 If our body tabernacle is destroyed, we have bodies built by god, eternally groaning for heavenly clothing.
1998. 2nd Corinthians 5:5-9 God's Spirit is in us; we walk by faith; we would rather be absent from the body and present with Him.
1999. 2nd Corinthians 5:10 WE MUST ALL APPEAR BEFORE THE JUDGMENT SEAT OF JESUS AND RECEIVE GOOD OR BAD JUDGMENT.
2000. 2nd Corinthians 5:11-13 We preach the terror of God to save you from outward appearance glory to glory of the heart.
2001. 2nd Corinthians 5:14-16 Jesus' Love constrains us; He died for all so we must live for Him, knowing Him by Spirit.
2002. 2nd Corinthians 5:17 THEREFORE, IF ANY MAN BE IN CHRIST, HE IS A NEW CREATURE, THE OLD THINGS HAVE PASSED AWAY; BEHOLD, ALL THINGS HAVE BECOME NEW.
2003. 2nd Corinthians 5:18-19 God reconciled us to Him by Jesus, imputing our trespasses to Himself for reconciliation.
2004. 2nd Corinthians 5:20-21 We are Jesus' ambassadors; be reconciled to God; Jesus is sin for us; He knew no sin.
2005. 2nd Corinthians 6:1-2 RECEIVE YE THE GRACE NOT IN VAIN; NOW IS THE ACCEPTED DAY OF SALVATION.

2006. 2nd Corinthians 6:3-4 Don't be an offense to the ministry; approve yourselves as ministers with patience in afflictions, necessities, and distresses.
2007. 2nd Corinthians 6:5-10 Paul implores ministry, forsaking sufferings, by purity, honor, rejoicing, and having riches of faith.
2008. 2nd Corinthians 6:11-13 Paul, "Our heart is enlarged for you; I speak to you as my children; be ye also enlarged."
2009. 2nd Corinthians 6:14 BE NOT UNEQUALLY YOKED TOGETHER WITH UNBELIEVERS; FOR WHAT FELLOWSHIP HAS RIGHTEOUSNESS WITH UNRIGHTEOUSNESS? WHAT COMMUNICATION HAS LIGHT WITH DARKNESS?
2010. 2nd Corinthians 6:15 What concord does Jesus have with Beliel or one who believes with an infidel?
2011. 2nd Corinthians 6:16 What agreement has God's Temple with idols? You are the Temple Of God; He dwells in us, walks with us, and is our God.
2012. 2nd Corinthians 6:17 OF SINNERS: WHEREFORE COME OUT FROM AMONG THEM AND BE YE SEPARATE SAITH THE LORD AND TOUCH NOT THE UNCLEAN THING AND I WILL RECEIVE YOU AND WILL BE YOUR FATHER SAITH THE LORD ALMIGHTY.
2013. 2nd Corinthians 7:1-3 Paul declaring holiness and fear of God, asking the Corinthians to accept them in true ministry.
2014. 2nd Corinthians 7:4-5 Paul, "I am bold, comfortable and joyful in tribulation; coming through Macedonia we were afraid."

2015. 2nd Corinthians 7:6-9 Paul refers to Titus' ministry to them; speaks of a misunderstanding that has been corrected and repented of.
2016. 2nd Corinthians 7:10-11 Paul, "Godly sorrow works repentance and salvation; these conflicts have cleared you of your problem."
2017. 2nd Corinthians 7:12-16 Paul speaks of his writings to the Corinthians, of Titus' ministry to them, and of the confidence that resulted.
2018. 2nd Corinthians 8:1-8 Paul tells of their ministry to Macedonia, of Titus, and of overcoming ministry problems everywhere.
2019. 2nd Corinthians 8:9-14 Jesus was rich and became poor for you; do what you have to do to minister and be equal to others.
2020. 2nd Corinthians 8:15 As it is written, he that had gathered much had nothing left over; he that gathered little had no lack.
2021. 2nd Corinthians 8:16-24 Paul giving honor to Titus' teachings and ministry to Corinth and for their receptiveness and ministry.
2022. 2nd Corinthians 9:1-5 Paul discusses their Macedonian ministry and compares it to Corinth to see if they measure up together.
2023. 2nd Corinthians 9:6 He who sows sparingly reaps likewise; he who sows bountifully brings a bountiful harvest.
2024. 2nd Corinthians 9:7 **ON GIVING AND TITHING: GIVE FROM YOUR HEART, NOT GRUDGINGLY OR OF NECESSITY; GOD LOVES A CHEERFUL GIVER.**

2025. 2nd Corinthians 9:8-9 God gives grace and abundance for good works; He covers the world and gives to the poor; His righteousness is forever.
2026. 2nd Corinthians 9:10-15 Ministers sow seed, increase righteousness, glorify God and Jesus, pray, and thank God for His unspeakable gift.
2027. 2nd Corinthians 10:1-3 Paul expresses meekness and gentleness; come boldly with confidence, walking in the flesh but not warring after the flesh.
2028. 2nd Corinthians 10:4 The weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds.
2029. 2nd Corinthians 10:5-6 We cast down things that exalt themselves against God; we are obedient to God and Christ, doing away with disobedience.
2030. 2nd Corinthians 10:7-13 Do not exaggerate your position with Jesus; there must be no comparing of old with new Christians.
2031. 2nd Corinthians 10:14-16 Paul tells the Corinthians that they, in believing, strengthen his group to go to other lands.
2032. 2nd Corinthians 10:17-18 Glory only in Jesus; one commending himself is not approved, only he whom Jesus commends.
2033. 2nd Corinthians 11:1-2 Paul wants Corinth to know his envy over their newness as a Bride of Jesus.
2034. 2nd Corinthians 11:3-7 Paul is afraid that Corinth could be beguiled by other gods because their salvation was easily received.
2035. 2nd Corinthians 11:8-11 Paul tells of support from other churches so that no complaints come from

Corinth.

2036. 2nd Corinthians 11:12-15 Paul wants to cut off their pagan influence and tells them that Satan can transform into an angel and such, seeming righteous, may be iniquity workers.
2037. 2nd Corinthians 11:16-21 Paul, seeming a fool for Jesus, speaks of boldness and reproach of those thinking him weak.
2038. 2nd Corinthians 11:22-23 Paul gives his credentials: A Hebrew, Israelite, Seed of Abraham, more than a minister of Christ, labored more, received stripes above measure, prison, and near death often.
2039. 2nd Corinthians 11:24-25 Paul, "I received forty stripes five times, three times I was beaten with rods, I was stoned once, three times shipwrecked, and a day and night I spent in the water."
2040. 2nd Corinthians 11:26 Paul, "I have been in perilous journeys often, in perils of waters, robbers, my own countrymen, heathens, perils in the city, in the wilderness, the sea, and among false brethren."
2041. 2nd Corinthians 11:27 Paul, "I have had perils of weariness, painfulness, watchings often, hunger, thirst, fastings often, cold, and nakedness."
2042. 2nd Corinthians 11:28-29 Paul, "Also I care for the many churches, I'm often weak, and often offended."
2043. 2nd Corinthians 11:30 Paul, "If I must glory, it will be in the things that concern my infirmities."
2044. 2nd Corinthians 11:31-33 Paul, "God knows I don't lie; Damascus tried to arrest me; I escaped in a basket

lowered over the wall."

2045. 2nd Corinthians 12:1-2 Paul, "I must glory in visions and revelations of Jesus; fourteen years ago I knew a man who was caught up to the third heaven."
2046. 2nd Corinthians 12:3-6 Paul, "The man was caught up to paradise, heard unspeakable words not lawful for man to utter; I glory in him but not myself; I won't be a fool, so man won't think highly of me."
2047. 2nd Corinthians 12:7 Paul, "TO KEEP ME HUMBLE, I WAS GIVEN A THORN IN THE FLESH, SATAN TO BUFFET ME TO STAY UNEXHALTED."
2048. 2nd Corinthians 12:8-9 Paul, "I ASKED GOD THREE TIMES TO TAKE THE THORN; HE SAID, 'MY GRACE IS SUFFICIENT FOR YOU, MY STRENGTH IS MADE PERFECT IN WEAKNESS'; I WOULD RATHER GLORY IN INFIRMITIES WITH THE POWER OF JESUS."
2049. 2nd Corinthians 12:10 Paul, "I take pleasure in infirmities, reproaches, necessities, persecutions and distresses for Jesus' sake, for when I am weak, then I am strong."
2050. 2nd Corinthians 12:11-13 Paul debasing himself as least apostle, saying that he should have made the Corinth Church greater.
2051. 2nd Corinthians 12:14-16 Paul tells Corinth that he will come a third time and be more a father to them, though they do not love him enough to reciprocate his love. He did not burden them but caught them with guile.
2052. 2nd Corinthians 12:17-19 Paul questions if any apostles have made gain for Jesus in Corinth; they all tried.

2053. 2nd Corinthians 12:20 Paul fears that his return will find Corinth in debates, envyings, wraths, stripes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, and tumults.
2054. 2nd Corinthians 12:21 Paul continues weary that he will find unrepentant, uncleanness, fornication, and lasciviousness in Corinth.
2055. 2nd Corinthians 13:1 Paul, "This is my third visit; in the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.."
2056. 2nd Corinthians 13:2-4 Paul, "I return in power; Jesus was crucified through weakness, but He and we shall live by power."
2057. 2nd Corinthians 13:5-7 Paul, "Examine yourselves, prove your faith and know that Jesus is in you; be honest and not reprobates."
2058. 2nd Corinthians 13:8-10 Paul, "Live truth, exceed our strength, and be perfect; I am kinder in writing than in person."
2059. 2nd Corinthians 13:11-14 Paul's farewell to Corinth, "God's love and peace to you, greet one another with a kiss, all the Saints salute you; the Grace of Jesus, Love of God and Communion of the Holy Ghost be with you all. Amen."
