

## SECOND TIMOTHY

2364. 2nd Timothy 1:1-4 Paul's greeting to Timothy with recount of prayers, God's gifts, and tears of joy.
2365. 2nd Timothy 1:5 Paul recounts Timothy's faith given from his grandmother Lois and Mother Eunice.
2366. 2nd Timothy 1:6-7 Paul remembers laying hands for gifts on Timothy, saying, "GOD HAS NOT GIVEN US THE SPIRIT OF FEAR, BUT OF POWER, LOVE AND A SOUND MIND."
2367. 2nd Timothy 1:8 Never be ashamed of our Lord's testimony, nor me, a prisoner, nor Gospel afflictions.
2368. 2nd Timothy 1:9 GOD HAS SAVED US AND CALLED US WITH A HOLY CALLING GIVEN US IN JESUS BEFORE THE WORLD BEGAN.
2369. 2nd Timothy 1:10 Our calling was manifested by Jesus Who abolished death and brought immortality through The Gospel.
2370. 2nd Timothy 1:11 PAUL, "I AM APPOINTED PREACHER, APOSTLE, AND TEACHER OF THE GENTILES."
2371. 2nd Timothy 1:12 I suffer, not ashamed, I KNOW WHOM I HAVE BELIEVED AND AM PERSUADED THAT HE IS ABLE TO KEEP THAT WHICH I HAVE COMMITTED UNTO HIM AGAINST THAT DAY.
2372. 2nd Timothy 1:13-15 Hold fast to my words; keep The Holy Ghost; Asia has turned against me.
2373. 2nd Timothy 1:16-18 God's mercy to Onesiphorus who refreshed me and was not ashamed of my chains in Rome; he sought me out;

God give him mercy; he served me in Ephesus.

2374. 2nd Timothy 2:1-5 Tell my story; teach others; endure as a soldier of Jesus; strive lawfully.
2375. 2nd Timothy 2:6-8 Laboring husbandmen are the first partakers of Jesus' blessings; Jesus is The Seed Of David and raised from dead according to MY Gospel.
2376. 2nd Timothy 2:9-11 I suffer as an evildoer in bonds; endure for the elects' sake; dead with Him is to live with Him.
2377. 2nd Timothy 2:12-14 We suffer to reign with Him; deny Him and He denies us; CHARGE BAD PREACHERS WITH SUBVERSION.
2378. 2nd Timothy 2:15 STUDY TO SHOW YOURSELF APPROVED UNTO GOD, A WORKMAN THAT DOESN'T NEED TO BE ASHAMED, RIGHTLY DIVIDING THE WORD OF TRUTH.
2379. 2nd Timothy 2:16 Shun profane and vain babblings; they will increase unto more ungodliness.
2380. 2nd Timothy 2:17-19 Hymenaeus and Philetus have erred, saying resurrection is past and hurting the faith of some; God is sure, sealing His own, and saying, "Christians, depart from iniquity."
2381. 2nd Timothy 2:20-21 Purge sin; be a vessel of honor, sanctified for good works.
2382. 2nd Timothy 2:22-23 Flee youthful lusts; follow righteousness, faith, charity, and peace; have pure hearts; avoid foolish questions that cause strife.

2383. 2nd Timothy 2:24-26 JESUS' SERVANT MUST BE GENTLE TO ALL, APT TO TEACH, PATIENT, AND IN MEEKNESS, CALLING SINNERS TO REPENTANCE WHO HAVE BEEN TAKEN CAPTIVE BY THE DEVIL.
2384. 2nd Timothy 3:1-2 IN THE LAST DAYS PERILOUS TIMES WILL COME; MEN SHALL LOVE THEMSELVES AND BE COVETOUS, BOASTERS, PROUD, BLASPHEMERS, DISOBEDIENT TO PARENTS, UNTHANKFUL, AND UNHOLY.
2385. 2nd Timothy 3:3-4 IN THE LAST DAYS MEN WILL BE WITHOUT NATURAL AFFECTION, TRUCEBREAKERS, FALSE ASSUSERS, INCONTINENT, FIERCE, DESPISERS OF GOOD PEOPLE, TRAITORS, HEADY, HIGHMINDED, AND LOVERS OF PLEASURES AND NOT GOD.
2386. 2nd Timothy 3:5 TURN AWAY FROM THOSE HAVING A FORM OF GODLINESS BUT DENYING THE POWER OF GOD.
2387. 2nd Timothy 3:6 These kind creep into houses and lead silly women, laden with sins and with divers' lusts.
2388. 2nd Timothy 3:7-9 THOSE WHO ARE EVERLEARNING INTELLECTUALS ARE NEVER ABLE TO FIND THE TRUTH; THEY RESIST IT BECAUSE OF CORRUPT MINDS; THEY ARE REPROBATE CONCERNING THE FAITH; THEY WILL BE EXPOSED.
2389. 2nd Timothy 3:10-11 You know all about me, my persecutions and afflictions which I endured with Jesus' help.

2390. 2nd Timothy 3:12 All that will give glory in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.
2391. 2nd Timothy 3:13-14 Evil people and seducers will get worse and deceive; stay in the Godly things you've learned.
2392. 2nd Timothy 3:15 FROM CHILDHOOD YOU'VE KNOWN THE HOLY SCRIPTURES; THEY MAKE YOU WISE UNTO SALVATION THROUGH FAITH IN JESUS.
2393. 2nd Timothy 3:16-17 ALL SCRIPTURE IS GIVEN BY INSPIRATION OF GOD AND IS PROFITABLE FOR DOCTRINE, REPROOF, CORRECTION AND INSTRUCTION IN RIGHTEOUSNESS THAT GOD MAY BE PERFECT IN YOU WITH GOOD WORKS.
2394. 2nd Timothy 4:1-2 Paul's charge to Timothy to be instant in or out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort.
2395. 2nd Timothy 4:3-4 People will turn from doctrine to lusts, teachers with itching ears turned into fables.
2396. 2nd Timothy 4:5-6 Endure afflictions and evangelize; I am about to be executed; my departure is at hand.
2397. 2nd Timothy 4:7 PAUL, "I HAVE FOUGHT A GOOD FIGHT, I HAVE FINISHED MY COURSE, AND I HAVE KEPT THE FAITH."
2398. 2nd Timothy 4:8 PAUL, "THERE IS LAID UP FOR ME A CROWN OF RIGHTEOUSNESS THAT GOD WILL GIVE TO ME AND TO HIS FAITHFUL."

2399. 2nd Timothy 4:9-12      Try to come to me; some have forsaken me; Luke is with me; bring Mark with you; I have sent Tychicus to Ephesus.
2400. 2nd Timothy 4:13      Bring my cloak I left at Troas with Carpus; bring the books and especially the parchments.
2401. 2nd Timothy 4:14-16      Alexander the coppersmith did me evil; god will reward him; others have forsaken me.
2402. 2nd Timothy 4:17-18      Jesus will keep me from evil works for His Kingdom, to preach to all Gentiles.
2403. 2nd Timothy 4:19-22      Salute Prisca and Aquila and the House of Onesiphorus; my disciples are here and there; try to come before winter; all salute you; Jesus be with your Spirit; Grace to you.
