

TITUS

2404. Titus 1:1-2 Paul's greeting and acknowledgement of the truth for eternal life that God promised before creation.
2405. Titus 1:3-4 Paul's message to Titus, "my Spiritual Son" that God manifests His Word through preaching.
2406. Titus 1:5-6 I left you in Crete to set things in order and to ordain elders who are blameless and with good families.
2407. Titus 1:7-9 **BISHOPS MUST BE BLAMELESS, NOT SELF-WILLED, HARD TO ANGER, NOT GIVEN TO WINE, NO STRIKERS, WITHOUT FILTHY LUCRE, LOVERS OF HOSPITALITY, AND BE GOOD, CONVENCING DOCTRINAL PREACHERS.**
2408. Titus 1:10 We have among us unruly, vain talkers and deceivers, especially of the circumcision.
2409. Titus 1:11-12 Their mouths of filthy subversion must be stopped; their prophets say that Cretians are liars.
2410. Titus 1:13-16 Rebuke them sharply; correct them from Jewish fables which are not true; they are impure.
2411. Titus 2:1-2 Teach sound doctrine; make the aged men sober, grave, temperate, and sound in the faith, charity, and patience.
2412. Titus 2:3-5 Aged women must be holy, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things, teaching young women to be sober, loving their husbands and children, discrete, chaste, good housekeepers, and obedient to their husbands that God's Word is not

blasphemed.

2413. Titus 2:6-8 Young men must be sober minded, in good works, uncorrupt, uncondemned, and saying nothing evil.
2414. Titus 2:9-10 Paul's word to servants on obedience, respect for masters, and embracing God.
2415. Titus 2:11-15 God's Grace is available to all; we should live soberly, looking for Jesus and doing good works.
2416. Titus 3:1 Paul reminding Christians that they are subject to secular government.
2417. Titus 3:2-3 Speak no evil; don't be brawlers, be gentle and meek to all people; we were once foolish sinners.
2418. Titus 3:4-6 Jesus saved us not by our works, but by His mercy; He gave us The Holy Ghost abundantly.
2419. Titus 3:7-8 Justified by Grace, we are heirs with eternal life, faithful in works thereafter.
2420. Titus 3:9 Do not play with the law, doing things to create loopholes; that is vain and unprofitable.
2421. Titus 3:10-11 Try to win a heretic only twice; if you fail, he is subverted, condemning himself.
2422. Titus 3:12 I'm sending Artemas or Tychicus to you; come to me at Nicopolis where I'll spend the winter.

2423. Titus 3:13-15

Bring Zenas the lawyer and Apollos; let all do good works; my group salutes you; greet those of your Christian group; grace be with you all. Amen.
